The Rapier Report

Welcome to the Rapier Report, this is the first article in a (hopefully) ongoing series on understanding Historical Fencing. Every article will focus on a specific technique or concept fundamental to Rapier Combat, particularly within the context of the SCA. All techniques and concepts presented here will be able to be practiced on the field against opponents in honorable combat. This article is intended to be viewed as written by a student, therefore it is encouraged that this understanding be scrutinized by anyone in the populace of Caid or beyond. I hope to pass on the lessons I learn, as I learn them, both for my understanding and for the understanding of those who may similarly struggle.

Today's Topic: Controlling the Center line. *What is the Center Line?*

The Center line is a straight line you can draw between your opponent and yourself. This imaginary line is the shortest distance between which an opponent's sword and your own sword can travel to land a killing blow. Controlling this line is important in the art of defense, because controlling this line is fundamental for a fencer's safety from incoming attacks.

How do you control the Center Line?

The best way I have found to control the center line, is to occupy it by putting my sword in the center space. If your sword is in the center line, then it is threatening your opponent, and they must deal with the threat of attack to be able to strike back in safety.

Why is Controlling the Center Line important?

Controlling the Center line is important because it gives you a defensive advantage; the advantage it gives you is time. If you control the center line, the distance your opponent's sword must travel through will be greater than the distance your own sword must travel to achieve the same goal.

How can I practice Controlling the Center Line?

I have found that controlling the Center Line is best practiced with a partner. Have one partner initiate the drill by trying to thrust though the center line. The other person will have their sword out and in front of their body, occupying the center line. The goal of the drill is to move the thrust out of the center using nothing but your sword. I recommend when first trying this, stand within measure of each other, and try not to move your feet. This will help you better recognize what the center line looks like between the two of you. The goal of the person thrusting is not necessarily to try to kill the other, but to try to keep their sword on that center line so that if the second person does nothing, they will be struck.

The goal of the person occupying the center is make the thrusting opponents sword point move away from your body.

Through this drill, you will start to learn just how much you must move your sword to protect yourself.

I put my sword out and occupy the center, but I still get hit, am I doing this right?

Just getting your sword out into the center on its own is not enough. You will need to move your sword so that you have leverage against your opponent's sword. The easiest way to do this is to take the part of your sword just above your hand guard (called the Forté or Strong) and move it toward your opponent's sword.

What if my opponent just lets me have the center line?

Fantastic! Some fencers do not want to wrestle for control of the center line; knowing how to control it still benefits you. If you control the center line uncontested, then you have access to the shortest line to your opponent's body.

Straight to the Point!

Controlling the Center line has helped me as a fencer in a few ways. It has helped me keep my sword in front of my body, it puts my sword first in my defense, and it has given me a good place to start my engagements. From the Center line, I have found it helps keep my parrying and my counter attacking motions smaller and has generally improved my form.

That's all I have for you this time.


