A.S.58, at 3:00pm.

An agenda and details of the proposed EK Law changes will be provided to those holding seats on the Curia via the dedicated e-list, and also posted on the Seneschal's web site, when they are available

At the last Curia of Their Royal Majesties Matthias and Æsa Feilinn, conducted ethereally in accordance with SCA, Inc. guidelines on 1 February 2024, A.S. 58, the following became East Kingdom Law.

The proposed changes to section V.C.3.g. (Crown's Youth Champions of Arms selection) were withdrawn from consideration at this Curia by the Crown.

#### The Curia Regis

- New III.A.3. (with renumbering) requiring at least one Curia per reign to be virtual or online; and
- Clarification of III.A.4.a. officer reports as from Greater Kingdom Officers, per custom.

#### Kingdom Officers

- Revisions to IV.B.1., new IV.B.12., and deletion of IV.C.4. (with renumbering) to raise the Kingdom DEIB Officer to a Greater Officer; and
- Revisions to IV.C.1. of the Kingdom Accessibility Porter's reporting and duties.

## Coronation of Tindal II and G. Emerson True April 6, Barony of Concordia of the Snows (Schenectady, NY)

The time draws near for the Barony of Concordia of the Snows to welcome all to the Coronation of Tindal II and G. Emerson True!

The site is the First Methodist Church of Schenectady, which was to have been the site of the Coronation of Tindal I and Alberic, had the Plague not forced us all to make other plans.

The schedule for the day will be posted as it is assembled.  
10 a.m. -- Last Court  
3 p.m. -- Curia

Please note site restrictions. On the entire site (interior and exterior), there shall be no:

- Weapons or fighting.
- Alcohol.
- Smoking.
- Live flames.

## Notes:

We have an exemption to the weapons ban for the Sword of State and a couple of ceremonial wooden halberds; beyond that, the only blades permitted will be cutlery. The fighting ban includes children with boffers.

The entire site is absolutely dry.

Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the church grounds.

Candles, etc., may add to the ambience, but any flames must be battery-powered.

Parking is available on or near the site.

A dayboard presented by the Cooks Guild of Concordia is included with the site fee. The evening feast will be prepared by noted East Kingdom culinary masters.

Sunday morning will feature a garbed hike up Bradbury Mountain and possibly a bit of fencing at the top.
