

If the Crown is to pass the Kingdom needs groups willing to support Crown Event bids for our Crown Tournaments and Coronations.

Knowing where these events are to be held can affect whether people are able to enter; having clarity about Royal obligations makes for a better reign.

There are useful resources and experienced people willing and able to assist in bid development and event planning. A good place to start is the newly updated Crown Event Handbook and associated resources to be found here:

https://seneschal.lochac.sca.org/guides-and-resources/crown-events/

And to squash some misconceptions ~ you do not need to be a Barony to bid for a Crown Event; the Kingdom takes none of the net income from a Crown Event (it all goes to the group); you do not need to provide accommodation; you do not need to use the same site throughout; the event does not need to be large/flamboyant/expensive.

We encourage groups to consider looking to the future, beyond the minimum timeline ~ start thinking now about 2024-2026, start talking to people in your local group and nearby, start gathering ideas and developing plans.

They also work closely with the masonry team (who run the underlying server infrastructure), and keep an eye on domain names and SSL certificates that are used for our web presence, but are not directly responsible for the server hardware or software upgrades.
