

Greetings Caid,

Their Majesties invite you to submit Letters of Intent for our upcoming March Crown Tournament!

Letters of Intent to fight in the Spring Crown Tournament of Caid on Saturday, March 4th, 2023 are now being accepted. Letters will be accepted until 11:00pm on the evening of Sunday, February 19th, 2023.

All entrants must have current membership with combatants having current fighter authorization at the time of submission. Prior to submitting a Letter of Intent, all combatants must verify their authorization status: use the following link - http://www.dev.caid-commons.org/list

Please read through the following to ensure you meet the requirements for the list:

- All persons entering Crown Lists must be current members and their membership must extend through the reign for which they are fighting.
- All persons must have been a resident of Caid for a period of one year between first Caidan event attendance and said Crown List in which they want to participate.
- All persons must have primary fealty to the Crown of Caid.
- All persons entering Crown Lists must be at least 18 years of age.
- All persons entering Crown Lists must have a name and device registered with, or in submission to, the College of Arms on the day of Crown Tournament.
- All persons entering Crown Lists must have demonstrated minimum participation during the period beginning with the previous Crown Tournament up to (but not including) the current Crown Tournament. Minimum participation consists of attending five events. At least four of those must be events listed in the official Kingdom Calendar as published in the kingdom newsletter and one of the following may count in their place: official meetings of baronial or shire councils, fighter practices, or guild meetings.

The Letter of Intent should include:

- The entrant's and consort's SCA names
- Both membership numbers
- Modern names and contact information, and
- Verification of the above required items to participate in Crown Lists.

Great Officers of State and Territorial Barons/Baronesses entering Crown Lists are additionally required to submit to the Crown the name of an informed designated representative capable of and willing to assume the duties of the office during the term of the reign.

The Spring Crown Tournament will be a standard double elimination tournament, the final round being best two out of three.

Beorn's Curio Corner: Wait, THAT'S period? Part Two of...

Good day to you fellow Caidans! How about these crazy spring days, am I right? By the time some of you read this, we will have new Heirs, and a select few of us ("we happy few" 1) will have braved the desert wastes, and the largest river in North America ² , to attend the "friendliest of all wars" - Gulf Wars! When last we left our intrepid adventurers, we were grooving on a plant that we may have, at some point, been told was not period to the SCA's era(s) of pursuit: the sweet potato. Well, now we are going to dig up the cousin of our first guest, and delve into the pre-17th century writing about that "other" tuber, the generic potato.

Solanum tuberosum (my Latin isn't the best, hence, my translation of this as "a Nightshade's Tummy" may be less than accurate), or the Potato, is a root vegetable native to the Americas. Domestication of these, we believe, first occurred in the area in South America now consisting of the border between southeastern Peru and northwestern Bolivia and can be traced back as far as 10,000 years ago! The cultivation seems to predate sweet potatoes by at least 5,000 years, and may have been some of the earliest plants harnessed by people in the western hemisphere.

Originally, sweet potatoes were THE 'potatoes' or sometimes called 'common potatoes' and the above were referred to by Gerard as 'bastard potatoes' or 'Virginia potatoes'; mistakenly believing these to have originated in North America. As a matter of fact, mistakes abound in the dissemination of potatoes (and tomatoes, peppers, and eggplants, but those are future articles³) all throughout Africa, Asia, and, you guessed it, Europe. While it IS true that these plants, including the potato, are members of the Nightshade Family, so are about 2700 other flowers, herbs, vines, spices and trees.

There was (and maybe still is) a saying that is something along the lines of "ignorance is no excuse," and if that is the case now, the distribution of the potato in Europe seems to demonstrate that it was not always the case. We see the first instance of potatoes on a shipping manifest on the Canary Islands in 1567. The earliest Spanish sources liken the smaller, what we would now call 'fingerling' potatoes to roasted chestnuts in consistency. Spanish raiders⁴ noticed that sailors who ate potatoes didn't suffer from scurvy, and recommended

them as foodstuffs for ocean voyages. They called them 'tartuffo' and thought they were some kind of truffle. There is even ignorance as to just how potatoes got to Ireland in the first place. The earliest possible introduction is in either 1588 or 1589 and regardless which story is true (the former certainly apocryphal; the latter, just sad) it was rather tragic. In the first instance, potatoes were among the items washed ashore from the Irish Sea when the Spanish Armada was dashed to bits in an Atlantic storm. In the second instance, Sir Walter Raleigh planted them at his estates in County Cork, and had a banquet for Elizabeth I where the cooks, unaccustomed to preparing the tubers, threw away the "lumpy bits" and stewed the leaves and stems for the assembled guests. The greens contain a glycoalkaloid toxin called solanine which causes cramps, vomiting and diarrhea. The potato was, henceforth, banned from court.

And here we are; Spanish sailors eat them, yet British royals do not. How on earth did they end up getting printed in a German cookbook? First, we have to ask, is this recipe really about potatoes? Well, the modern German word for potato is Kartoffel and has the same root as the Italian/Spanish term for truffle (we just read about that!). However, in southern Germany and Austria, the term for potato is Erdapfel and literally means "earth apple." This could mean any vegetable or fruit that grew in or on the ground, including most gourds like pumpkins, melons, or squash. Depending upon who you choose to believe, either Marx Rumpolt's 1581 culinary textbook Ein new Kochbuch contains the first recipe, or, it didn't show up in German cuisine until the reign of Ferdinand III in the first third of the 17th century. How do we know for certain? Well, we don't, but based upon the recipe, we can make an educated guess. First thing's first, a facsimile of the recipe itself from the 1604 edition, and then we break it down and see for ourselves. Sound fun?

37. Earth Apples. Peel and cut them small / cook them in Water / and squeeze it well through a hair cloth / chop them small / and roast it with bacon / that small sliced is / take underneath a little Milk / and let it cook together / so it will be good and pleasant tasting.

Full disclosure, I have cooked this very recipe before. For a Coronation feast no less. And yes, I did make a vegan option with roasted shallots and olive oil to replace the bacon and bacon grease, and almond milk instead of cow's milk. I am not a vegetarian, and as such I prefer the "leaded" option⁵ but it was certainly palatable either way (why would I serve something NOT edible?).

Now, what else COULD it be if not potatoes? A gourd perhaps? Unlikely, since they are also not native to Germany. Most are from the Americas, with a few cultivated in Africa and Asia.

Perhaps the Earthnut Pea, a pretty flower used for perfumes that has small, but edible tubers and is common to that part of Europe. The amount required to make a dish of any size also makes that a possibility, but only a little more likely.

Therefore, we are left with making the logical leap of white potatoes. Not russets or Irish reds or Yukon golds, but a type that we would now consider to be an heirloom type. It IS possible. After all, Marx Rumpolt was the head chef for the Archbishop and Elector of Mainz. Such a position would have access to all the newest things from the westward expansion. His employer was often prone to giving parties where Protestants and Catholics would mingle and attempt to iron out their differences. And, as Elector, the principal interests were not those of faith, but those of the German state (such as it was). How nice is fried potatoes with bacon as an ice -breaker? Thank you Marx for giving us such a glorious dish! Next month we are going to do a little April Fools;
