Greetings to all in Lochc,

We have a new King and Queen (Kitan and Alesia) HUZAH! and I welcome them and offer my assistance in any heraldic areas they require .



The following names and devices have been registered.

* **Æsa draumspakr**. Device. Argent, a saltire coupé, overall three bars coupé gules, a bordure vert.

* **Ailbhe éccnaid**. Name.

* **Aufidius Felix**. Name

* **Frederick von Rosen**. Name and device. Sable, on a pall purpure fimbriated argent a rose Or.

* **Frosti af Ulfahol**. Name .

* **Joanna of Braidwood**. Alternate name Joanna of Breadwood.

* **Laurencia Fitzjohn**. Name and device. Sable, a vol and on a point pointed argent a rose proper.

* **Rúnfríðr Keiliselgr**. Alternate name Rúna Keiliselgr. .

* **Siegfried von Cleve**. Name and device. Quarterly sable and vert, in bend sinister two trees blasted and a bordure argent.

Under the new marshalling rules accepted on this month's Cover Letter, the plain sections remove the appearance of marshalling per SENA A6F5e.

* **Valentine Gaylord**. Name change from Gaylord of Sain Monica.

* **Zaven Zeytuntsi**. Device. Gules, within a mullet of six points voided and interlaced six crescents in estoile, in base two eagles close regardant addorsed Or.

Please look into the LoAR and check out the latest changes that have been made to the rules.

It has come to note that several Baronies are having trouble finding replacements for Baronial Heralds. This leaves your Barony in a very unstable state.

Please consider applying for the position, you will be supported by your Baron/Baroness's and other officers including the outgoing officers. I am also available to consult with if you have any questions. To those that have applied since this missive, I thank you and look forward to working with you.

Please reach out to any heralds you know if you require assistance with a submission. Lochac has a great record of minimal returns due to the diligence of it's heralds.

From Kingdom Youth Officer

Greetings from your friendly Kingdom Youth Officer!

Are you someone who attends SCA events in Terra Rosa and enjoys running activities for children? Do you have children, family, or friends with children who would like them to have lots of amazingly fun things to do at events?

Do you have an SCA Youth Authorisation Card (YAC)? Have you applied for one, only for it to be lost in the mail and never arrive or mysteriously be eaten by your cat or housedragon? Or perhaps you had one that has expired?

To ensure we can continue to offer safe, engaging activities, we need more volunteers with valid Youth Authorisation Cards. Even if you don't typically run children's activities, your local Seneschal, event Stewards, and your SCA community would greatly appreciate it if you could apply for a card.

As many of the Mundane Territories and States in Terra Rosa are bringing in new regulations to ensure the safety and supervision of children, we want to remind all volunteers working with youth that it is becoming increasingly essential to have a state-issued background check (also known as a Working with Children Check, Working with Vulnerable People Check, or Blue Card). This check must be verified by the SCA before it can be used.

The good news? The checks are free for volunteers in almost every state and territory across Terra Rosa! And if you already have a paid background check for your mundane employment, it is perfectly valid to use it for SCA activities here.

So what do you need to do to get a Youth Authorisation Card, I hear you ask? To make it easier, we've created a webform to apply for your Youth Authorisation Card:

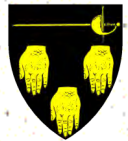
role as some of the other Kingdom officers (or Royalty) can be, if that sort of thing is an issue for you.
