We are in need of this rare find, someone who is willing to take on this most important role of Lochac Seneschal! Baron Porvaldr inn Suðreyski has to step down from this illustrious position due to "Life" and this position needs to be filled.

Applications are now being sought from those who feel they have the skills and passion to take this role for the next two years. The successful applicant will be appointed upon completion of the selection process and a handover is finalised.

To be eligible for this role you must be at least 18 years old, a current member, acceptable to the Crown, Society Seneschal and the two local incorporations (SCA Ltd and SCA NZ Inc).

To successfully apply, you will need to: provide full SCA and mundane CVs demonstrating relevant knowledge, experience and character. Items to be considered in your application may include the following:

- Excellent communication skills - especially a high level of responsiveness via email but also to a reasonable extent via instant messaging and remote meetings
- Understanding of the current policies and procedures needed to ensure sound governance at all levels across the Kingdom and Society, and ways to promote same
- Strong understanding of the respective roles and responsibilities of the Crown, Seneschallate, Kingdom Officers and Societal officers in managing our affairs
- Awareness of the diversity of our great kingdom including the differing jurisdictions between Australia and NZ, policies of SCA Ltd and SCA NZ Inc., and across Australian states
- Knowledge of Corpora, Kingdom Law and procedures and local traditions
- Ability to work with and actively support diverse Kingdom Officers and group Seneschals and help make their roles easier and more successful
- Time and flexibility to work on important issues as they arise and needs your immediate attention
- Ability to inherit, shape and work with a diverse, creative team of helpful and capable deputies so you don't have to handle all the demands of the role solo
- Patience, especially with people who have a knack for probing such limits



- A strong sense of natural justice, fairness and proper process when issues arise that demand significant attention. This is in direct relation to handle difficult or wearying disputes and investigations without cracking too obviously and without losing so much sleep that you can no longer function effectively
- A strong strategic sense, especially regarding the need to ensure consistently-excellent recruitment and retention throughout the Kingdom
- A proven track record of making complex things simpler without sacrificing the elements essential to proper governance

Festival is only "two weeks away"... are you getting everything together!

This missive will have a bit of information about festival. It maybe a bit long...

Campsites

There will be a significant change to the campsite allocations this year. As many know, last year we had to move a number of sites due to wet ground. These sites will not be returning to those areas.

Many campsites are in the process of being sited. As we have needed to move camps from the bottom of the hill, we are now utilising the space out towards the archery and equestrian areas. We are in the process of liaising with Wombaroo regarding new water and east points. One significant factor in allocating space to camps is the number of persons who are booked for that site. This is one reason why bookings are important.

Maps

That previous years maps are not fit for use this year. Campsite maps are not able to be released until at least one week after bookings are closed in March. This ensures we have correct numbers for campsites. A campsite needs a minimum of five (5) persons to be listed on the map. Village Green

This year the Village Green is being relocated up the hill on the other side of the high ropes. This area is flatter, and will be more accessible to the new layout of the site.

Tavern

This year there will be no licence for the tavern. We have spoken with Lady Isabella from the Salty Bint and they have advised they will not be running the tavern. This has a couple of outcomes:

- This year there will not be any tavern mugs for sale, and
- There will be new proprietors for the tavern. There will be more information to come. Watch this space.
