



The Aztec language, still spoken today by many of the indigenous of Mexico, has been spoken since at least the 7th century. In the language, the word auacatl, is the word for "testicle." This was used to describe the auacatl fruit, shaped like, well, you know. When the Spanish arrived in the 16th century, they merged the local word for the fruit, mashed, with the word for sauce, mole. Combining the two, you ended up with auaca-mole. Most people LOVE a good (g)uaca-mole... some tortilla chips... and now you know more random carp.
