I write you all this day concerning the newest information concerning the submissions process complete with happy words from Laurel Sovereign of Arms: we have New submission forms!

Over the past six months, Laurel and her staff have been working hard behind the scenes updating and streamlining the heraldic submission forms for use in the Known World. Our latest version of the forms are officially released this month, and can be found online at http://rampart.outlandsheralds.org/#submissionforms

The main changes are to streamline language and remove personal information which was found to be no longer relevant. They also streamlined the so-called "boxes of death" to make the submitter's desires known without making choices which were mutually exclusive.

The current submission forms, v3.0, will be accepted until the end of 2023. Forms received after Dec 31, 2023 must be v4.0. Heralds at all levels are encouraged to make sure you've replaced all 3.0 forms with the newer 4.0 forms well before that date, particularly any paper copies that may be stashed somewhere for consultation tables.

Greetings Dear Outlands!

It has come to my attention that a misunderstanding has taken place where it comes to the handling of money in the SCA. I would like to first try to clear up this misunderstanding by offering excerpts from the Society Financial Policy dated 12/16/2022 and the Outlands Financial Policy dated 4/18/2021.

Society Financial Policy

IV. BANK ACCOUNT IDENTIFICATION AND STRUCTURE

A. All funds will be maintained in an account with a recognized banking institution or credit union.

XI. CONTROLLING DISBURSEMENTS

All disbursements will be made to an entity (individual or business) by signed checks, online payment (where applicable) or money orders/cashier's check. No disbursements by cash. Disbursements in advance of a purchase must be documented beforehand and will be treated as receivable items until they are reconciled by presentation of receipts and/or cash totaling the amount of the advance.

XII. CONTROLLING CASH RECEIPTS

Cash receipts shall include but are not limited to: event income of all types, money collected from advertised fund raising endeavors, donations, money from the sale of goods purchased with group funds, and newsletter sales and subscription income.

A. Cash receipts of any type totaling more than \$50 must be deposited in the appropriate account no later than 14 calendar days after the receipt by an officer of the SCA. Cash receipts of any type less than this limit must be deposited in the appropriate account no later than 30 calendar days after the receipt by an officer of the SCA. No incoming funds of any type are to be kept out of the appropriate account longer than these timeframes. Undeposited income of any type is not to be used for refunds, reimbursements or expenses.

Outlands Financial Policy

IX. Methods for controlling cash receipts.

B. Controlling Cash Receipts

- 1. Cash Receipts shall include, but not limited to:
 - a. Event income of all types,
- b. Money collected from advertised fundraising endeavors,
 - c. Donations,
 - d. Money from the sale of goods purchased with group funds,
 - e. Newsletter sales and subscription income.
- 2. Cash receipts of any type must be given to the Kingdom Exchequer or their designee. Receipts totaling more than \$50 must be deposited in the appropriate account no later than 14 calendar days after the receipt. Cash receipts of any type less than this limit must be deposited in the appropriate account no later than 30 calendar days. No incoming funds of any type are to be kept out of the appropriate account.

Both policies indicate that money raised or received from SCA-sponsored activities are to be considered SCA Funds. This does not mean that ALL money given to an officer is

to be considered SCA funds. We don't want your pocket change from lunch or the proceeds of your kid's Girl Scout cookies, even if they were baked using period methods or packaged in period boxes. This also means that the sale of privately purchased supplies (scribal, leather, ratan, archery targets, stickers, etc) with the intent to resell privately are also not considered to be SCA funds. The SCA does not manage other people's personal finances. The questions that should be asked are, "Did the group use SCA funds to purchase these items, or the materials to make items, to be sold?", and "Does the Seller indicate to their Buyers that the proceeds will go to an SCA-sponsored activity or fund?" If the answer to either of these questions is Yes, then Yes, those proceeds are considered SCA funds, regardless of whether the money is handed to an officer or paid member. (By the way, only paid SCA members may handle and verify SCA funds.) Money received from SCAsponsored activities are to be given to the Exchequer for that group, or their warranted designee, to be verified and deposited. If your group is also fundraising for another SCA group or fund, or another nonprofit organization (501 (c)3), then a check will be written from the group's bank account after the money has been verified by the Exchequer for that group. The check can be written at the event as long as the Exchequer, or their designee, has verified the amount and can deposit it within the required timeframes, and an eligible second signatory is available. One last thing, ALL questions regarding the interpretation of financial policies shall be directed to the Office of the Exchequer, either locally or at the Kingdom level. Per the letter from the Society Seneschal dated 2/28/2023 "Regarding the Relative Authority of Kingdom and Local Officers", "local and kingdom officers must focus on decisions that fall within their area of responsibility". If questions arise about any level of financial policy, please consult your Exchequers. If they feel that the policy needs to be clarified, then the Exchequer will make that clarification. No other officer is qualified to make interpretations or clarifications on financial matters.
