It was great to see people at the heraldic consultation tables, and I wanted to thank Master Llywus once again for coordinating Herald's Point and for holding down the fort—largely by himself!—all week. I'd also like to thank everyone who did list heraldry, site/cry heraldry, attended the heralds' meet-and-greet, and even just wore or displayed heraldry. You are seen and appreciated!

It's also my pleasure to announce that in partnership with Mistress Dragoslava, the Outlands will be hosting Virtual Known World and Heraldic Symposium (vKWHSS) over the weekend of January 23-25, 2026. Dragoslava and I are working on a website and a class submission form, which we will announce widely as soon as they're ready. If you're interested in assisting with this endeavor, please reach out! There's a couple of things I already know I could use help with.

In that same vein, I'd like to sponsor a full track of heraldry courses at A&S Collegium in September. If you have a heraldry class you want to teach, the class submission form can be found here: https://docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSd261Xe4hQgNLqJzlx4C09QaOV5nYyVSQVUZK5b5jDH2H-teg/viewform . Our good Wheel Herald (Maese Carlos) will be teaching a class on list and field heraldry, and I have several book heraldry classes that I am trying to decide between. If you're a herald (or even herald-adjacent!) and there's one or more specific areas of heraldry you'd like to take a class on, please reach out to me! I'm very happy to go looking for instructors for classes that people want to take.

Additionally, I wanted to once again remind heralds to please submit reports: Baronial heralds are required to report monthly, and other group heralds at least quarterly. I'm always happy to get more reports than fewer! I live in the far North of the Kingdom, and reports are how y'all tell me the good work you've been doing and let me know what problems you have been having. Reports are very easy to submit, just go to https://portal.outlands.org/officers/reports/submit/general and fill out the form.

Finally, I also wanted to put a plug in for award recommendations. Have you seen someone do cool stuff for a long time? Is someone overdue for recognition for the outstanding works they've been doing? Ever find yourself thinking "surely they have X award?!" Check their entry in the Order of Precedence at http://wimble.outlandsheralds.org/ and if they don't have it, put them in for it! It's super easy! Just go to https://portal.outlands.org/awards/recommendations, fill the form out, and hit Submit. (Also, if the person is a herald, or you're putting them in for something related to heraldry, do me a kindness and let me know as well!
