Please demonstrate the courteousness, honor, and joy of our kingdom. You are each an ambassador of Meridies.



Greetings from the Chatelaine

If this was your first war... I hope you had a blast! A few years back Gulf Wars was my first event, and I wouldn't change it for anything. There were lots of well-meaning people that suggested it might be overwhelming and to wait a bit, I'm glad I went anyway.

That being said, it does take lots of preparation and you may need to reach out for some help. Luckily there are many resources available.

If you are contemplating your first war, this is the article for you! We will help you plan for the best experience ever!

War is something you have to throw yourself into, participate and let it happen. If at all possible, go the full time and camp on-site. While comforts of a hotel or air bnb are nice, you'll miss a lot of good stuff leaving site.

Find yourself a camp and get to know the people a little beforehand, even if it's just online. Pick your camp well, it will be your home for a week.

There are many ways to find a group to camp with at war. You can look through the different online groups to find a camp or check with your Kingdom or even local group. There are camps for people with disabilities, family friendly camps and party camps, art-oriented camps and service-oriented camps.

Find out who the Camp master is for the group you are going to camp with and contact them. That person will let you know the details of how the camp is arranged. Some may have camp fees to help with group expenses. Some will even have meal plans so you won't have to cook!

Once you know the name of the camp it'll be time to pre-register. You'll find

the registration on the webpage of all wars, including Gulf. Payment can be made before the event via PayPal.

When you register, make sure you list the name of the group you are camping with. It is how the campsite makes sure there is enough space in the group for each camper.

Welcome to war preparation time! It's almost as exciting as war itself. Here is a list of items you will need first:

- A tent: Look for something sturdy, waterproof, and one you can set up yourself. If you need help, it might be best to let your camp mates know so the can be prepared to help you with it onsite.
- Bedding: I suggest a cot or simple bed frame to keep you off the ground, though air mattresses will work as well. Don't forget blankets and pillows. Sleeping bags are good but keep in mind it may be cold or hot on any given day as we camp in any weather.
- Lighting: Make sure you have light for your tent and to carry with you.
 Camp lights, flashlights and/ or headlamps work well.
- Clothing: First, invest in some rugged totes/bins to keep your clothes in. Leave at least one set of street clothes and a garb outfit in the vehicle in case of emergency.

What to wear, what to wear? Since it may be wet, dry, hot, cold on any given day, layers are your friend.

- one long or semi-long tunic—It is great to just throw on to leave your tent for the bathroom or grab coffee in the morning.
- Two pairs of socks per day—wet feet are terrible.

- As much garb as you can gather
 Pack at least one garb outfit a day minimum.
- A cloak, cape, coat, or a warm wool/fleece blanket that can serve as such.
- Head coverings such as hats, hoods, veils.
- Comfortable shoes, you'll be walking a lot.

At the time I thought that was overkill and didn't quite have enough. I was, however, glad for every piece of garb I did pack; the advice was not wrong.

- Food: Though there are food vendors on site or your camp may have a meal plan, bring some easy food anyway. You'll need more protein than you think and most likely will crave surgery stuff. Being outdoors 24/7 will do that to you. Things like summer sausage, crackers, little Debbie's etc. will work great.
- Water: lots of water and/or containers to get water and keep it around.
- A mug: you can carry around to drink your water.
- Feast gear: plate, knife, fork and spoon, and an extra mug for not water.

There are hordes of packing lists floating around, check them out and get ideas. Talk to your local group about their experiences. There are even groups on line with lots of advice for packing for your first SCA war experience.

In the next PC, we will discuss how to prepare for attending your first war and what to expect when you get to site.


