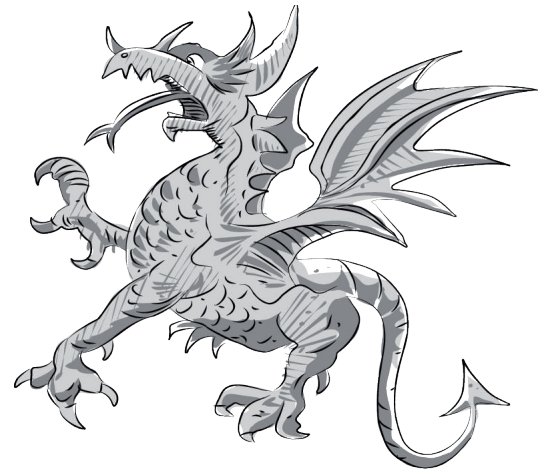

Submission Guidelines

The deadline for the Dragon's Tale is the 25th of the month that is two months before the issue date (e.g., the December issue deadline is 25 October). Submissions for the Dragon's Tale should be sent to dragonstale@drachenwald.sca.org. Material should be sent in MS Word, RTF or plain text. Send photographs and artwork as separate files. Note that event announcements will be standardised in format. Original work (articles, photographs, artwork) must be accompanied by a permission form <http://www.drachenwald.sca.org/sites/default/files/permission.pdf> or the equivalent words in an email. Any copyrighted material by others must be accompanied by written permission from the original author(s). Please check the licence/usage terms of any clip-art used. The Dragon's Tale is set using Scribus 1.4.6 with Garamond, Arial, Arial Narrow, Lucida Handwriting and UBW Chancery typefaces in various sizes. The Dragon's Tale logo is in Tyrfinng Demo typeface.

Event Scheduling and Announcements

Events must be scheduled on the Kingdom Calendar before the event announcement is sent. This can be done by filling in the calendar event date request form on the Kingdom web page: <https://drachenwald.sca.org/events/calendar-add/> Announcements should then be written and can be updated directly to the web form or sent separately to the Chronicler.

Event announcements must include:

- Name of official SCA sponsoring group.
- The name (Society), and email address of the autocrat.
- Site street address (if no address, you must mention that in the announcement).
- Date of the event.
- Starting/stopping time of the event .
- Cost and Payment information (if there is a fee).

You are encouraged to include:

- Name and contact details of Marshal-in-Charge (if there is combat).
- Reservation deadlines, if any.
- URL for the full announcement
- Restrictions, if any (pets, open fires, alcohol) etc.
- Information about what the event is about
- Information about accommodation, meals etc.
- Other contacts (reservations, cook etc.)

- Their Majesties first demonstrated the Challenge game with the event site tokens. King Krake challenged Queen Beatrix to a game of rock, paper, scissors. Queen Beatrix was victorious, so King Krake deposited a token into the appropriate jar to accumulate points for the Queen's side in the Knäkebrod War.

- Þora Sumarliðadóttir, Admiral and keeper of Drachenwald's Interests over All the Seas and Fisheries and Trade from upon the lands whereupon the sun does not set in the summer, nor does rise in the winter came to pay taxes and tributes as is their duty by right and custom. Þora explained that in the Lofoten islands, in the far north of Norway, where she lives, the taxes to the Kingdom traditionally consist of one fish for every 20 caught. Therefore Þora brought forth the Crown's share for this year, and also several years of back taxes which had not been paid on account of plague reduced travel. Þora then proceeded to fill King Krake's hands with fish, and when that overflowed, had Queen Beatrix hold our her skirts to catch the rest of the fish.

I hope that you have all seen the good work that the kingdom web team has done to give the Order of Precedence (OP) website a facelift: <https://op.drachenwald.sca.org/>

You may also have noticed if you use the "Advanced search" that there are very few modern names listed? This is not a mistake but rather a strategy to move from an "opt-out" position regarding publishing everyone's modern names, to an "opt-in" so that people can have more control over what information regarding themselves is made public.

Medieval painting, pigment and egg tempera

A while back I felt like trying to paint with egg tempera, and I had a few bentwood boxes that I could try on. I'm not very creative when it comes to painting and creating patterns and pictures, but wanted to add some extra flair to the boxes! But first, I'll give you a short background on medieval painting and pigments.

Before the invention of oil paint, artists and painters made paint by grinding stones and minerals into powders, mixing these coloured pigments with egg yolk. The yolk acted as a binding agent. Sometimes honey was added to keep the paint from drying too quickly, and water was also added to thin the paint to desired thickness. The balance of mixing these ingredients is difficult. Mixing too little of a colour creates the challenge of doing the exact same thing as you did before when you need more paint. But you also didn't want to mix too much since these pigments often were expensive and precious materials.

The earliest, reliably analysed, use of egg tempera is a mummy portrait from the 4th century. But there are also written sources mentioning pigments and binding agents. Pliny, a 1st century Roman naturalist, specifically writes that Romans were familiar with the use of egg yolk in paint.

With the rise of Christianity and its need for narrative images; murals, altarpieces and icons, egg tempera was in wide use throughout the Middle ages. It became the primary medium of Early Christian icon painters and was also commonly used in illuminated manuscripts. Other paints in use were those made with egg white (glair), gum arabic (watercolour) and paints made with animal glue.

By the start of the Renaissance in the early 1400s, egg tempera had become the principal form of painting on easels. Both in Italy and other parts of Europe. In Northern Europe, oil paints were also in use, but not very widespread. Oils were used in decorative painting throughout the middle ages, and probably earlier. These early oils were generally dark, thick and not very well suited for easel painting. This got better during the 1400s, and the oils became lighter in tone, dried faster and became easier to work with.

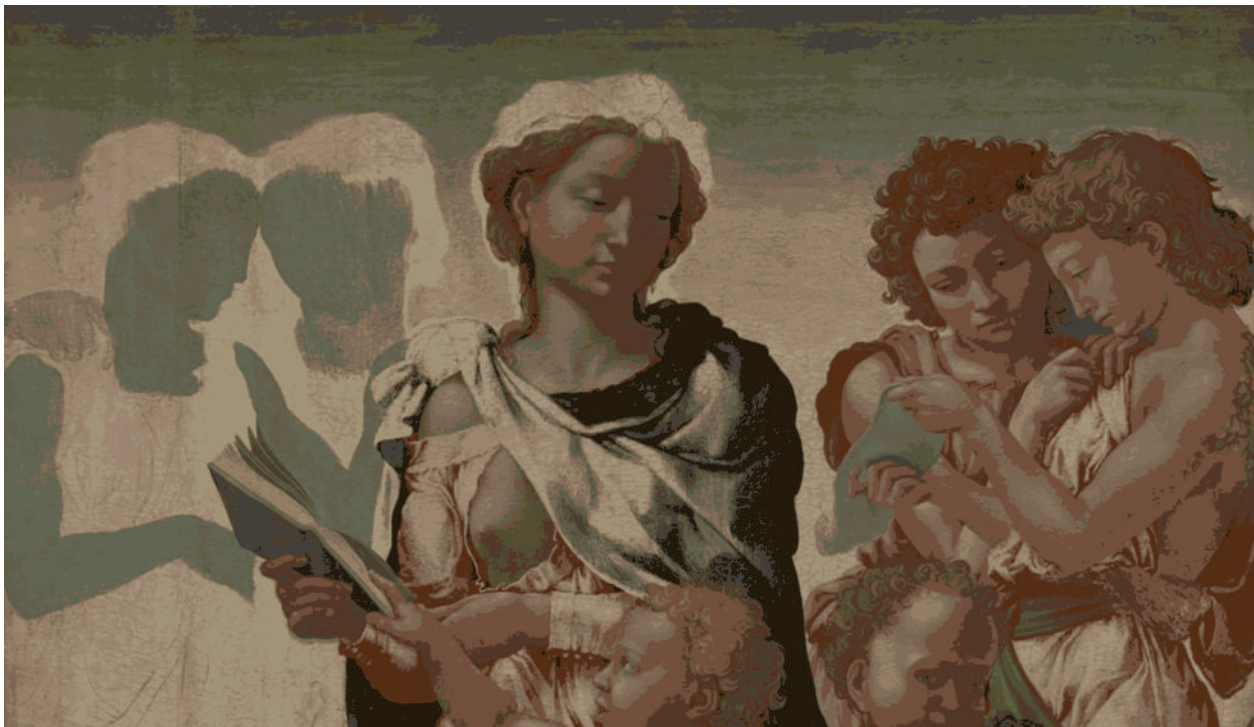
Oil can be applied thickly, and the opacity to lights make them pop more. Tempera on the other hand must be applied in thin layers. This makes oil paint better for creating natural lights and more realistic imagery.

In the mid and late Renaissance, the artists painted in a variety of ways. Some continued to work in pure egg tempera, some combined and did tempera underpaintings and overpaintings in oil. Some artists worked with both tempera and oil depending on which colour they worked with, some works better in egg tempera, some in oil. Some even mixed the both mediums and made tempera grassa. And of course some converted fully to oil.

Egg tempera fell out of fashion during the 16th century and was only used by icon painters.

So, a quick art lesson would be that:

Panel paintings before 1400 is most likely egg tempera.



Panel paintings from 1400 to 1500 can either be egg tempera, oil, or a combination of the two. But the later in the 1400s the work was painted, the more likely it is oil. If the brushstrokes are more linear, it suggest egg tempera. If they're more smooth and blended, it suggest oil or tempera grassa. Panel paintings by the early 1500s are nearly all painted in oil.

That was the mediums, what about the pigments?

According to a chemical analysis done on 14 Swedish medieval churches and their murals from the 12th-15th centuries, there are a few pigments that were commonly used during the time period. These are pigments used in Sweden during the middle ages, to paint in churches with. If they're also pigments used to paint other things with, I am not sure. But at least we know they were available during the time, and used for painting.

Black: carbon black, magnetite, plattnerite, tenorite, metacinnabarite

White: lime, gypsum, ceruse

Yellow: yellow ochre, massicot,orpiment, lead-tin yellow, Naples yellow, gold, copper vanadate

Red: iron (III) oxide, red ochre, lead red/minium, cinnabar

Violet: caput mortuum

Brown: umber, ochre

Green: malachite, atacamite, green earth, green vivianite, copper sulphate

Blue: ultramarine, azurite, blue vivianite, smalt



Medieval painting, pigment and egg tempera

2 weeks back I wrote about Medieval painting, but how do we use egg tempera?

You'll need an egg, some pigments, a small mixing vessel, a toothpick, water and a brush!

Start by cracking the egg and separate the yolk from the white. When all the white is gone, you gently place the yolk in the palm of your hand and carefully roll the yolk from one hand to the other, while wiping your free hand on a paper towel to remove any excess egg white.

When the yolk is completely dry, gently pinch it between two fingers, hold it over a small vessel and puncture the egg sac with a toothpick. Empty the sac into the vessel and then discard the yolk sac.

Now, add your powdered pigments to the yolk a little at a time and mix until it is fluid and can be used with a brush. Tempera paint that is too thin or thick will crack when it dries. But have a go a try, that's the best



way to learn.

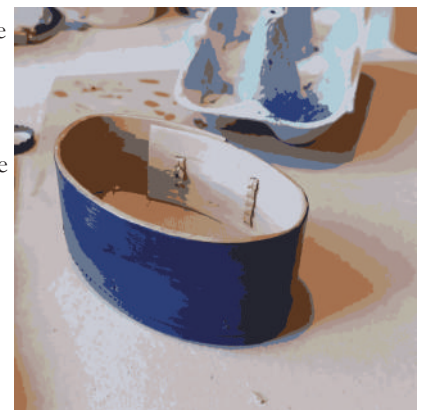
The next

step is to paint away! Regardless of what you're painting, clean it before and dry it so the tempera has a good base. When it comes to drying times, the messages are very different. If you're doing a full painting, the drying time can be 6-12 months. Other sources say that egg tempera dries very quickly due to the thin layers of paint. And I'd agree with the last verdict. Do thin layers and build the depth of colour that way.

I made too much paint for the surface I had to paint, so you don't have to use an entire yolk! I probably made it too thick as well, too saturated. So next time I'll make less paint, and thinner.

As I mentioned in the previous post about painting mediums, some artist in the renaissance incorporated both egg tempera and oil in their paintings. Simply because the mediums had different characteristics. Since egg tempera doesn't darken or yellows with age, it's a good choice for parts of an image with light values and/or cool colours, such as whites or blues. Areas with dark values on the other hand, was painted on oil since darks in oil are more saturated and deeper.
