Submission Guidelines for *The Pale*

ARTICLES on period topics, history, art, puzzles, SCA life, bardic stories and the like are welcome additions to *The Pale*. A 500- to 1000-word article will usually fit in one issue; longer articles will be split into multiple parts to appear in successive issues. Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html. Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

IMAGES, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at www.midrealm.org/chronicler.

EVENT PREVIEWS: A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. The listing **MUST include the name of the event, sponsoring group, site address, date, times and event steward contact information.**

EVENT NOTICES (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: Crown and Coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of Kingdom or Principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. **These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event.** The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be

submitted through the **online form** available on the calendar page. Contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary at calendar@midrealm.org with any issues. Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-Kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at <http://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale/>. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, website URL, name (SCA & modern) of the event steward, and a contact email address of the event steward. Simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All clip art images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. **All artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s). SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image.** Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.

PLEASE NOTE THAT MIDDLE KINGDOM EVENTS NO LONGER NEED TO PAY FOR ANY EVENT ADS AS OF OCTOBER 2016.

Hi, all,

Just a few reminders for this letter:

NMR checks and reports are due within 10 days of the event. This includes events that are donation only or charge no site fee. In those cases, no check is required, but you still need to report on the # of adults in attendance and the # of non-members.

On the event report, Paypal or SCORES fees can be listed as Fees & Honoraria - BUT on your monthly reports and Domesdays the fees go on the Income Detail page 11b under Paypal and SCARS Income Event.

Midrealm Groups may now use the SCA Online Registration and Event System (SCORES) as an alternative to Paypal for their event preregistration. Fee structure is comparable to Paypal. The event registration form is available from the Kingdom Exchequer. SCORES requests must be submitted far enough in advance that it may be processed (form is sent to Kingdom, who approves and then submits to Society) and available online for 30 days.

Middle Kingdom Chronicles - The Order of the Mark

May 3, 2025 was a historic day which saw the premieres of the Order of the Mark named for the Middle Kingdom. The privilege of naming the premieres fell to King Kilian and Queen Jalida at Their final court. The day began with an assemblage of the Greenwood Company, the Grant-level order for archery and thrown weapons. Coming from all parts of the Kingdom, at least 40 members traveled distances short and long to attend, including three of the original eight premieres. They lined the aisle and formed an arch of arrows as the King, Queen, barons, and baronesses processed beneath. The King and Queen invited them to stand at the dais as They addressed the populace. They spoke about the difficult decision They faced in having to name only three members to the new Order of the Mark, but that They had made Their choices based on input from the Greenwood Company, Red Company, and the established peerages.

Countess Aibhilin ni Dhomhnaill is perhaps best known as the mother of the Greenwood Company. In 1996 she, and her husband Tarquin the Red, served the Kingdom as the 52nd King and Queen. They created the Order of the Greenwood Company to recognize excellence in archery and thrown weapons. Countess Aibhilin has been a proponent of archery for her entire SCA career. She has served as Kingdom Archery Marshal, Kingdom Archery General, Pentamere Missile Weapons Marshal, and Pentamere Regional Archery Commander. She was made a member of the Order she created in 2001. In 2017 she was recognized as a Companion of the Order of the Pelican.

Baron Robert Thorne comes from a family of archers who have served the Kingdom, the Region of Midlands, and their Barony of Illiton for decades. Robert, tied with Master Fritz von Bare, has the highest score ever recorded in the Middle Kingdom in the Royal Round, a standardized shoot across the Known World, and is ranked as a Dragon Archer. His father, Master Gareth Thorne, shares this rank as well.

Order of the Mark - continued

In addition to target archery, Robert is an accomplished practitioner of the art of thrown weapons. Currently he is Earl Marshal of the Middle Kingdom and Territorial Baron of his home Barony of Illiton. Robert has held the positions of Middle Kingdom Deputy Archery Marshal, Middle Kingdom Thrown Weapons Marshal, Deputy Archer General, and Midlands Regional Archery Marshal. He was made a member of the Order of the Greenwood Company in 2000. In 2021 he was recognized as a Companion of the Order of the Pelican.

Forester Muldonny McVriw has been a driving force promoting archery in the North Oaken region for the better part of fifteen years. Muldonny is a three-time winner of the Schutzenfest, the highest level archery competition in the Middle Kingdom. He has taught many residents of North Oaken and beyond the art of making their own arrows. In addition to target archery, he has experimented with various thrown weapons and is an accomplished combat archer. He was archery champion to King Nikolai and Queen Serena and has served as Kingdom Archery General. He recently became the developer behind the SCA Scores site, taking over from its creator Sir Jonathas Reinisch, which tracks archery scores across the Known World. Muldonny was made a member of the Order of the Greenwood Company in 2016.




