

Since the CovidSafe policy was withdrawn there has been some confusion about what information needs to be on event flyers and webpages. The Kingdom Chronicler has been adding this language to event notices she has received. A BIG thank you to Anne for that.

Please remember these officers are SCA members just like you. They take these positions because it is a job that must be done and they want to help the SCA function and succeed. While you may not agree with the decisions made, you may not have all the information they have, and often they are not allowed to share the information with you due to privacy concerns. That Aprilis, with his shoures swoot, he thinks heraldry is coole!

Well, maybe not April, but Chaucer certainly did, and we know this not just because of Paul Bettany's excellent performance in *A Knight's Tale*. Chaucer mentions heralds and heraldic things several times in *The Canterbury Tales* and in other works. For example, he says in *The Flower and the Leaf*, "And after them came a great company of heraldes and pursuivantes eke." He then follows with having them do all sorts of cool heraldic things.

You know who Chaucer would think is cool? Her Excellency Genevieve de Chambery, Baroness of Vatavia. She is our rock star this month. Find her entry on the Order of Precedence here: https://www.calontir.org/persona/1193. You can talk to her about heraldry and all the things she's done with it at Coronation on April 8th. We both hope to see you all there.

Her device is purpure, on a chevron throughout or three fleur-de-lys palewise gules, in base a fleur-delys or. She likes long walks on the beach, lilies, purple, and gold. With a bit of red.

Want proof? She has a badge, too: Purpure, a fleur-de-lys per pale or and gules. Note all the same elements. You should ask why she created the badge as well as the device, especially with it being so similar.

One specific question I suggest you ask is how one can use heraldry with pottery.

Shockingly, Her Excellency's heraldry prompted me to riff on fleur-de-lys this month. The easy part here is the etymology, as fleur is "flower" in French and lys (or lis) is "lily."

By the way, since I started with The Canterbury Tales,

the Friar's Tale has this line: "His neck was white as is the fleur-de-lis." In Middle English, it's also called the "flour delice" (flower of joy) and "flour de luce" (flower of light). We see this in *The Faerie Queene* from Edmund Spenser. "The lilly, Ladie of the flowring field, The Flowre-deluce, her louely Paramoure."

Hmmm, that brings up a philosophical question. Is the War of the Lilies Calontir's "louely paramoure?" Since such questions are best discussed with beverages around a fire, this proves that heraldry can drive you to drink, but in a good way. Usually.

Now, the most obvious association of the fleur-de-lys in heraldry is the French royal coat of arms, which currently has three fleurs-de-lys in a triangle (it used to have a bunch). This use of fleurs-de-lys in French heraldry goes back to a seal of the future Louis VIII in 1211. However, French monarchs used it in the 1100s. For example, in 1179, Louis VII ordered fleurs-de-lys on the coronation clothing of his son Philip II, also called Philip Augustus.

They started using fleurs-de-lys to associate the French rulers with saintliness and divine right. There were a couple reasons for this. First, it previously represented saints, in particular the Virgin Mary and St. Joseph. Also, they believed the oil that anointed Clovis I when he converted to Christianity had been poured out of a vessel with a fleur-de-lys on it.

Side note: Philip was crowned in 1179 as *Rex Francorum*, King of the Franks. However, in 1190, he started styling himself as *Rex Francie*, the first king to call himself King of France. A subtle, but important difference to scholars and heralds focused on ceremony, like say, me.

Oh, look, I had another digression. Nobody expected that, I'm sure. Just like the Spanish Inquisition. But that's *another* digression, and we have more to cover

when it comes to fleurs-de-lys.

While we start with the French when discussing the lily in heraldry, it's all over the place. The golden lily is the traditional symbol of the Bosnians people. A fleur-de-lys is on the coat of arms of Florence (we'll get back to this one in a moment). It was on the badge of the Canadian Expeditionary Force during World War One (This one is important to me personally because my grandfather served in the CEF in 1916). Oh, and then there's the planet Naboo, which has a stylized fleur on its flag.

And let's not forget the New Orleans Saints.

I said we'd get back to Florence. The device of Florence is a red fleur on a white background. What's cool isn't that it's the same as Calontir's original colors, which it is as we talked about last month, but that this *isn't* the original heraldry. It was, originally, a white fleur on a red background.

The conflict between Guelphs and Ghibellines was especially fierce in Florence. Now, I won't go too deep into this conflict, otherwise this issue of the Mews would be something like 500 pages long, but suffice to say it was basically a fight between those who supported the Holy Roman Emperor (Ghibellines) and those who supported the Pope (Guelphs).

The original heraldry of white fleur on red background became the standard of the imperial party in Florence, otherwise known as the *parte ghibellina*. However, the town government were staunch allies of the Guelphs, so they reversed the colors to show their preference.

In other words, in Florence during this time, they had their own War of the Lilies.

And I absolutely find that cool.

EVENT FLYER GUIDELINES

For Their Majesties to hold Court, or any official business to occur, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event.

Before sending an event flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. Check the Kingdom Calendar at: https://www.calontir.org/events/ For information on how to submit a flyer please visit: https://www.calontir.org/chronicler/

For an event to be considered complete and published, so official Kingdom business can be carried out, an event announcement MUST contain these **SIX ITEMS**:

- Dates of the event- day and month
- Event time: when site opens & closes to the populace
- Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event Steward, including contact phone and email. (Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

 Details of Registration : Do NOT use "FEE" as a describer for registration cost.

Example of wording for Registration:

Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 / Children 5 & Under: FREE

Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. If you wish to send a PDF, you are more than welcomed. However, I need a version I am able to edit, because sometimes that PDF just will not convert correctly and I would like to keep your flyers looking nice.

Deadline: The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1**st **of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event**. (e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st.) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
