East Kingdom Spring Crown Tourney May 3-5, Shire of Lyndhaven (Upper Gagetown , NB)

Spring Crown Tourney 2024 will be the first Kingdom event at our excellent site. The site will be open Friday, May 3rd, at 5 pm for those travelling a distance.

Saturday will feature the lists in the center field or the main hall, depending on the weather. We can offer space for up to twelve lists to be run simultaneously on the main field. Also, the site is equipped with six indoor showers and toilets for the fighters after their bouts.

At the pleasure of their Majesties, we have room for court either in the main feast hall or in the open-air amphitheatre.

The site boasts six double cabins, with sixteen single bunk beds per side, and an attached modern washroom between. The cabins are unheated, but there are plugs for space heaters and CPAP machines. If your household wishes to be bunked in a cabin together, please include who you wish to be cabin sharing with on the google doc's form at the time of your reservation. There is also generous space to camp in tents should attendees wish to do so. No open fires are permitted on the grounds.

The site is a church camp and thereby very discreetly damp.

Great Western Regional FARE May 30-Jun 2, Kingdom of Northshield (Fargo, ND)

The Shire of Korsvag will be hosting the Great Western Regional FARE! This even is a Fighting, Archery, Rapier, and Equestrian Event (FARE) which will focus on all major activities that the SCA offers as well as a few new activities.

The facility consists of a full-size archery range, thrown weapons range, equestrian track and field, tenting for 200 tents, a fighting field for both Rapier and Heavy and an outdoor stand to watch all equestrian activities. Part of the archery range will be used for night shooting. Additionally, there will be a large focus on equestrian activities, authorizations and demonstrations. The archery field will be split to allow for more than one tournament to occur.

An area is available for merchants if any plan to attend. The fighting field is large enough to have more than one tournament at a time or a tournament and melee at the same time.
