





Diversity, Equity, and Inclusivity Spotlight

Happy Transgender Day of Visibility

While this was last month, the 31st of March, I want to acknowledge a day that not only raises awareness of the discrimination that the trans community faces but especially celebrates trans visibility, joy, and experiences. TDOV was created in 2009 by Rachel Crandall-Crocker explicitly to "bring together trans people from all over the world".

Transgender people have existed throughout history; the Wikipedia page for '<u>Transgender</u> <u>history</u>' alone is a wonderful read full of dozens of examples of transgender people throughout our period in the SCA and beyond into modern history. (Content warning for historical violence and prejudice against transgender people, however)

This article gives a brief history of trans history '<u>Is</u> <u>Trans New</u>', especially within Australia, and includes a link to a page with '<u>Information for</u> <u>Allies</u>'. For non-transgender people, TDOV is not only a day to celebrate transgender friends, family, and community, but a reminder to use cisgender privilege to take action and actively support the trans community, to enact positive societal change.




