## Publication Policies

Send submissions to the Kingdom Chronicler (see Regnum). All submissions IN THEIR ENTIRETY must be in the Kingdom Chronicler's possession no later than the first of the month prior to the cover date (e.g. January 1 for the February issue). This includes e-mail and hardcopy submissions. Should the first fall on a Sunday or holiday, the deadline for hardcopy will be moved to the next business day; e-mail submissions will be due no later than the 1st regardless.

If you are going to be late, you must inform the Chronicler before the first of the month so that space may be reserved. Anything arriving after the first is subject to refusal and has no guarantee of being published.

Submissions shall consist of a [1] an electronic copy, [2] an event announcement checklist which has been signed off on by the Seneschal of your group, and [3] a release form for any artwork (including maps) in the submission. If your submission is missing any of the previous items it will potentially not be published if not resolved by midnight on the first.

PDF is the preferred file format for submissions. Any other format MUST be discussed with the Kingdom Chronicler for acceptability.

Recruitment across the Kingdom is looking great so keep up the good work. Local Groups have been putting in amazing effort to keep this up and I'd like to quickly commend Bonwicke in particular for their Abilene Mead Fest Demo!

For upcoming demos to keep an eye on the Shire of Ffynnon Gath will be doing their second year at the New Braunfels Renaissance Faire Demo! The demo will be running December 6-8 and 13-15; they run 5pm -10pm on Fridays, 10am -10pm on Saturdays, and 10am - 6pm on Sundays. New Braunfels Renaissance Faire was an incredible opportunity last year with some great recruitment that has helped multiple groups; it was so

successful that they have expanded to 2 weekends for this year and I know that Ffynnon Gath will need all of the help that they can get to man it! Keep an eye on posts from them for details on how you can help.

In other news the first round of revisions for the upcoming Kingdom Census is underway. It will take a little time to get it to a finished state and I hope to have it released by the Spring. Your local Chatelaines will have more information for you after Winter Round Table on the Census so keep an eye out for more information!

As a new thing I intend to include a quick suggestion section in Black Star reports to give advice on how individuals around the kingdom can help their local groups with recruitment and retention. This advice may come in the form of words from members of various communities around the Kingdom, ideas on ways to help your local group, or calls from local Chatelaines for volunteers to help with various activities. This month I'd like to talk about using social activities other than SCA related ones to help keep your local communities healthy. We often get very focused on our various paths, current projects, or responsibilities and as a result don't always have the time to get to know each other as we only get to see the side of people that is directly related to the activity we're doing. Getting to know each other better and connecting with members of our SCA community can help prevent misunderstandings, give us opportunities to problem solve, or just reduce feelings of fatigue and burnout. Getting outside of SCA settings can make it easier to get to know people and remove stressors. Try organizing welcoming, inclusive, non-SCA social activities in your local area as opportunities to have fun with your community in low stakes settings. A baronial game night, shire bowling night, paintball weekend, movie night, or just a monthly hang out at a local pub or restaurant can be great ways for us to have these chances to connect. Try keeping the "shop talk" of the SCA to a minimum, have fun and take these opportunities to get to know people and make new friends that you might not have made before. Anyone can start casual hangouts (it doesn't have to fall on the Chatelaine or Group leaders.) Next time you're thinking about getting a small SCA group activity together, consider posting an open invite to your local group's Discord or FB group to see who shows up. Getting away from the titles, responsibilities, and pressure of the activities of the SCA at times can help us better connect with those around us and give us healthier, more active communities.

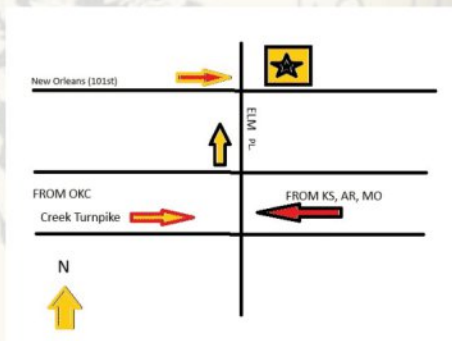
