From the Society Seneschal

New Peerage Order Named

On April 12, 2025 at the Quarterly Meeting, the SCA Inc. Board of Directors voted to approve name, badge and regalia for the new peerage order celebrating those who have achieved a standard of excellence in prowess for ranged martial pursuits.



The Board approved 'the Order of the Mark' as the name for the new ranged peerage with badge is (Tinctureless) A set of nesting scale weights within and conjoined to a masle fleury at the upper point. The regalia of the Order will be two white vambraces or bracers.

The College of Arms will now finalize its registration processes with potential options having been previously pended in November 2024. Writs for the new peerage may be issued for 3 principals in each kingdom from 1 May 2025 with the Board having provided a variance to Corpora regarding the consultation as there is not yet an order to consult with.

From 7 June 2025, the Crowns of the Known World may commence elevations to the Order of the Mark.

The three principal members of the new order will be the Order with whom the Crown must consult, per Corpora. In other words, once those three Principals are elevated, no other writs will be issued without proper consultation with the Order.

Those three Principals are the deliberative body that will, in consultation with the Crown and in compliance with Corpora, be the foundation by which all future inductees into the Order will be considered. They are the bedrock on which the Order will be built and should not be considered lightly.

Let the celebrations commence!

She also tracks warrants expiration dates and advises when they or the officer's membership are within 90 days of expiration.



Baroness Liadan of Lochlainn, Deputy Kingdom Seneschal for Background checks, backgroundchecks@atenveldt.org. Her duties are to assist individuals requesting background checks with submission, ensuring they meet the qualifications for a background check and submitting the request to Society for processing. She will also work closely with the Kingdom Youth Officer and other Youth Activity Officers to ensure their background checks are in force and to assist in renewals.

Requests for Letters of Intent-Baron & Baroness of the Barony of Ered Sul

At the Too Hot event, the Crown and the Kingdom Seneschal will be polling for the Heirs of the Barony of Ered Sul. The reign of Baron Nilstr and Baroness Margre is coming to a close and they are looking to pass their leadership onto a new Baron and Baroness of the Barony of Ered Sul. To that end, we would ask that any interested parties submit their letters of interest to meet the following requirements:

- Baronial candidates must be a current paid member, and must receive their *Southwind* or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony in which they reside.
- Candidates must be at least 18 years old

Candidates must have Letters of Intent in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal and the Baron and Baroness no later than midnight May, 30th. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in the Baronial newsletter for the populace to review prior to the polling (with personal information redacted).

Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:

- Full contact information, including SCA and modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email, and membership numbers and expiration date
- Their reasons for seeking the position
- Their history of participation in the SCA and the Barony in which they reside
- Their plans for the future of the group
- Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of the Baronage
- Their statement that they are willing to be installed with their preference of either two or a three-year warrant in the position.

New/Updates Award Charters--BOA

Order of the Sable Gladius

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Atenveldt an award known as the Order of the Sable Gladius, which will be given by the Coronet of the Barony, subject to the pleasure of the Crown of Atenveldt, to those persons who have displayed excellence in the performance of the chivalrous art of heavy weapons combat.
2. The holders of this award shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Sable Gladius and shall be entitled to place the initials C. S. G. after their names.
3. The insignia of the Order shall consist of a silver medallion presented on a black ribbon or cord, whose design shall be: "Argent, two palm trees couped trunks crossed in saltire proper, and in chief a gladius sable." (pending approval of the College of Arms).
4. The award carries neither arms nor precedence.
5. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Coronet of the Barony after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
6. Companionship of previous recipients of this award is hereby confirmed.
7. The Coronet of the Barony of Atenveldt shall be the Principal of the Order. The Protector of the Order shall be the Crown of Atenveldt.

Order of the Vert Shamshir

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Atenveldt an award known as the Order of the Vert Shamshir, which will be given by the Coronet of the Barony, subject to the pleasure of the Crown of Atenveldt, to those persons who have displayed excellence in the performance of the chivalrous art of rapier combat.
 2. The holders of this award shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Vert Shamshir and shall be entitled to place the initials C. V. S. after their names.
 3. The insignia of the Order shall consist of a silver medallion presented on a green ribbon or cord, whose design shall be: "Argent, two palm trees couped trunks crossed in saltire proper and in chief a shamshir vert." (pending approval from the College of Arms).
 4. The award carries neither arms nor precedence.
 5. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Coronet of the Barony after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
 6. Companionship of previous recipients of this award is hereby confirmed.
- The Coronet of the Barony of Atenveldt shall be the Principal of the Order. The Protector of the Order shall be the Crown of Atenveldt.

Order of the Purple Ney

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Atenveldt an award known as the Order of the Purple Ney, which will be given by the Coronet of the Barony, subject to the pleasure of the Crown, to those persons who have displayed excellence in the performance of the Arts and Sciences.
2. The holders of this award shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Purple Ney and shall be entitled to place the initials C. P. N. after their names.
3. The insignia of the Order shall consist of a silver medallion presented on a purple ribbon or cord, whose design shall be: "Argent, two palm trees couped trunks crossed in saltire proper and in chief two flutes crossed in saltire purple. (pending approval of the College of Arms)
4. The award carries neither arms nor precedence.
5. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Coronet of the Barony after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
6. Companionship of previous recipients of this award is hereby confirmed.
7. The Coronet of the Barony of Atenveldt shall be the Principal of the Order. The Protector of the Order shall be the Crown of Atenveldt.

Order of the Argent Dart

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Atenveldt an award known as the Order of the Argent Dart, which will be given by the Coronet of the Barony, subject to the pleasure of the Crown of Atenveldt, to those persons who have displayed excellence in the chivalrous art of archery and/or ranged weapons.
2. The holders of this award shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Argent Dart and shall be entitled to place the initials C. A. D. after their names.
3. The insignia of the Order shall consist of a silver medallion presented on a white ribbon or cord, whose design shall be: "Gules, two palm trees couped trunks crossed in saltire and in chief a quarrel fesswise argent." (pending approval of the College of Arms).
4. The award carries neither arms nor precedence.
5. Amendments to this charter shall be made by the Coronet of the Barony after due consultation with the Crown of Atenveldt.
6. Companionship of previous recipients of this award is hereby confirmed.
7. The Coronet of the Barony of Atenveldt shall be the Principal of the Order. The Protector of the Order shall be the Crown of Atenveldt.

Order of the Heart's Flame

1. There shall exist in the Barony of Atenveldt an award known as the Order of the Palm Frond, which will be given by the Coronet of the Barony, subject to the pleasure of the Crown of Atenveldt, to those persons who have displayed a willingness to give ongoing service to the Barony of Atenveldt.
2. The holders of this award shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Palm Frond and shall be entitled to place the initials P.F.B.A. after their names.
3. The insignia of the Order shall consist of a silver medallion presented on a white ribbon or cord, whose design shall be: "Argent, two palm trees couped, trunks crossed in saltire and in chief a palm frond fesswise gules."
4. This award carries neither arms nor precedence.

Order of the Golden Hunting Horn

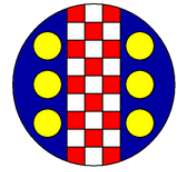

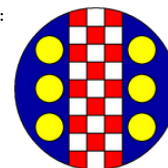
