


I stand on the shoulders of giants, who have walked these paths before me.

There are some times that I have had to steel myself and call upon all of the reasons that this reign was so important, whether it be my reign, or another transgender sibling who had taken on this role. There have been so many magical moments that have proven to me time and time again just why this reign was so important to those within our Kingdom, and our society. The importance of the representation of an obviously and obnoxiously queer person in leadership. The whispers of those who see themselves represented through my being on the Throne. The college kid who cried when they saw the AoA writs with the progress flag, and saw our Kingdom as a safe place to be. The laurel

who swore fealty for the first time to a Crown of Lochac, swearing while I was Crown, because I'm the first where he has been represented by anyone in this position. 

DEI in the SCA

Baron Charles de Bourbon was appointed SCA Inc.'s Diversity Equirty and Inclusion Officer on March 1, and has been posting regular updates and useful articles on the SCA Diversity Equity & Inclusion Facebook page since then (www.facebook.com/SCADiversityEquityInclusion). Posted below is an update made in April about DEI items approved in the April 23rd SCA Board of Directors meeting:

"For context: in 2021 Jessica Van Hattem submitted a suite of recommendations to the BoD, and in December, 2021 several board members crafted a proposal based on those recommendations to present for implementation.

When I stepped up, the proposal was handed to me to review for implementation and proposal to the board. Sunday, the following items were approved for implementation across the Society. Some of these items are fairly large, and I will be building implementation task forces.

- 1. required DEI training for all Society and Corporate officers, the BoD, and Kingdom greater officers including crowns
- 2. Work with kingdoms to develop a process to publish and retain required accessibility information for events/locations.
- 3. Work with Society Chatelaine to develop DEI awareness for new folks
- 4. All kingdoms are asked to have a DEI officer, and I will work with Kingdom DEI officers and Seneschals to standardize the job description, scope, and function.
- 5. Form a workgroup to investigate the potential creation of a Society DEI officer and the roles and responsibilities associated with the position. For additional review:
- 6. RFP for external consultant being reviewed

Policy Change:

7. Add B for Belonging to DEI office, so it is now the DEIB office in keeping contemporary practices."




