
Mists Constable

Hello Misties!
It's been my honor and pleasure to serve as Constable of the Mists for the past (mumble mumble) years, but I am coming to the end of my second full term and it's time to pass the office on. I'm hoping to identify a successor in time for the fall event season -- the first Mists event this fall will be Mists/Cynagua War in September -- so that they can be trained (if needed) and step up before the end of this year.

Constable of the Mists is a great job -- the Mists runs 6 events a year, generally 3 camping and 3 day events, and the job of the Constable happens almost entirely at the events so there are very few tasks or paperwork requirements to keep track of between events. You get to be the face of the Principality welcoming everyone to site, and have access to the gate sheets to re-learn the names of people you've known too long to ask; you get a seat at the table in the business meeting to see the inner workings of the Principality without having any homework; and you get to join the communities of Mists Officers and West Kingdom Constables, who are always gracious about supporting and helping out when needed.

If you are interested, please reach out to me by the end of this month to let me know. And if you're not sure or on the fence, or if you have any questions I can answer about what being Constable requires, the support available, or anything else, please reach out and chat -- Constable of the Mists can definitely be a first service job (it was mine!) and I'm happy to answer questions about it, but if you're nervous about the scale of responsibility or can't commit to 6 events a year there are also branch officerships open that may be an option as well.


