

Greetings upon our great kingdom of Ealdormere do we, Prince Steinnar and Princess Margiag, send greetings.

With the holidays past, we look forward to an exciting year, where we can sing the praises of Ealdormere across the known world, met, share, laugh. and celebrate Pennsic 50 together as a kingdom.

We invite all to submit to join our spring crown and ensure we have honorable heirs to stand by our side through the wars, revely of summer and lead the kingdom forward when our time is done.

Our tournament will be random drawn double elimination tournament, with each match being best 2 of 3 passes. This will continue until we have 2 undefeated combatants on the winner side and 2 combatants with only 1 loss.

The semifinals will have each the undefeated combatant face one of the other combatants in a best 2 of 3 matches, any weapon style, with each match being best 2 of 3. Should the undefeated combatant lose the match, there will be another 2 of 3 match with the winner advancing to the finals. Should the undefeated combatant win the first match he will advance directly to the finals.

The finals will be a best 3 of 5 matches, with each match being best 2 of 3, in any weapons form.

All weapons must be in good repair and freshly taped. Shields should also be in good repair. Any visible plastic on armor should be covered. Armour and garb should attempt to present a period look, befitting one that aspires to royalty.

All fighters are expected to conduct themselves in a way that inspires those around them, through word and deed. Should we feel that a combatant is not holding themselves to this high standard, in their conduct upon the field, we will not hesitate to remove them from the lists. Please contact us if you have questions about this. We will also be attempting to contact each entry to discuss further what is expected.

Crown represents the best we as a society have to offer. Our expectation is that those who enter this list do so with the knowledge that their behaviour and presence is the beacon around which our kingdom gathers around. Our kingdom deserves the very best to lead them and we know that those inspiring individuals will come out victorious on that day.

Letters of intent are due 14 days prior to the tournament day, and need to be delivery to both the Senechal and ourselves.

From The Seneschal

Greetings everyone,

I am pleased to announce that Spring Coronation will be hosted by the Canton of Northgeatham on April 29th, 2023. As well, Spring Crown Tourney is being sponsored by the Barony of Skraeling Althing on May 27th, 2023. Please see the Kingdom Calendar and website for more details.

Their Highnesses are calling for those who wish to fight to make their intent known to participate in Ealdormere's Spring Crown Tournament. As per Kingdom law (see III-200), please make sure to also provide me with a copy of all required documentation via email at ealdormere.kseneschal@gmail.com.

Note well that the deadline for submissions is firmly set at 13 May 2022 11:59pm. Please be sure to include copies of your:

- Letter of intent,
- Combatant's authorization card -- both sides,
- Membership cards of combatant and consort -- both sides,
- Signed copy of the declaration form -- found in the library on ealdormere.ca,
- Record of involvement in the Kingdom over the last 12 months (law III-503),
- Proof of residency -- either as a copy of a bill or as copies of combatant and consort's driver's licences, and
- Such other requirements as requested by Their Majesties in Their requirements (if applicable).

Please review the applicable laws of Ealdormere before submitting your application:

III-400 All prospective combatants and consorts must be paid members of the SCA and must maintain that membership through to the end of Their reign. Proof of membership must accompany the request to participate in the Crown Tournament.

III-500 All prospective combatants and consorts in the Crown Tournament must meet the following requirements:

III-501 They must be subjects of Ealdormere as defined by Corpora and must remain subjects of the Kingdom through to the end of Their reign.

III-502 They must be at least 18 years old.

III-503 They must have been subjects of Ealdormere and have demonstrated a clear level of involvement in the Kingdom over the year prior to the Crown Tournament.

III-504 They must be armigerous.

III-505 All prospective combatants must be authorized to fight as an armored combatant in the Kingdom of Ealdormere and must present proof of authorization when submitting their letter of intent.

III-600 Any person who does not meet the requirements of Section III-503 or 504 may make an application to the Heirs under the "Rule of 12" as outlined below:

The Prospective combatant and consort shall submit a request to participate in the Crown Tournament pursuant to Section III-200. Their request must be accompanied by a letter addressing why they seek dispensation from Section III-503 or III-504. This letter must bear the signatures of 12 subjects of Ealdormere, all of whom are armigerous. By signing the dispensation request, the signatories vouch for the worthiness of the candidates. Due weight will be given to this request.

Note: This dispensation request must accompany the request to participate in the Crown Tournament and is not a method of recourse after a combatant or consort has been disallowed from the Crown Tournament.

III-700 Neither the Sovereign or the Consort of Ealdormere, nor any person who has served as Sovereign or Consort of Ealdormere within three months prior to the Crown Tournament, may participate as a combatant or consort in that Crown Tournament.

III-800 No prospective combatant may have more than one declared consort. No prospective consort may be fought for by more than one combatant.

PROPOSED LAW CHANGE: Ealdormere Sumptuary Laws, Symbols of Rank

The Proposal to grant the right to wear a gold coronet adorned with six pearls to include

those who have earned their Court Baronacy for having served as Territorial Baronial Nobles.

ARTICLE XII - Order of Precedence and Symbols of Rank

XII-200 Symbols of Rank

XII-201 Only Dukes and Duchesses may wear a coronet adorned with strawberry leaves.

XII-202 Only Counts and Countesses may wear a gold embattled coronet.

XII-203 Only Viscounts and Viscountesses of Ealdormere may wear a silver embattled coronet.

XII-204 Only Territorial Baronial Nobles may wear a gold coronet adorned with six pearls (spheroids), which may be adorned with the full baronial arms.

XII-205 Only those who are Court Baronial Nobles and have formerly served as Territorial Baronial Nobles, may wear a gold coronet adorned with six pearls (spheroids).

XII-206 Only Court Baronial Nobles may wear a silver coronet adorned with six pearls (spheroids).

XII-207 Any individual who has earned the right to bear a symbol of rank from another Kingdom may continue to bear that symbol within Ealdormere.

From the Media Relations Deputy


Greetings unto the populace of Ealdormere,

From the Trillium Herald

Добрий день!



I am once again opening up applications to serve as my successor as Trillium Herald. Trillium is the Principal Herald for the Kingdom of Ealdormere and is a member of Privy Council. So what do you need to apply?

- 1. Experience, preferably as a Senior Staff herald or a local herald, with the College of Arms and the general reporting requirements and structure of the College at both Society and Kingdom levels
- 2. Excellent organizational skills
- 3. High-level familiarity with heraldry as practiced in the Society, including the submissions process, court heraldry, field heraldry, display heraldry, and precedence. (Note: Trillium does not need to be an expert in any of these fields, but basic familiarity is key)
- 4. Ability to delegate and manage a team of staff heralds
- 5. Regular access to email and electronic media

A sixth, unwritten requirement is the ability to act with tact and discretion. Trillium may be privy to the business of the Crown and as such may need to keep things such as court business in confidence.

Note that Trillium is NOT expected to herald every court (or any courts at all--we have had "book heralds" serve in the position before). Your job is to make sure each court has a warranted herald, and while that can be you, it does not have to be (plus some Royalty choose their own reign herald).

Normally, the successor deputy serves a year before stepping up so they can learn the position. My warrant ends in October and can be extended if need be if my successor would like the full year.

Deadline for applications is April 30.

If you are interested, please contact me and provide your SCA CV. We'll talk!





A few things we're required to say...

This is the March 2023 AS 57 issue of The Tidings, the official newsletter of the Kingdom of Ealdormere.
