Greetings unto the populace of the East from the office of Chancellor Minor!

Much planning and thought has been taking place the first half of this year in how to best serve the youth and families of the East and action is finally under way! My goal is to focus on the holistic experience

of our youth, inside and outside of the family activities pavilion. After all, youth do not stop existing once Family Point closes, just as adults do not stop existing once the battlefield, A&S, feast hall, etc. close.

To that end, I am retiring the use of regional officers for the Office of Chancellor Minor. Our awareness on the need for coverage for youth activities in the form of background checks is much more pervasive than it has been in the past and, given the needs of the populace, no longer make sense. I would like

to personally acknowledge and thank Lady Eleanor Grey, Lady Toi Poisson de Mortagne, and Mistress Sheherazada al-Zahira for their work as Northern, Central, and Southern Region Deputy Chancellor Minors as well as the deputies that have come before them. Without their work, there is no way that my office supporting our youth and families could run.

However, in lieu of regional officers, I am pleased to introduce Age Ranged Deputies. After all, this work cannot be done alone. These deputies will be tasked with assisting in creating and orchestrating the resources our families need the most based on stages of childhood and adolescent development. Some things are universal challenges like keeping little ones hydrated and clothed (garb swaps for the win!) but there are some specific challenges that each group faces.:

Young Families And New Parents (Newborn - 4 years) - Maternity garb, nursing garb, babyproofing a camp, etc.

Childhood (5-12 years) - SCAdian basics for kids, simple crafts, much of the current purview of youth activities

Adolescence (13-17 years) - Life beyond family point, integrating with "adult" society, SCAdian civics, coming of age and transitioning into adulthood

Please note that I'm giving rough estimates of the ages of youth that these deputies will serve, but it's all up to interpretation as we all know that children develop at their own pace. Ideally, with these resources in place, we can work on developing a road map for youth and their families of what they can expect their trajectory to be as they reach their majority.

Lastly, I do have another deputy position that needs to be filled for our beloved Principality of Tir Mara! This position is vacant and I look forward to making sure that our Tir Maran children are looked after by one of their own. Many thanks to Lord Eignhard d'Aix la Chapelle for his service as Chancellor Minor!



High Nobility & Low Stakes is an immersive SCA event. Our immersion is not centered around a particular place and time, but around social status and respective entertainments. Upstairs, you will find the Reverdie Revels, a masked ball in celebration of Spring, featuring delicate nibbles, exquisite clothing, and courtly manners. Downstairs, you will find "The Golden Serpent," a casual and even raucous tavern with hearty foods, gaming, and the general rabble. While courtly manners reign upstairs, tavern disputes can lead to fencing knife fights or outdoor dueling (weather permitting).

Participants are highly encouraged to "sneak" between the spaces using whatever disguises they wish. Some may simply remove regalia & don a simple cloak to visit the tavern. Others may add a fancy mask and cape to sneak into the ball. All attendees will be given a simple mask if they require one, but people are highly encouraged to bring their own fancy masks for the day.

We may have door guards to remind you of the tone of each space & to encourage a spirit of play in our day. However, a game is only good if everyone is having fun. Therefore, if you wish to have a spirited argument, a dramatic declaration of a courtly love poem, a duel, or any immersive action that relies on another attendee playing along, you *must* be certain that the other party consents to be part of the game. Anyone who fails to do so will be banned from the overall competition, their tokens forfeit.

Participants will also receive a bag of twenty coin tokens*. Each token is worth one point. Tokens can be used for gaming downstairs in the tavern, tipping musicians, rewarding service, etc. The event staff will also have 5 point coin tokens to be given at their discretion for acts that add to the overall spirit of the event.
