The Knights Hospitaller, founded in 1099 in Jerusalem are an oft followed group within the Society due to their military, chivalrous, noble, and pious nature. This Catholic military order was better known as the Knights of the Hospital of Saint John of Jerusalem, as the initial charge of the order was to care for poor or sick pilgrims in the Holy Land. After the west was booted from the Levant in the late 13th century, the Order moved first to Rhodes, then to Malta as their home base. In 1530, the Sicilian King granted the lands of Malta to the Order, which they ruled until 1798.

Today, the Sovereign Military Hospitaller Order of Saint John of Jerusalem, of Rhodes and of Malta, or Sovereign Military Order of Malta represents the latest iteration of this same group, based in Malta and Rome. They have their own passports, stamps, and an observer seat at the UN. Closely tied to the Holy See in Rome, they are still a separate group, and exist around the world as Knights and Dames of the Order. Fort St. Angelo in Malta is today home to the Knights of the Order who have taken the Order's vows of poverty, chastity and obedience.

So on your next visit to Malta, go to Fort St. Angelo and meet other Knights of the modern middle ages, the latest in the long lineage of the Knights Hospitaller. And now you know more random carp.

#### DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR COMMENTARY

#### CORPORATE POLICY XIX. DELEGATION OF INVESTMENT AUTHORITY POLICY

The Board of Directors is currently considering the following addition to the SCA's Corporate Policy:

XIX. Delegation of Investment Authority Policy

The Board shall ensure that fiduciary responsibilities concerning the proper management of SCA, Inc.'s institutional funds are fulfilled through appropriate investment structure, internal and external management, and portfolio performance consistent with all policies and procedures. Based on the advice and recommendations of the Treasurer and its external fund manager(s), the Board shall approve investment policies and objectives that reflect the long-term investment-risk orientation appropriate to the organization. The Board may, at its sole discretion, create or eliminate committee(s) to advise the Board in furthering its duties and may select, appoint, and remove members thereto.

The Board hereby delegates supervisory responsibility for the management of its invested funds to the Corporate Treasurer, subject to the financial limitations specified in Corpora, as noted below:

- determine that institutional funds are prudently and effectively managed with the assistance of management and any necessary investment consultants and/or other outside professionals, if any.
- recommend the retention and/or dismissal of investment consultants and/or other outside professionals.
- receive and review reports from management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals, if any.
- periodically meet with management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals management, investment consultants and/or other outside professionals.
- report to the Board (as needed) whether this policy, investment activities, risk management controls and
  processes continue to be consistent with meeting the goals and objectives set for the management of
  institutional funds.
- execute such investment transactions as are necessary to ensure that SCA, Inc.'s investment portfolio reflects
  the asset allocation, investment-risk orientation, or other direction regarding the investment portfolio as has
  been established by the Board.
