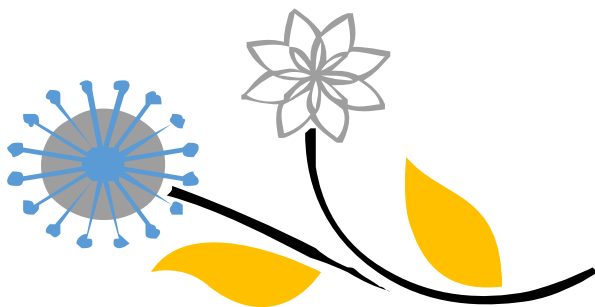

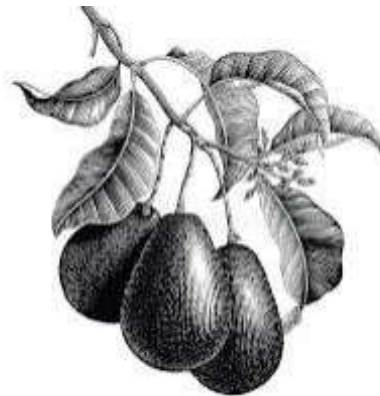


# Random Carp that I have learned...
