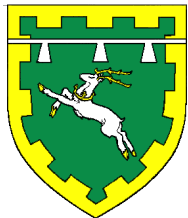

From the Heralds:

I write you today again concerning the College of Heralds of the Outlands. This is a continuing series of letters broadly about the structure of the College of Heralds of the Outlands (and College of Arms at the society level); the College is separated into three main categories, Book Heraldry (names & armor), Voice Heraldry, and Protocol Heraldry. Last month we discussed the Protocol heralds, this month we will talk about the secret fourth branch of Heralds: Administration.

The Administrative branch of the College of Heralds is led by White Stag, the Principal Herald. As THE kingdom herald, White Stag reports to Laurel Sovereign of Arms, the Society Herald. They are also the lead admin herald, and is supported by their emergency deputy, Palmer.

Weel is the chief education herald, who is responsible for spreading the heraldic arts and sciences for the other three branches, and helping White Stag edit the Heralds Handbook, the main administrative document for the College of Heralds.

And finally we come to Palmer Herald, the heir-apparent to White Stag, and their emergency deputy. Palmer is the herald preparing to step into the tabard of Kingdom Herald, or the recently departed herald supporting their successor officer.

I hope these letters have been informative to the populace, and if you have any questions about heraldry, the offices and the officers who fill them, please do not hesitate to reach out. We hope to be friendly and helpful folk.

The Bid deadline is November 20th of 2024 for 2026 Battlemoor. You will serve as Battlemoor Deputy Seneschal in 2025 and learn the role in preparation to become the 2026 Battlemoor Seneschal. Your proposed Mains should be deputies in 2025 in order to learn the roles and responsibilities.

Your bid must contain the following:

This may sound daunting, but let's explore each item.

This is about your stewarding team including your emergency deputies, as well as any confirmed division or department heads you have. It is understood that it is difficult to ask over 50 people to commit to an event almost a year in advance. However, for yourself and the person who will have to take over for you in an emergency it is needed. You and they must be willing to commit to this. Full information must be tendered as this will be used to create warrants, should you be successful in your bid.

Please see the Organization Chart for more information about your Division and Department heads.

Tell us who you are and what you have done in the SCA and in the Modern World.

Yes... WHY? Why do you want to devote your life to this project?

There is no right or wrong answer to this question, however writing "I think it would be really cool to ride around in a golf cart and tell people what to do", may not be your best choice of response.

This is required because in the past people often found out they were on someone's bid and had not been asked if they were willing to be. This eliminates the surprise factor. It also eliminates a bidder from "just putting names down" to make their bids look good.

The letter needs only contain the person's willingness to work for the bidder. It may be as simple as:

"I [Name of person], agree to work for [Name of the Bidder] in any capacity needed, should [Name of Bidder] be successful in becoming the Battlemoor Seneschal of [insert Battlemoor number]."

[Signed - Or - Email confirmation with full headers]

Here is where you can talk about any new concepts or plans you might have for "your Battlemoor". This is where you may further explain why you feel you would be the right person for this position.

Required Reporting

Battlemoor requires communication between the Battlemoor Seneschal (BMS), Mains, Kingdom Officers, and Crown. You can expect to participate in at least a monthly meeting between BMS and Mains. The Mains can expect to report to their corresponding kingdom officer as well via email or Google meeting. Internet access, email address, and phone service is required.

What If Modern Life Happens?

Battlemoor is a dynamic large 500+ person event with a budget approaching \$50,000. These situations can create a high stress environment. Not all people are prepared for interactions that can manifest under high stress environments. While event bid planning and having a mentorship learning process attempts to teach individuals how to deal with these stressful situations, not all staff will be a good fit for their roles. In addition, sometimes Modern Life can cause a case of the SCA Blues, affecting participation. As a Deputy of the Kingdom Seneschal, the Battlemoor Seneschal or Kingdom Seneschal may need to make personal changes due to these reasons. This will not be held against your event bid nor invalidate your bid.
