Letters should be sent electronically to crown@meridies.org. Copies must also be sent to the Kingdom Seneschal (Seneschal@meridies.org), the Earl Marshal (kem@meridies.org), and the Kingdom Exchequer (exchequer@meridies.org), as required by kingdom law. It is Our intent to notify all couples of whether their intent is acceptable by the 21st of May.

The format for the tournament will be that of Meridian tradition: double elimination with the first round will be a challenge up by order of precedence (low to high). Each round will be fought best two-out-of-three. The final round will be fought the best three-out-of-five to secure the tournament victory.

We wish you good fortune and look forward to your letters and seeing great deeds upon the field.

Law Updates for the Reign of Rander and Arianne

April 1, 2023

III.100 REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING A CROWN LIST

Remove sections a. and b.

a. These Kingdom Officers have the right to disqualify a competitor or consort for documented violation(s) of Society policy and/or Kingdom law; specifically, concerning the Kingdom Requirements covered in I.107.H and III.100.C.

b. The refusing officer must submit the reason for the disqualification to the Crown in writing.

Change to:

A. Acceptance

1. The Crown will choose those entrants They find acceptable after consultation with the Kingdom Seneschal, Earl Marshal, and the Kingdom Exchequer. The Crown may disqualify a competitor or consort for cause.

Move III.100.C to III.100.B.4

4. Each competitor and consort must be at least nineteen (19) years of age on or before the date of Crown List

111.100.C

7. Within seven (7) days of Crown List, the Sovereign Heir and Consort Heir must provide to the Kingdom Seneschal proof that Their memberships extend through the end of Their reign as Sovereign and Consort if They have not done so already.

Move and Change to:

III.100.B.5

7. Within ten (10) days of Crown List, the Sovereign Heir and Consort Heir must provide to the Kingdom Seneschal proof that Their memberships extend through the end of Their reign as Sovereign and Consort if They have not done so already.

VII.102 EVENT FEE STRUCTURING

Events must offer a price structure that includes food and non-food options. This is referred to as an On-Board (with food) or Off-Board (without food) price

Change to:

A. If events are charging separately for food (On-Board), a without food (Off-Board) price must also be offered for the food being charged. Courtesy food offered as a part of the event structure for all attendees (i.e. breakfast, lunch, traveler's fare, dayboard, etc.) will not fall under this restriction

I.101 ADMINISTRATION OF MERIDIAN LAW

Add to I.101.C:

8. Any law changes informed by either modern law or SCA Corpora shall be in effect upon publication in the kingdom newsletter, unless the modern law and/or SCA corpora requires that it needs to change Meridies kingdom law immediately.

VIII.104 PATENT OF ARMS

- G. Each Order will meet at least twice in each Reign, as determined by the Crown and the Order
- 2. Peerage Orders are permitted to conduct official business online, providing the process is established in the charter.

Change to:

2. Peerage Orders are permitted to conduct official business online, providing the process is established in the governing documents, and the date is published on the kingdom calendar.

VIII.201 ORDERS OF HIGH MERIT

B. Procedures

2.f. All in-person and online meetings must adhere to the guidelines of the Order.

2.f. All in-person and online meetings must adhere to the guidelines of the Order, and providing they are permitted in their governing documents, and the date is published on the kingdom calendar.

The College of Heralds is looking for a Spark Herald. Spark Herald is Beacon's replacement deputy. This will put you in charge of heraldry in our kingdom. You would be responsible for the organization and administration of the college of Heralds, ensuring that everyone is doing their job, and giving assistance when needed.

You would be expected to step up as Beacon sometime in November, 2023. The role is largely administrative -- ensuring that reports are turned in on time to society, and coordinating activities across the different offices of the college. You do not need to be proficient in all areas of heraldry. Heraldry is a team sport, and so long as you can herd cats, there will be people who have your back!

In some exciting news, we have new submission forms for names and armory. These forms are fillable PDFs, and if you wish to use digital artwork, we have specially sized templates for you to use. We will accept the v3.0 forms until the end of 2023 however.

Last month we discussed how to preregister and pack for your first war. There are some other things I would also recommend you do before hand.

As I mentioned, you will be walking a lot. While there are carts that run all over site, you will still be putting in a lot of miles on foot. It may be a good idea to walk some now to get in shape.

If you can, save a little money to shop. The magnificent market on site is a great place to enlarge your garb and medieval experience.

Many wars have apps which you can install on your phone. The app will have maps, schedules etc. This can make your experience a lot easier on a site you have never been to before.

It's time for war! Troll in, which means entering the site and showing your registration. You'll receive your site token, keep it safely around your neck or in your belt. You'll show this everywhere you go.

Find your camp and get set up. Don't

worry if you haven't done this before, your camp is more than willing to help you!

At Gulf Wars, there is a Volunteer point where you can register with them, if you haven't done it online before. you will sign in by telling them your kingdom and local group you'd like to support. All hours will be credited to those groups, and they will receive money also volunteer hours count for war points.

Volunteering is the fastest way to make new friends, get to know the site and help your kingdom/local group. So make sure you volunteer at least a few hours.

Definitely check out the market. Enjoy some freshly baked treats, drink some fabulous coffee, have lunch and browse.

Watch some fighting or volunteer at fighter support to have a front row place, maybe even on the field between bouts.

Visit artisan row, Al mahala, renaissance village and Early Period living for some classes. Scribes point is a great place to

volunteer if you like to draw or write, even if you think you don't have skills yet.

If you don't have a name and device registered yet, heralds point will take good care of you. A little off the beaten path are equestrian and archery, but both well worth the visit.

Learn a dance or two. Play some games. Go to some parties. Hang around a campfire with new and old friends. Sing, laugh and listen to stories. It is a rare experience to get to meet people from all over the country and all over the world who have an interest in history.

War is lots of things for different people, find out what it is to you. Be brave! Please feel free to join newcomers point on Facebook if you have any questions at all, we'll be happy to help.



From the Parchment Clerk

The Greater office of the Parchment is looking for a deputy. Being Parchment in Meridies is a prestigious position but with that prestige comes A LOT (and I do mean a lot) of sacrifice and dedication. For those thinking about applying for this position, I beg you to read the following:

- 1. Consider how much time and energy you must spend and if you can prioritize this position. It requires several hours a week once you become parchment and as deputy, I will slowly give you more and more responsibilities until you are prepared and ready to take over.
- 2. Consider your ability in calligraphy. This position is extremely calligraphy-heavy. Knowing many different hands and learning to match the style on the scroll so the parts we fill in blend seamlessly with the hand that is already on the scroll and learning how to fill in the blank spaces creatively. You don't have to be perfect at this right away but being willing to learn and grow on top of a solid knowledge base is a must.
- 3. Consider diplomacy. As Parchment, the weight of your words and actions is much heavier. You have the influence to help people and encourage people. This is a heavy responsibility that constantly weighs on my mind. Also, you will be working closely with the crown and their entourage. The appropriate respect and deference are important and as well as being able to express the concerns and feelings of the scribes in a confident, yet humble manner. In fact, learning diplomacy skills overall is essential.
- 4. Consider your knowledge of illumination styles and what country and century they are from is very helpful when choosing scrolls for recipients.
- 5. Consider organizational skill level. I can't express how being organized helps with not only maintaining the kingdom cases but also keeping track of which scrolls are going out, are commissioned, and missing or destroyed scrolls. As well as keeping track of active scribes and their skill level so that you know who is doing what and how much. And it's such a great pleasure to see our scribes' skills improve over time as they practice and work on their craft.






