From the Office of the Seneschal:

Beloved Outlands,

Over the course of my Outlandish Herald letters, I have tried my best to give insights into upcoming changes in the kingdom and SCA. Policies are set by the SCA through the Organizational Handbook that includes Corpora, the By-Laws, Corporate Policies, and the Articles of Incorporation. This is a time of change for the SCA where your opinions are valued. From Omnibus Peerages to Patron membership levels, the Society wants your feedback. Feedback to the society should go to <u>SCA-</u> <u>Comments@sca.org</u> and include your modern name, member number, expiration date along with your Society name and title.

Change can be difficult. Change can feel like the rug has been pulled out from under our feet if we are unprepared to face the ever-changing rules. It can be hard to see things from a different perspective, especially when we fully believe we are in the right. One of the most dangerous phrases is "we have always done it this way" and when we refuse to adapt and overcome new or changing challenges, that is when tempers can flare. Keeping up with the modern laws that govern a 501(c)3 nonprofit as well as Society's rules can be overwhelming. It can be easy to place blame on "The BoD" or "The Society Seneschal" when you don't know who they are. When our emotions kick in, we act our worst, and we think it's not our fault. We invent stories that evoke a feeling, and we build on those feelings until our emotions finally get out of control. It is only when we ask ourselves to pause and separate the fact from the story that we can create new emotions that can lead us to a pool of shared meaning.

There are a lot of great things in the works for this kingdom in the coming year. One of our overall goals is to make volunteering easier. You will see the concept of Story Bonding coming to a kingdom online event featuring the hard work of Sir Alexander. Together we will explore how to onboard officers for both local and kingdom positions. The Northern Seneschal Deputy, Duchess Conal and her team have been working on the Event Steward Handbook. This handbook will give a step-by-step guide to hosting events, including a section on camping and feast. The Southern Seneschal Deputy, Sir Hroleif and the Kingdom Chatelaine, Lord Ilo have been busy with their team creating the Demo Handbook. The Kingdom Officers have heard your feedback and are working on processes to make more fun, less work a reality for everyone in the Kingdom of the Outlands.

From the Royal Outlands Interkingdom University:

Greetings, Teachers & Learners!

We have just recently approved over 35 new titles for online classes that had been submitted to the Regents for approval. However, most of these didn't even require any kind of approval!

What counts as an online class?

In the ROIU, an "online class" or "virtual class" is any class you take without being physical present, in the room with the teacher. There are basically two varieties: classes taken which are taught LIVE online, like at a Virtual Event (such as the recent Virtual Known World Heraldic and Scribal Symposium); and classes which are pre-recorded (this is usually a YouTube video).

When you are acting as the Teacher and you teach a class of type #1 at an online event, if it is of the "pre-approved" variety (see below), you can simply fill out the Teacher Documentation Form on the ROIU website and record the class you taught.

If you are acting as the Teacher and you create a YouTube video, if it is of the "pre-approved" variety, you do the same.

If you are acting as the Student and watch either a live online class, or a pre-recorded class (like a YouTube video), if it's "preapproved," you just fill out the Student Documentation Form on the ROIU website and record the class for credit.

Now, what is "pre-approved?" ANY class which meets any of the following criteria is pre-approved for the ROIU, and you don't have to do anything special beyond fill out the Teacher Documentation Form or Student Documentation Form:

Any class taught at an official SCA event or function (including virtual events), to include published gatherings such as fighter practices, guild meetings, populace gatherings, etc. The event or function must be published (Social Media counts!) at least 48 hours before it happens and generally open to people who are interested (within reason-- if there's not space for more than 10 people around the forge at your smithing class, that's ok). So if it's a class at an SCA event or regular/official gathering, that works.

Any class sponsored by, hosted by, or bearing the endorsement of an SCA Office (e.g. "official" classes, including videos, from the Society X, or the Kingdom Y, etc.

Any class sponsored by, hosted by, or bearing the endorsement of the "official" University of ANY Kingdom-- The Royal University of the Midrealm (RUM); the Universities of Artemisia, Atlantia, Drachenwald, and all other kingdoms of the SCA. (I know there are more out there!) Any class listed on the ROIU website under the Virtual Classes link (under "Scholars") has been vetted and pre-approved. (Please note: we are in the process of removing and repairing some broken links in this section!)

So what isn't preapproved? On the ROIU website, under "Scholars," there is a Virtual Class Recommendation Form. What is this form for?

This form is for non-SCA online classes or videos which don't fall into one of the pre-approved categories above, but which you think are serious and academic and should be available to count for ROIU credit. There are a lot of great documentaries online! If you come across something that you think should be counted, use this form to submit it to the ROIU Board of Regents. We will review it as soon as possible and, if it fits our expectations, we will add it to the "Virtual Classes" list on the ROIU website. Classes should be about 45-60 minutes in length, and obviously should cover some period subject(s). Please be sure to include as much information as you can about the class, and please recommend which College(s) and Division(s) this class should go in (up to two)-- e.g. "Arts & Sciences - Fiber Arts" and "History - 1400 - 1500."
