



A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

When we talk about the Renaissance, your first thoughts go to Italy, 15th century, Raphael and Michaelangelo... but that is not *actually* the great Renaissance... more like the sequel to the first leap forward in culture, economics, and science; the Islamic Golden Age, which lasted from the 8th century to the 14th century.

Centered around the largest city in the world at the time, Baghdad, the caliphates did the first translations of classical knowledge from Greek, Syriac, Middle Persian, and Sanskrit. It was these Arabic translations that were later translated into Latin. Key innovations from the time include mass paper production, universities, *al-gebra*, geometry, trigonometry, scientific method, the heliocentric model, anatomy, and more. Hospitals in their modern application, as well as pharmacies and surgery came about during the age.

With the occupation of *al-Andalus* (modern Iberia), came the restoration of Roman-era aqueducts coupled with Persian and Indian crops like rice, sugarcane, citrus, carrots, apricots; along with restoring the Greco-Roman practice of cultivating and curing olives and growing pomegranates re-invented Mediterranean cuisine.

Alas, several factors brought the six century enlightenment to a close. A religious fervor shifted culture away from scientific thinking. Along with conquering Mongols, and the *reconquista* of the Iberian peninsula, the once vast entity that stretched from the Atlantic Ocean to the Indus River was overtaken and chipped away until the Ottoman Caliphate was abolished at the end of World War I.

The roots of the European Renaissance, with the scientific 'advancements' and Classical literature that it is known for come from many Islamic sources taken during the Reconquista, and Byzantine interactions with the Ottomans. And now you know more *الكرب العشوائي al-karib ashwai* (random carp).


