

From the Kingdom Seneschal

Greetings!

Letters of Intent to fight in the Fall Crown Tournament of Caid on Saturday, September 9, 2023 are now being accepted. Letters will be accepted until 11:00pm on the evening of Saturday, August 26, 2023. Please read this complete message since the method for submitting Letters of Intent has changed.

Fall Crown Tournament will be held in the Barony of Starkhafn. The format will be a standard double elimination tournament with the final round being best two out of three.

All entrants must have current membership with combatants having current fighter authorization at the time of submission. Prior to submitting a Letter of Intent, all combatants must verify their authorization status using the following link - http://www.dev.caid-commons.org/list. Contact the Kingdom Earl Marshal - marshal@sca-caid.org - with any concerns about authorization status.

Please read through the following to ensure you meet the requirements for the list:

- All persons entering Crown Lists must be current members and their membership must extend through the reign for which they are fighting.
- All persons must have been a resident of Caid for a period of one year between first Caidan event attendance and this Crown List in which they want to participate.
- All persons must have primary fealty to the Crown of Caid.
- All persons entering Crown Lists must be at least 18 years of age.
- All persons entering Crown Lists must have a name and device registered with, or in submission to, the College of Arms on the day of Crown Tournament.
- All persons entering Crown Lists must have demonstrated minimum participation during the period beginning with the previous Crown Tournament up to (but not including) the current Crown Tournament. Minimum participation consists of attending five events. At least four of those must be events listed in the official Kingdom Calendar as published in the kingdom newsletter and one of the following may count in their place: official meetings of baronial or shire councils, fighter practices, or guild meetings.

Great Officers of State along with Territorial Barons/Baronesses and Their Heirs entering Crown Lists are additionally required to submit to the Crown the name of an informed designated representative(s) capable of and willing to assume the duties of the office during the term of the reign.

Starting this Crown Tournament, Letters of Intent are to be submitted through the Kingdom Website with the following form: https://forms.gle/jcXthmAMcXkPWpJt7. The link to the form can also be found on the Seneschal's page at http://www.sca-caid.org/caid/seneschal/.

To submit your Letter of Intent, the following information must be provided:

- The entrant's and consort's SCA names
- Both membership numbers and expiration dates
- Modern names and contact information, and
- Verification of the above required items to participate in Crown Lists. A list of events attended will provide verification of attendance.

There is also an opportunity on the form to submit a letter formally expressing your desire to enter Crown Tournament.

Could I Make A Note?

Hail and well met good people of the Society for Creative Anachronism! It's your friendly neighborhood Kingdom Chronicler here, reminding you that one of the most important aspects of our volunteer organization is... its volunteers! Now, I realize that I am not breaking any new ground here; however, beyond assisting with the dreaded diseases of "helium hand" and "refusing to ask for help," there is another way in which to serve in Caid's populace, and indeed the other members of the Knowne World.

I am talking about writing Award Letter recommendations. Our game is often a wonderful and engaging endeavor. And, there are few things in the SCA as heartwarming as seeing someone receive just and timely recognition. We are very lucky to have a system where anyone, and I do mean anyone, may recommend anyone else for any award in any Kingdom. Now, it helps to know the person, the award, and the respective Kingdom's climate before firing off a recommendation in a foreign land for someone to receive their "Order of the Ordered Order" (I imagine when a Herald reads this it would sound like "OOOooooOOOooooh!"). But, I mean, you could do it.

While there are 20 different Kingdoms in the SCA, there are a staggeringly greater number of awards. True enough, certain things like AoAs (Awards of Arms) are standard, while many others are not. For example, though we technically *have* them, Grants of Arms not attached to one of our Orders in Caid (sometimes referred to in a saucy tone as "naked Grants"), are almost never given. But in other Kingdoms, they are an integral part of the awards recognition process. Here in Caid, there are four "levels" of award: Non-armigerous, those with Arms, those with a Grant, and those with a Patent. If you are unsure of what a person has, you can either check their Caid Wiki entry (if they have one [and if they don't maybe they should get one?]), or look them up online at http://heralds.sca-caid.org/op/people.php and see what awards they already have.

I cannot stress enough that the Crown is always looking for recommendations from Their populace. As wise as the Sovereign and Consort may be, and as many and varied as Their Court undoubtedly are, there are simply not enough eyes and ears to see and hear everything that everyone does every day! So, please, should you notice an excellent fighter, a devoted servant, a talented artisan, a formidable archer, a swift equestrian, a person of great courtesy and wit, or anything else that seems, to you, to be noteworthy, then by all means, make the Crowns (and if living in the confines of a Barony, the respective Excellencies) aware of the good gentle.

Now for the old fogie note: **back in MY day** we had to write physical letters and use a stamp and everything. But now we have these wonderful websites with an automated letter generator and it can assist you in the process. For Caid, it is at- http://royals.sca-caid.org/awards/online.php

Going to Your First War?

If you are planning on going to your first war, we thought we would make some suggestions and recommendations that may help make your first war just that much easier.



First and foremost, it is okay if you don't have period style camping gear! We all started from somewhere and there is no reason to let your camping gear stop you from enjoying your first war! Just let your camp master know you have modern gear and they will be able to place you properly.



An old trick to keeping hydrated is to eat pickles or even drink the pickle juice. However, not everyone can or really wants to drink pickle juice and we get that. So, we suggest picking up some electrolyte packets from your local big box store.



If you are planning on bringing water (which we highly suggest for summer time events), you can freeze some of your water bottles/jugs to use instead of only relying on ice to chill your cooler.

Which we suggest you start cooling 24 hours before loading it up.



I have seen people use plant misters as a way to cool off while not being too modern looking while doing so.



If you have time, make a towel tunic. They are helpful for going back and forth from the showers. You can use an old towel, some terry cloth fabric, or even an old bed sheet to make them.

As was stated before, these are just a few ideas. Of course, if you ask nicely, most people are willing to help and answer any further questions you may have.
