

Another Pennsic is in the history books - or it will be as soon as everyone has time to process it. For this issue we will take a quick look at some of the things that happened at War. Here are a few things to know:

- Final attendance was recorded at 8.676.
- This year, the Midrealm allied with the East, instead of standing against them with additional allies. We faced Æthelmearc and all attendees from every other kingdom in the Known World. This can be called a "purple war" because it mixes the red of the Middle Kingdom with the blue of the East.
- We won! Almost everything. But the important part was that everyone had fun.
- Team Purple won the Laurel and overall A&S highest score war points. The allies won the non-Laurel category. This issue features a few photos of some of the amazing entires.
- Team Purple also won the archery populace War points thanks to so many people coming out to shoot. It was recorded that, between all participants, 26,904 arrows were loosed.
- During the first week, the weather was unbearably hot and muggy. During the second week, it was much more pleasant, and temperatures shockingly dipped down into the 40s at night. It really is true to be prepared for anything when you are packing for Pennsic!
- The Order of the Mark is growing: Forester Gwyneth Cole and Forester Taliesin of Archenfield were put on vigil, and Master Jean Paul Pierrepont was elevated at Thursday's Royal court. A complete list of awards given at Pennsic 52 will be available in the next issue of "The Pale."
- Master Adam der Strom was elevated to the Order of Defense. He also shared the prize of best period German costume at the Midrealm Oktoberfest party with Baroness Emmeline von Kaltwasswer. Which award brought more excitement? Hard to say!
- Her Majesty Neassa was awarded the prize for most fun Oktoberfest costume, but she graciously awarded the pretzel crown to Forester Gwyneth Cole for her cute, retro, authentic Austrian dirndl.





