

- ◇ **A statement of the reasons you wish to be Crown and goals should you ascend**
- ◇ **A listing of SCA events you have attended in the last 12 months**

Please also review Kingdom Law and Corpora to ensure you meet the requirements for participation. If you have any questions regarding your qualification, please reach out to Our Seneschal promptly.

Crown Tournament will be fought in bouts of two-out-of-three unless the list becomes so large that this would make the tournament excessively long. The Crown will make the final decision regarding bouts the day of the tournament. No weapons restrictions will be imposed.

We thank all of you for your kindness and support of Our beautiful Heartland. We look forward to seeing you again soon!

CALL FOR APPLICANTS - LAUREL PRINCIPAL SOVEREIGN OF ARMS

The Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) is seeking candidates for the position of Laurel Principal Sovereign of Arms (Laurel).

Laurel is the principal heraldic officer of the Society and the head of the College of Arms and is responsible for fostering the study and practice of heraldry, supervising the processing of submissions, and overseeing the heraldic activities of the Known World.

Laurel is an unpaid position, currently requiring approximately 20 hours a week. The position requires considerable tact and patience, armory and onomastic knowledge, supervisory ability, the ability to work within tight deadlines and coordinate closely with Wreath, Pelican, and other staff to produce a Laurel Letter of Acceptance and Return monthly, computer literacy and word processing skills, reliable e-mail and telephone access, and time and ability to travel.

Calontir!

Ah, fall, my favorite time of year. There's something about the crisp cool days, and I really enjoy Halloween. I'll talk about some Halloween-related heraldic things after I get some business out of the way. First, we have a new permanent Saker Herald. Mistress Dorcas Whitecap took this up on an interim basis back in the summer, but it's now her job for real. If you need to figure out some trick to get what you want passed, she might have some ideas.

This is also the case for the Blue Hawk Herald, our OP Clerk. Agnes von Heidelberg did a great job getting us caught up, and she'll continue on. Assisting her will be Mistress Emeline de Moulineaux. They're making sure all the treats get recorded.

How was that for a smooth Halloween reference? Anyway, I've been blessed with so many wonderful applicants over the past six months, and I want to thank all who've volunteered. Calontir is blessed with so many capable and generous people.

Now let's get to the fun part, Spooky Heraldry. There are 34 current instances where skeletons have been registered. Fish skeletons form a surprisingly large number of these. Of course, there are human skeletons, some with wings and then you see a few odd ones, including a crane, a dragon, and a unicorn skeleton.

I find the fish skeletons fun, because the word skeleton comes from the Proto-Indo-European word for "to parch, wither," or in other words, to make dry. Along those lines, in Greek "skeleton" also meant "mummy."

You can get a pumpkin on your device, and eight people

have registered those. What you can't do is register "orange," at least as its own color, or tincture. If you want orange, and there are more than a few people who have heraldry that displays orange, you have to register gules and simply use artistic license.

Not only can you have bats on your heraldry, you can have demi-bats, not to mention all sorts of bat-winged creatures. I love the etymology of bat, which comes in part from the Old Norse leðrblaka, which means literally "leather flapper."

Now I'm thinking of Michael Keaton playing Leather Flapper Man, saving everyone in Gotham City. Perfect for a Halloween disguise.

On to werewolf, which is also something you can register, as four people have done in the SCA. The "were" part of the name means "human." Note the Anglo-Saxon concept of wergild, or money to pay for a life.

This word actually goes all the way back to Proto-Indo-European, meaning there are cognates as we'd expect. The fun one here is in ancient Persia where the month corresponding to Halloween is called Varkazana, which literally means "month of the wolf-men." How cool is that?

There are all sorts of monsters in heraldry, and I don't mean creatures like werewolves, dragons, griffons, and the like. No, I mean specifically monsters registered as "monster." These are creatures with a variety of forequarters, or hindquarters, heads, wings, or whatever. You can choose just about any combination that you want, just stick a whole bunch of creatures together that you like. Just mash them all into one monstrous beast. In other words, in heraldry, you can do the mash, the Monster Mash.

Hope that was more treat than trick and you all have a graveyard smash for Halloween.

Changes to Kingdom Law as read into the final court of Agamemnon and Marie on October 7th, 2023 in the lands of the Barony of the Lonely Tower.

Article II.400: (Law Change)

(Original) When the Crown wishes to change Statutory Law, the Witan will be informed of the proposed changes. The changes will be read in an official court and published.

(Revised) When the Crown wishes to change Statutory Law, the Witan will be informed of the proposed changes. The changes will be read in an official court and published. No new statutory law or changes to statutory law will take effect until

the end of the reign in which the law or change is approved.

Article VI.101: (New Timing Crown Tournament)

(Original) The Crown List for the Kingdom of Calontir will be held the first full weekend of June, and the first full weekend of December, except for unusual circumstances defined by the Crown.

(Revised) Until December 2023, the Crown List for the Kingdom of Calontir will be held the first full weekend of June and the first full weekend of December, except for unusual circumstances defined by the Crown. After December 2023, the Crown List for the Kingdom of Calontir will be held the second weekend in April and the second weekend in November, except for unusual circumstances defined by the Crown.

Article VI.500: (New Timing Coronation)

(Original) The Coronation for the Kingdom of Calontir will be held the first full weekend of April, and the first full weekend of October, except for unusual circumstances defined by the Crown.

(Revised) Until March 2024, the Coronation for the Kingdom of Calontir will be held the first full weekend of April, and the first full weekend of October, except for unusual circumstances defined by the Crown. The Coronation for the Kingdom of Calontir will be held the second weekend in February and the second weekend in July, except for unusual circumstances defined by the Crown.

I've two announcements to make. First, I'd like to put forth this proposed change to the requirements for four of the RUSH degrees. Please take a moment to read through this and send your comments to TRM's by November 18 2023.

Proposed Changes:

Auditor Artis

Requirements (class prefixes included):

- 4 hrs. SCA history/culture COMP; SCA
- 2 hrs. basic heraldry HERL
- 2 hrs. fighting/fighting appreciation/archery ARMR; LIST; MISS; WARS
- 3 hrs. performing arts DANC; DRAM; MUSC
- 3 hrs. medieval history HIST
- 2 hrs. medieval philosophy/theology/mathematics/law LAW; MATH; PHIL
- 3 hrs. adornment CLAC; CLER; CLNR; FIBR; JEWL; NEDL
- 3 hrs. life arts BREW; CHIR; COOK; HERB
- 3 hrs. life sciences EQUUS; FIRE; LETH; METL; SCI; SHIIP; TENT; WOOD
- 3 hrs. fine arts A&A; GAME; LANG; LIT; MSCR

In order to successfully fulfill the requirements for the Auditor Artis degree, a student must complete forty (40) class credit divided as indicated above, with 28 specified topics and 12 electives.

PROPOSED CHANGE

Auditor Artis: Requirements: 30 classes of any prefix. Classes must span at least 3 different prefixes.

Lector Artis : In order to successfully fulfill the requirements for the Lector Artis Degree, a student must complete sixty (60) class credit from the University, including the completion of the Auditor Artis Degree. The student may choose to concentrate in a specific area or pursue a general course of study for the additional twenty (20) classes.

PROPOSED CHANGE

Lector Artis: In order to successfully fulfill the requirements for the Lector Artis Degree, a student must complete the Auditor Artis Degree, an additional twenty (20) classes, as well as an A&S presentation in the form of an A&S entry with feedback, or presented to a member of the RUSH board.

- To complete the RAC Auditor requirements, a total of twenty (20) classes of credit are required with 15 specified topics and 5 classes of electives.

PROPOSED CHANGE

RAC Auditor: To complete the RAC Auditor requirements, a total of fifteen (15) classes of credit are required. Classes must span at least 3 different prefixes.

RAC Lector: In order to successfully fulfill the requirements for the RAC Lector Degree, a student must complete thirty (30) class credit from the University, including the completion of the RAC Auditor Degree. The student may choose to concentrate in a specific area or pursue a general course of study for the additional fifteen (10) classes.

PROPOSED CHANGE

RAC Lector: In order to successfully fulfill the requirements for the RAC Lector Degree, a student must complete the RAC Auditor Degree. The student may choose to concentrate in a specific area or pursue a general course of study for the additional ten (10) classes.







For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: <https://www.calontir.org/events/> For information on how to submit a flyer please visit: <https://www.calontir.org/chronicler/>

Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:

- ◆ Day month and year of the event
- ◆ Site open & close times for populace
- ◆ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ◆ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ◆ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ◆ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

**Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member
Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 /
Children 5 & Under: FREE**

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1st of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
