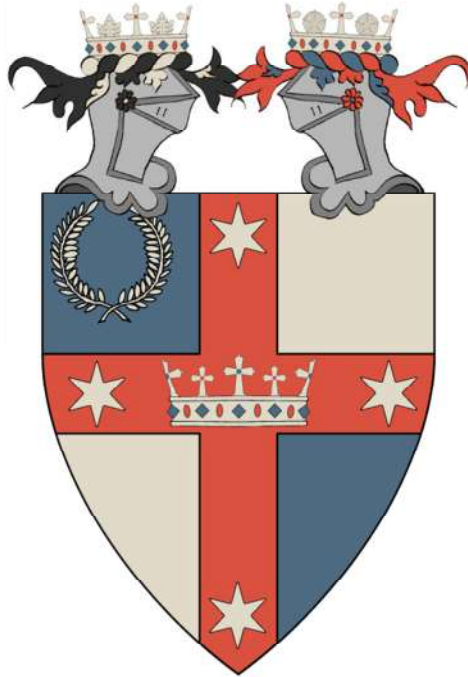
A Decree of Crown Tournament.

Let all know that on the ii day of September in the year of our society lviii within the lands of the Shire of Adora, there will be a very great tournament of arms, in appropriate armour with such heraldry displayed of the noble tourneyers as is the ancient custom, all clean, serviceable and acceptable to the eye. And each combatant shall have a named consort, for they shall be assaying the lists for the honour of being recognised as Heirs to the Crown of Lochac. Inasmuch as the Kingdom needs legitimate heirs to safeguard its future against any internal or external Threats, and as the Queen is beyond child-bearing and the King without recognised spawn of his loins, thus a Crown Tournament is necessary to identify successors.

And all combatants, whatsoever their station whether barons of the court, knights of the realm or but newly authorised in combat, are welcome, an their manner and demeanour be acceptable to Their Majesties and they being of 18 years or more. As always, chivalry and courtesy are to be honoured both on and off the field, by combatant and consort alike.

Should combatants number less than a dozen, the tourney will be that of a round robin; if more join the lists, combat will then be single kill, triple elimination as has been undertaken heretofore.

All contenders are called on to submit a Letter of Intent by no later than August xiv.



In the days of old, crests would be displayed before such a passage of arms, but these being cumbersome things not well suited to long travel, Their Majesties call for a display of any Letters of Intent worthy of admiration, whether for beauteous decoration, a fine hand or puissant words. For They would know of the inspiration to be taken from contemplating such combat or extolling the virtues of one's consort, or the grace to be gifted to the Kingdom by those who would vie to take the throne.

All should know that the burden of the Crown is a weighty thing, but that the joys that come with it may lighten even that.

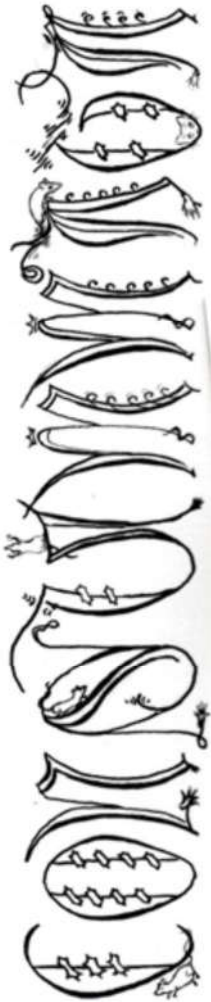
Note to self: add wings as per the bat? Carve spiral channels to aid stability? Further research is required.
