We are here to help the kingdom in whatever way We can.



# In coversation

#### An Interview with Sir Skane Tyrsson



In this edition of The Fluffy Flyer, we dive into the journey of a remarkable individual who has been elevated to the Order of Chivalry — Sir Skane Tyrsson. Known for his unwavering dedication and thoughtful nature, Sir Skane shares the emotions he experienced upon receiving the news of his vigil for The Order of Chivalry. From a blend of excitement and surprise to the overwhelming sense of responsibility that comes with elevation, he offers a candid look into what this achievement means to him personally and how

it has shaped his identity within our community. Join us as we explore his insights, aspirations, and the profound significance of his journey towards knighthood.

#### The Q&A

How did you feel when you received the news about your vigil for The Order of Chivalry? Were you surprised, excited, or overwhelmed?

How did I feel? Goodness, I do not possess the skill at word-craft to sufficiently express the rush of feeling that hit me before, during and after that moment. Excited, yes. I mean, who wouldn't be excited to see plans and work and hopes all come to fruition after such a journey. Surprised, not so much, there were some indicators that had me at least prepared for the possibility. Not to say that I knew it was happening. I was not, however, blindsided. Overwhelmed, perhaps. To be completely honest, I was surprised by my physical reaction to the preamble before they called my name. It was a lot of "They've called up the Members of Chivalry! Is it me? What if it isn't me? Where's my wife? There she is, oh thank goodness. Why's my mouth so dry? Why can't I breathe properly? I'll bet I'm changing colours...". I sincerely hope that none of that chaos showed, and I was able to at least appear stoic. Then, it happened. They called me up. Our Then Queen Kiera, spoke my name and changed everything. I'll ask you a question to answer this question. How would you feel to have our Crowns and Council say "Yup, that guy has what we want. Get him in here."? People are lucky if they get that feeling more than a few times in their whole lives.

What did being placed on vigil for knighthood mean to you personally?

Vigil is the transition time. When you are a squire, you behave as a squire. Although you are learning to be a Knight, you aren't preparing for imminent Knighthood. You stay your ground and do your work. You are this thing (i.e. a squire) until they make you another thing (i.e. a Knight). Being on vigil bridges that gap a bit. It allows a small amount of time for you to begin preparing for the next journey stage. It also allows



you to wrap up any business that needs doing before taking the next step. I had some gifts to finish that would have been less appropriate after my elevation. Being put on vigil also gave my family and friends time to prepare for my elevation. Vigil is important to my family (and now to me). To us, it is not to be taken lightly. There is also significant value in being on vigil. Vigil is when people you don't know as well are more comfortable coming forward and giving you advice. And since we all benefit from shared experience, this is a valuable facet to this tradition. I personally received A LOT of solid advice as well as heartfelt truths during my vigil, that I don't believe I would have received otherwise. I am grateful. Vigil isn't for everyone, but I value mine.

Now that you've been elevated, how has it impacted your sense of identity and belonging within the organization?

First and foremost, apart from my wife and inspiration Lady Kassandra Formica, I now no longer represent an individual with my comportment (i.e. my Knight Ogedei BAHADUR), I now represent an entire order. Even more than before, I need to be an ambassador for what we (the Order of Chivalry) represent. Every word I speak...every move I make...they are no longer for me, and my benefit. My primary aim needs to be, forever more, to the benefit of our Society and the people who work and live within it. For some, elevation to an order is the end of the line. But I feel differently. I still see room for personal and martial growth. And I see room to share what I have and what I've learned.

As you reflect on your journey to date, what are your hopes and aspirations for the future as you see it?

"Future"...what a nebulous, but grand concept. I think that I will answer this in equally terms. As I think I can cover all facets in one. The concept is that of Progressive Overload. At its root, it is an exercise science term, but it can evolve to encompass all of what we do. In short, it means "Do what you can, until you can do more". In the gym, lift what you can, until you can lift more. On the field, fight with as much skill as you possess, until you possess more. Off the field, give as much of yourself as you can, until you can give more. Socially, be as understanding and as open-minded as you can, until you can manage more.

Now we know I am a huge fan of your sweetheart and inspiration Lady Kassandra Formica, and we've all seen here amazing work on your garb for your elevation, and I know this enquiring mind wants to know how special that made you feel?



Kassandra is the love of my life and my reason for existing. Without her love and approval, I am nothing. Every single day, she gives me the strength and courage to push forward. She is my light, the bedrock of my belief, and simultaneously the source of my strength and my greatest weakness. I have never figured out why she chose me...and honestly, I'm afraid to speak my confusion too loudly in case someone figures out that a mistake has been made and I lose her. How special did she make me feel? VERY! She always does!

Would it be okay if I asked you to describe what your personal tenants are that you believe are/were an integral part of your journey to becoming a Knight?

This is a far more complicated answer than I can give here, but I'll give some of what I can.

- o Leave everywhere slightly better than when you arrived.
- o Never be satisfied with anything less than perfect. Does that mean that everything (anything) you do will be perfect? HECK NO. But keep trying as hard as you can. (i.e. do everything with your whole ass)
- o Know/Learn your limits. No one can do everything. Do what you can when you can.
- o Share pieces with others. We are each valuable in our own way. Take a piece from this person and a piece from that person and internalize it until those pieces have made you into a person worth taking pieces from.

#### Final Thoughts

We plainly see in our conversation with Sir Skane Tyrsson, it's clear that his journey to knighthood is marked by reflection, growth, and an unwavering commitment to the values of the Order of Chivalry. His insights on the significance of vigil, the weight of responsibility, and the importance of community resonate deeply within Avacal. As he looks to the future, embracing the concept of 'Progressive Overload', we are reminded that the path of a knight is not just an endpoint but a continuous journey of improvement and service. We thank Sir Skane for sharing his experiences and candor, and we look forward to witnessing the impact he will undoubtedly have on our community as he grows in his new peerage.

# The Unique Skills and Work of the Medieval Surveyor By Křišťan Věstonice of Moravia

#### Introduction

One important element of SCA arts and sciences that may not be intuitively known or understood is the role of a surveyor and the surveyor's value to medieval society. Surveyors existed in the Middle Ages; they were guild members given legal sanction as approved agents for their work by the King or through the military. Medieval surveyors were literate and understood complex mathematics - normally the result of a long and rigorous skilled-labor apprenticeship tenure with a guild.

Unlike fine arts, entertainment, or practical craftsmanship, surveying is a skill that does not produce a product of beauty or functionality that can be appreciated in its final form. Surveying is rather like mathematics or astronomy - a tool that increases our ability to create order and improves our understanding of the world around us.

This article aims to increase our awareness of the roles, functions, and value of the surveyor's craft. In doing so, it is hoped that our lives in the Middle Ages - and our collective sense of place in it - may be more deeply and colorfully enriched.

#### **Greek Mathematics Meet Roman Technology**

The revival of interest in Euclidean mathematics was a direct result of the "...Renaissance in education and scientific knowledge<sup>2</sup>... providing the necessary intellectual foundation for the development of [medieval] surveying."<sup>3</sup> At the time, the medieval human concept of an earth-centric universe combined with Euclidean geometry provided accurate earth measurement; but without calculus, was lacking when projected into space [e.g., for maritime navigation].<sup>4</sup>

Medieval surveyors used crude but effective Roman tools for their work.<sup>5</sup> In the hands of a capable surveyor with a firm grasp of mathematics, these tools were precise and accurate when measured against future scientific standards. There were limitations, however. Roman surveying instruments were restricted in range to the vision of the naked eye, and the equipment was unwieldy and vulnerable to the caprices of weather.<sup>6</sup>

Medieval surveying was - quite simply - grueling mental and physical work, frequently in difficult weather conditions. To accomplish the work normally required a large team of workhands, each with a specific duty to aid the surveyor.

#### Tax Assessment for the King

"The principal task of the surveyor in the medieval economy was assessing and recording the customary obligations and rights of tenants of the manor, not the technical business of measuring the size of tracts, or making their boundaries. [The surveyor] kept the rolls and records of rights to land, of agricultural

production, of the number of trees in the forest, and of the rents, fees, fines, or days of work due from each tenant to his or her lord."<sup>7</sup> In England and throughout central Europe this tax assessment was called *taille* (Tah-**LAY**), or simply "aid" conducted on behalf of, and under the sanction of, the King.<sup>8</sup>

The scope, therefore, of the medieval surveyor was mathematical, legal, and judicial. In addition, the surveyor was required to be well versed in geology, fish and wildlife ecology, crop and timber production, animal husbandry, and topography and land measurement. In taille assessment, the mathematical and technical aspects of surveying were of secondary importance to the general span of knowledge required for accurate taxation.

#### **Public Works**

In addition to legal authority for taille assessments, medieval surveyors also possessed technical expertise to support a variety of public works which benefitted public commerce, the military, and the concerns of the Crown.

- Surveying works for harbors and wharves, canals and aqueducts, and all-weather stone roads supported commercial and military needs.
- Plumbed city walls and fortifications supported military defense.
- Mapping and boundary surveys supported the sovereign interests of the Crown.

Of special note were road and city design surveys.

In laying the course for a road, the surveyor had to understand topography and carry on a fine balance between the cost of expensive road materials and construction against the shortest viable distance between two points. Horse and oxen-drawn commerce required a gentle gradient. As well, a steep road gradient risked washing out in heavy rains. The surveyor had to work with the terrain to lay out a road that could efficiently carry hundreds of years of traffic.

Finally, the medieval surveyor supported the interests of organized religion. The urban layout of cities significantly changed in the mid 1300's from a random form to a configuration which conveyed Christian symbolism. City plots and streets were straightened and paralleled through accurate surveying, providing a Euclidean aesthetic designed to reflect order, beauty, and truth - pleasing God as He looked down from Heaven.<sup>11</sup>

#### Value to Royalty and to the People

Using Greek mathematics and Roman technology, the role and work of a surveyor spans a significant part of medieval life. Kings, Barons, and Lords relied on trusted taille assessors to assure effective yet equitable taxation from their subjects. Surveying support to public works promoted efficient commerce for economic growth and welfare to the populace; and it maximized the effectiveness of the King's instruments of war. The surveyor's work also reproduced mathematical order in city design that reflected medieval Christian aesthetic values designed to please God.

The author hopes that our lives and personas of the Middle Ages are enriched by a consideration of how surveying as an art and science touches nearly everything we do, and improves our medieval world.

## The mabinogion - Taliesin excerpt

And this was the first poem that Taliesin ever sang, being to console Elphin in his grief for that the produce of the weir was lost, and, what was worse, that all the world would consider that it was through his fault and ill-luck. And then Gwyddno Garanhir asked him what he was, whether man or spirit. Whereupon he sang this tale, and said:—

"First, I have been formed a comely person, In the court of Caridwen I have done penance; Though little I was seen, placidly received, I was great on the floor of the place to where I was led: I have been a prized defence, the sweet muse the cause, And by law without speech I have been liberated By a smiling black old hag, when irritated Dreadful her claim when pursued: I have fled with vigour, I have fled as a frog, I have fled in the semblance of a crow, scarcely finding rest; I have fled vehemently, I have fled as a chain, I have fled as a roe into an entangled thicket; I have fled as a wolf cub, I have fled as a wolf in a wilderness, I have fled as a thrush of portending language; I have fled as a fox, used to concurrent bounds of quirks; I have fled as a martin, which did not avail; I have fled as a squirrel, that vainly hides, I have fled as a stag's antler, of ruddy course, I have fled as iron in a glowing fire, I have fled as a spear-head, of woe to such as has a wish for it; I have fled as a fierce hull bitterly fighting, I have fled as a bristly boar seen in a ravine, I have fled as a white grain of pure wheat, On the skirt of a hempen sheet entangled, That seemed of the size of a mare's foal, That is filling like a ship on the waters; Into a dark leathern bag I was thrown, And on a boundless sea I was sent adrift; Which was to me an omen of being tenderly nursed,

And the Lord God then set me at liberty."



# **RECIPES**

# **VENISON NECK POT ROAST**

#### PROVIDED BY HIS GRACE, SIR RORIK GUNNARSON



- INGREDIENTS:
- 1-2 pieces venison neck, crosscut (~1.5" thick)
- 2 large carrots, peeled, cut into 2" pieces
- 2 large potatoes, cut into 2" pieces
- 1 small rutabaga, cut into 2" pieces
- 2 yellow onions, large dice
- 2-3 sprigs rosemary
- 6-8 sprigs thyme
- 1 quart venison stock
- ~½ cup red wine
- ~\frac{1}{4} cup flour

#### METHOD:

- 1. Preheat oven to 275F
- 2. In a Dutch oven, add oil and heat to medium high.
- 3. Add in carrots, potatoes and rutabaga and brown for 4-5 minutes, remove from pan.
- 4. Brown onions in the same pan, 4-5 minutes. Remove from the pan.
- 5. Turn pan to high heat and season the neck roast with salt and pepper. Dredge it with flour, shaking off any excess. Brown all sides of the neck in the pan, 1-2 minutes each side. Remove neck roast from pan.
- 6. Use red wine to deglaze the pan, scraping up any browned bits from the bottom.
- 7. Return the neck, carrots and onions to the pan.
- 8. Add in thyme and rosemary.
- 9. Top with stock to just cover the neck and bring to a simmer.
- 10. Cover with lid and place on the center rack of the oven.
- 11. Cook until fork tender, approximately 3 hours.

# VIKING AGE BREAD RECIPE

BASED ON ANALYSIS FROM VIKING AGE, BIRKA SWEDEN BREAD FOUND

PROVIDED BY HIS GRACE, SIR RORIK GUNNARSON



#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 150 grams (2/3 cup) barley flour
- 6 tablespoons (90 grams) wholemeal flour
- 2 teaspoons crushed flax seeds
- 100 ml (1/2 cup) of water
- Pinch of salt

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Blend flours and flax seed until well mixed
- 2. Add salt and mix
- 3. Add water and knead for 5 minutes or until mixture is a ball of dough. (if it gets too watery add flours, if it is too dry add water)
- 4. Let sit for 90 minutes 2 hours
- 5. Tear the dough into small balls and make them into cookie sized small cakes
- 6. Heat a dry cast iron pan at medium heat and bake the "cookies" 5-20 minutes / side. (Option: heat over to 300-degree Fahrenheit and bake the cookies for 18-20 minutes or until brown)

# ONE GALLON HONEY MEAD

#### PROVIDED BY HIS GRACE, SIR RORIK GUNNARSON

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- distilled or filtered water
- 2-3 pounds honey, local raw honey is best
- ½ ½ package champagne yeast (find it at homebrew stores or online here)

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Simmer ½ gallon water until warm.
- 2. Add honey: 2 pounds for a dry mead or 3 pounds for a sweet mead. Stir until dissolved.
- 3. Simmer (do not boil) for about 30 minutes, skimming off any scum that forms.
- 4. Remove from heat, let cool to about 100°F, and pour into a gallon glass bottle.
- 5. Add any extra ingredients you may want.
- 6. When the temperature is below 90°F, add the yeast. One package will make 5 gallons of mead, so use between ½ of a package and ½ a package.
- 7. Cap the bottle and shake well.
- 8. Add more water to fill the bottle, leave 3-4 inches of headroom at the top.
- 9. Take the top off and add an airlock.
- 10. Once the airlock is in place, set the bottle in a cool spot for about 6 weeks.

#### NOTES:

 Within 12 to 24 hours, you will notice bubbling and foaming in the top of the bottle. If you add fruit or herbs, this may bubble into the airlock and get stuck, you will want to clean it out well and reset it. A clogged airlock could lead to an explosion.



After six weeks it should have stopped bubbling or slowed to once every minute
 When the bubbling stops, it is time to bottle it.

#### **BOTTLING YOUR HOMEMADE MEAD**

- Pour the mead out of the bottle into a strainer to remove any fruit or herbs.
- Pour the strained mead into another bottle and cap tightly. The mead will continue to ferment for a while, producing a sparkling beverage.
- You can put the mead in a refrigerator for a week or so. This will cause the yeast to slow and settle to the bottom.
- Open the bottle and decant the top of the mead, down to the sediment on the bottom, into another bottle. Your mead will now be still, or (mostly) non-sparkling.



#### DRY OR SWEET HOMEMADE MEAD?

#### Sweet Mead

o To get a sweeter mead, add more honey (3 cups or more), and use a yeast made for sweet wines (Lalvin 78-B Narbonne is one of the best you can use).

#### Dry Mead

o To get a dry mead, use a lesser amount of honey (like the 2 cups mentioned) and stick with the champagne yeast.

#### IDEAS FOR FLAVORING HOMEMADE MEAD

- You could start with apple cider instead of water. This is called cyser.
- Herbs such as lemon balm, lemongrass, rosemary, hibiscus, vanilla, rose, and even hops can be used. For this size recipe, use ½ cup dried herbs or one cup fresh herbs.
- Fruit is another option for flavoring mead. Blackberries, blueberries, wild grapes, persimmon, rhubarb, spiced apple, lime or grapefruit, elderflower, maple, or spiced pumpkin are some possibilities.

#### ADDITIONAL TIPS FOR HOMEMADE MEAD

- Sterilize your equipment and bottles to prevent bacteria from forming. Filtered water is also a must.
- Fruit that has not been cleaned could also cause problems and be sure to keep an eye on your airlocks, so they are not clogged.
- If you sniff your mix while it is brewing and you smell rotting fruit, don't worry. It's not rotting, it's working! If it still smells bad after it is done, leave it a few weeks in the new bottles. Raw and "green" mead will smell strong. Once it sits for a while, the smell should mellow out.

IF YOU SEE MOLD, OR WORSE, MAGGOTS, COMPOST IT. THERE IS NO HELP FOR THAT BATCH.

MEAD MADE THIS WAY WILL HAVE SOME ALCOHOL, USUALLY AROUND 15%. NOT A LOT, BUT MORE

THAN OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES. BE AWARE OF THIS IN CASE YOU WANT TO GIVE IT TO

SOMEONE WITH SENSITIVITIES TO ALCOHOL.

# **TOURTELETES IN FRYTURE**

#### PROVIDED BY LUCREZIA ISEPPA CONSTANTINA DI ARBOREA

Forme of Cury from the 14<sup>th</sup> century has many delightful surprises for the person looking for something sweet such as this recipe of small figs basted with honey. Showcasing the use of spices (I've even supplied my own Poudre Fort recipe) and emphasizing the flavours that were popular at the time. Fig and honey pocket pie anyone?



#### **Modernized Version:**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

#### **DIRECTIONS:**

#### 1. Prepare the Filling:

a. In a mixing bowl, combine the finely chopped or puréed figs with saffron and mixed spice blend. Adjust the spices to taste and set aside.

#### 2. Make the Pastry:

a. In a large bowl, mix the flour and salt. Add the cold butter and use a pastry cutter or your fingers to combine until the mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Gradually add cold water, one tablespoon at a time, mix until the dough comes together. Avoid overworking the dough. Form the dough into a ball, wrap it in plastic wrap, and refrigerate for at least 30 minutes.

#### 3. Assemble the Tourteletes:

a. Roll out the chilled pastry on a floured surface to about 1/8 inch thick. Cut out circles of dough (about 4-5 inches in diameter). Place a spoonful of the fig filling in the center of each circle. Fold the pastry over to form a halfmoon shape and seal the edges well, crimping with a fork for decoration.

#### 4. Fry the Tourteletes:

a. Heat oil in a deep-frying pan to around 350°F (175°C). Carefully add the tourteletes to the hot oil in batches, frying until they are golden brown and crispy, about 3-4 minutes on each side. Remove with a slotted spoon and drain on paper towels.

#### 5. Baste with Honey:

a. In a small pot, gently heat the honey, skimming off any scum that rises to the surface. Once the tourteletes have drained, brush the warm honey over them.

#### 6. Serve:

a. Enjoy the tourteletes hot or cold and share with your friends!





## **NEW BUSINESS**

Calendar questions:

- Kingdom events on long weekends possibly moving things off of long weekends
  - o We need to commit as a populace to participating in the long weekend. It is pricey to get appropriate venues for it.
  - o If we don't want to use a long weekend, then let's don't but commit to one way or the other.
  - o Many do not attend curia on Monday and so it's difficult to make appropriate decisions
  - Kingdom events require a lot of things and it's difficult to have them all scheduled in a single day
  - o Can some of those things move to a zoom meeting. Curia anyone? An informal polling of preference by show of hands was requested – not a vote and no immediate change intended, just an indication of preference:
    - Online preference 23
    - In person preference 0

- Good with whatever 25
- o Spreading out the calendar more evenly, the calendar does already fairly well spread out. Most months have at least 2 events with a weekend in between with the exception of June which may have more depending on when July long weekend ends. 




