A look at modern practices and their medieval sources

The earliest proof of Europeans setting foot on the continent of Australia is 1606. So Europeans regularly visiting Australia are off the end of what we consider in-period. But what about Australians visiting Europe? The first living Australian visiting Europe happened in the mid-13th century. Who was he, and how do we know? In the *De Arte Venandi cum Avibus* (The Art of Hunting With Birds) from the 1240s is an image of IT, a cockatoo. These four images of a white cockatoo pre-date an Italian altarpiece embroidered with a cockatoo from 1496. It turns out that the specific species in question is a yellow-crested cockatoo, which comes from northeastern Australia. In the case of the manuscript, the particular bird was a gift to Holy Roman Emperor Frederick II from the Sultan of Egypt. One can only imagine the years of travel such a bird experienced over trade routes from Oceana to Europe. So before Marco Polo went to China, a cockatoo came to Italy. And now you know more random carp.



Change to Section VI.A.1 – Lesser Officers and Offices of State: General Duties:

There shall exist in the Kingdom of Artemisia, Lesser Offices of State. Among these shall be the Kingdom Youth Officer, Kingdom Social Media Officer, Kingdom Tournament List Officer, Kingdom Scribe, Officer of the Marshallate Rolls, Archer General, Kingdom Equestrian Officer, Keeper of the Regalia, Inter-Kingdom Advisory Council Representative, Grand Council Representative-Kingdom Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Officer, and others as deemed necessary by the Crown.

Additions to Section V.B.5 - Lesser Officers and Offices of State: Specific Duties:

5. The **Kingdom Arts and Sciences Officer** shall:

- a. Interpret and maintain the Kingdom rules for the Kingdom Arts and Sciences Competition. The Kingdom Arts and Sciences championship shall be held in conjunction with Kingdom Collegium.
- b. With the Kingdom Seneschal, and the Kingdom Event Deputy, be responsible for soliciting bids for Kingdom Competition/Collegium and non-competitive Kingdom A&S Event.
- Promote the historically accurate representation of medieval arts and sciences through competitions, education, and demonstrations.
- d. With the Kingdom Chronicler, solicit and approve articles submitted to the Arts and Sciences issue of the Sage Advice.
- e. Attend Kingdom Collegium-sponsored Arts events and oversee the Kingdom Arts and Sciences Competition. If the Officer is unable to attend, he/she will delegate this authority to a deputy or other qualified person before the event.

Removal of Section VI.B.10 - Lesser Officers and Offices of State: Specific Duties:

10. The Inter-kingdom Advisory Council Representative shall:

- a. Be a member of the Society for Creative Anachronism, who receives a copy of the Kingdom newsletter at their residence.
- b. Have an effective means of communication.
- c. Have resided and been active within the Kingdom for a period of one (1) year prior to the assignment, and shall continue to reside within the Kingdom during their tenure.
- d. Have demonstrated a thorough understanding of Artemisian Kingdom Tradition and binding laws of the Society.
- e. Have demonstrated an ability to communicate orally and in written form.
- f. Be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- g. Have held at least one (1) office for a minimum of six (6) months.

- h. Not be a ruling Sovereign, Consort or Royal Heir to the Kingdom throne.
- i. Be appointed by the Crown of Artemisia.
- i. The tenure for a member of the Inter-Kingdom Council shall be two (2) years.
- k. Report to the Crown of Artemisia and the Kingdom Seneschal on a quarterly basis.

Addition of (new) Section VI.B.10 - Lesser Officers and Offices of State: Specific Duties:

- 10. The Kingdom Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Officer shall:
 - a. Provide education to the Artemisian officers and populace regarding areas of diversity, equity, and inclusion.
 - b. Promote accountability, supporting current and evolving processes to address inequitable actions, including: discrimination, bullying, and harassment. As the DEI Office is not investigative, the Officer shall refer individuals who are requesting investigation to the office of the Seneschal.
 - c. Facilitate necessary conversations and decision-making that can lead to a more diverse, equitable, and inclusive Kingdom.
 - d. Assist in creating a welcoming climate for all participants to contribute, celebrating the presence of differences.
 - e. Endeavor to engage in at least one passion project per tenure to address areas of DEI that may need further assistance (inclusion around accessibility, LGBTQIA+ issues, increasing Inclusive Excellence, etc).
 - f. Send quarterly reports to the Kingdom Seneschal and Society/Corporate DEI Officers.

Clarification of Section VII.2 - Officers of the Royal Court and Champions of Artemisia:

2. The Champions of Artemisia shall be: King's Champion of Artemisia, Queen's Champion of Artemisia, Champion of the Arts and Sciences, Sable Rose (Rapier) Champion of Artemisia, Equestrian Champion of Artemisia, Archery Champion of Artemisia, Thrown Weapons Champion of Artemisia, Youth Champion of Artemisia, and the Bard of Artemisia. They may be chosen either by tournament or by simple designation of the Crown

Amendment of Section XI.A.2 - Crown Tournament Submission Requirements:



2. To have resided within the Kingdom of Artemisia for twelve (12) months and to have

been active in the SCA for the twelve (12) months preceding the Crown Tournament. All

entrants to Crown Tournament must submit in writing to the Crown, Kingdom Seneschal

and Kingdom Tournaments Officer, a letter of intent to participate in Crown Tournament. Letters of Intent must also include proof of membership for both combatant and consort, a copy of the combatant's authorization card, and entrant forms for both combatant and consort. All required paperwork must be received no later than fourteen (14) calendar days before the date of Crown Tournament, in order for the combatant and consort to be considered for entrance to Crown Tournament. The Kingdom Seneschal and Kingdom Tournament List Officer shall verify a valid marshallate authorization for each combatant and a valid membership status and for each combatant and consort for the day of Crown Tournament.
