We often have A&S available at our practices, depending on who is in attendance. We are in a close partnership with the Skeldergate practice, as there is a nice amount of overlap in the fighter roster and general location. Thus, we take pains to avoid conflicting practice times and dates between the two cantons.

The practices during the warmer months are on Thursday nights from 6 until it gets too dark to see an opponent or pell. They are outdoors, and hosted by Lord Michaelis. Folks interested in joining us can contact either Lord Iustus (<u>marshal.risingwaters@gmail.com</u>) or myself (<u>risingwaters@gmail.com</u>). Fees are voluntary, and much appreciated as they go towards the winter practice site which we rent from the local district school board. There is loaner gear for both armoured combat and fencing - although we ask fighters to contact us in advance so we can be sure to have it at the practice for them.

At our regular weekly practices, we have invited guest participants among the chivalry and order of defence. Sir Richard is a regular participant, and Lord Iustus and I both tend to use a combination of drills and active sparring in the practices. I can also commend Iustus for his work to support new fighters as they prepare for their authorization. It's top notch! Our practices are also very welcoming and supportive of women fighters, and fighters with a range of abilities.

In the past, we have also had armouring workshops, as well!

## **Mega Practice:**

Rising Waters is known for hosting mega practices, including thrown weapons and archery in addition to armoured combat and fencing. We have also included classes for special interest topics (e.g. tailoring patterns). We have already held one of these this year, and look forward to scheduling more.

The Skeldergate Practice is held by-weekly during the Summer Months in Stouffville Ontario . Coordinating our schedule in cooperation with Ard Chreag where one week we practice at Skeldergate with the following at Ard Chreag on a regular basis. As this is an outdoor site in a backyard it is weather dependent but practice schedules are usually announced on Social Media (Skeldergate, Septentria and Kingdom FB Pages) a month in advance.



After the pandemic lockdowns, in order to rebuild our numbers we have formed an information sharing collective with our neighboring groups, Primarily Ard Chreag, Eoforwic, Petrea Thule (and others) whose Armored Marshals I communicate with regularly in order to maximize our numbers of fighters. I do my best to get word out as often as possible to allow folks to plan ahead, to ensure that communication is clear during weekends when there are kingdom events or nearby practices happening.

Although last summer we held armored combat practices only, this year we are talking to Fencing Marshals in order to allow fencing and cut and thrust practitioners a chance to attend and train as well. There are also plans for armoring nights and A&S related to fighting in the works. (shield, tabard painting and construction etc..)

We usually have a half a dozen regular fighters, with the number on good days being above ten and steadily growing.

The best part of our practices are the great balance of older seasoned fighters, with several members of Chivalry (our current Majesty attends regularly) mixed in with a very enthusiastic crop of newer fighters who bring a good positive energy to the practice.

After practice the grill is usually on with hot dogs, burgers and freezies regularly on the menu. The site is next to a community center so there is lots of free parking within a 30 second walk from the site. We are 100% kid and dog friendly, and aim to be welcoming and inclusive to all who wish to attend.

All information is regularly posted on the Skeldergate FB Page( along with other local group and baronial pages ), which I am also the moderator on so I see messages and respond fairly quickly.
