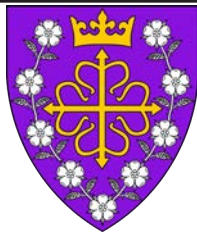

Greetings all!

Let's start right off with the business. As I mentioned last time, is that it's time for me to find a successor. Deadline for letters is end of the year. So, if you're interested in this job, and it's a great job because we have awesome people in Calontir's College of Heraldry, send a letter to [goldfalcon@calontir.org](mailto:goldfalcon@calontir.org).

Since it's time for whatever winter festival you celebrate, I thought I'd give you a grab bag of small stocking stuffer type stuff, or at least some notes and links to enjoy various aspects of Calontir and heraldry.

Happy 44<sup>th</sup> anniversary! To what, you might ask.

Well, I'm glad you asked. It is the 44<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the December 1980 Letter of Acceptances and Rejections which has a small connection to Calontir. In that letter, the SCA College of Heraldry passed the badge of the Region of Calontir: Purpure, a Cross of Calatrava within a laurel wreath bordurewise Or. Add a crown to that and presto, it's our kingdom's device!

I'll get back to that letter in a moment, because there's more fun stuff in that letter, but I thought I'd mention Geoffri of Wareine. Don't worry, I'm not going to cover all that he did for Calontir. There's just no way I could in this format. However, I will mention it was he who chose the Cross of Calatrava for Calontir.

He is also our first Cross, entering the order on April 21<sup>st</sup>, 1979, more than a year before Brummbar von Schwarzburg became the second member. And, as you can see, before the region had its own badge. He was, literally, a Cross before Crosses were cool.

If you want to know more about Geoffri, and he is incredibly important in our history with a title no one else has (the Bailiff), the *Chronicles of Calontir* are a great place to start. Craig J. Brown, otherwise known as Crag Duggan, wrote these after interviewing as many possible people who were there at the time. You can get them on Amazon (Volume 1 – Foundations is here: <https://www.amazon.com/dp/B00AX8R7RI> and (Volume II – The Princes is here: <https://www.amazon.com/dp/1482308541>).

Speaking of repositories of history, please allow me the indulgence of drifting over to bardic stuff for a moment. If you're interested in Calontir's history of songs, go to <http://www.calonsong.org/songbook.php> where Katriana op den Dijk has done a fantastic job of collecting many of the songs we've sung over the years. We might not sing *Greyhound Bound for Pennsic* much anymore, but it's fun to remember Calontir's rebel sons, at least every once in a while.

Back to heraldic stuff, did you know we celebrate

International Heraldry Day many years at Lilies? That's right, June 10<sup>th</sup> is the day, so this is your six month warning to get something cool going for Tuesday at Lilies AS 60.

If you're interested in heraldry outside of the SCA, you can see it in action by going to the various colleges of arms. For example, the College of Arms for England, Wales, Northern Ireland, and much of the Commonwealth has a quarterly newsletter with their events, appearances, interesting tidbits, and even new grants of arms.

Yes, I'm subscribed to the newsletter (It's here: <https://www.college-of-arms.gov.uk/>). Did you think someone as geeky as me wouldn't? One fun tidbit for me in the August newsletter was a visit from the then Prince of Wales to the College of Arms on July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1968, or six days after I was born. So, I guess that makes Charles III and twins, right?

Anyway, as I promised, back to that December, 1980 LOAR. In that one, the college accepted the devices of the Order of the Torse and the Order of the Warlord's Chalice. Yes, you read that right. The *Warlord's Chalice*. Shannon of Dovehaven was given the Warlord's Chalice on July 26<sup>th</sup>, 1980. Yes, Shannon is listed as the premier member of the *Queen's Chalice* on the online OP, but that's not what they actually got.

Of note, while the name changed, the device has not.

But wait, there's more in that letter! It slices, it dices! Or rather, so did Chepe l'Orangeux, who had his name and device passed in this LOAR. You might remember him, or at least his name, from the reading of the lineage at Coronation as our first King. His arms, by the way, have two lightning bolts in saltire and l'Orangeux means, "The Stormy One."

With that, I'll wish you a year without storms, one full of chalices brimming with your favorite beverage, beautiful heraldry, and glorious songs.

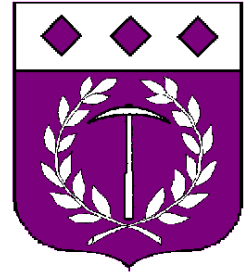

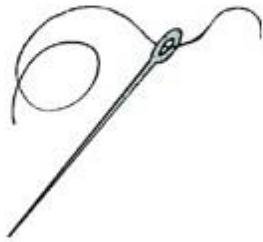

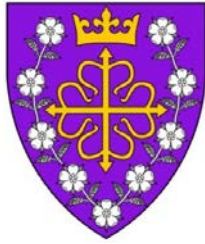

## Event Flyer Guidelines

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in The Mews. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. The Mews WILL NOT publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <https://www.calontir.org/events/>

**Editable:** An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. Work with the Social Media Officer for flyers that may be posted on social media.

**Deadline:** The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the 1st of the month THREE MONTHS PRIOR to your event. *For Example:* If the event is in November, the flyer must be received by August 1st for the September Mews. Refer to the Calendar at the front of the Mews.

If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period. The deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!

### Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

1. Name of the sponsoring group or groups
2. Day, month, and year of the event
3. Site open & close times for populace
4. Location of the event—the name of the event site, and full address.
5. Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email (Needed for emergencies or issues arise)
6. Details of Registration—Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

*For Example:*

Adult Event Registration: \$25  
Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20  
Youth (6-17) \$5  
Children 5 & Under: FREE
