Greetings, kinsfolk,

In general, all is quiet with the Exchequer's office. I want to make a couple quick points about PayPal pre-registration as we get a better handle on how it impacts events.

If your group is using PayPal for preregistration, please take the fees into consideration in the event budget. PayPal fees add up to about 3.8% for fees paid through that service. This is especially important for Kingdom and Known World level events, as 3.8% starts to add up quickly and can significantly impact event profits.

Another note about site fees and PayPal: groups MAY NOT charge different site fees for PayPal pre-registration. This is not allowed by PayPal. So, unfortunately, groups can't charge more to help cover some of the fees. Groups CAN put out a donation jar at the Gate for anyone who wants to donate and help cover fees.

That's it for this month. If I haven't said it recently, thank you all for your invaluable service to your groups, and by extension the Kingdom and Society.

BE ON TARGET! DEPUTY SOCIETY MARSHALS WANTED

These are exciting times for the Society, as we return to events and practices, have ever-increasing access to historical sources and equipment, and see growing interest in historical combat. The Society Marshal is seeking two Deputies to join our team,

working to encourage the participation of all in the Society's martial activities, and striving to expand and improve those activities for the benefit of the Society and its members.

Two Deputies are currently being sought for the roles of:

Society Deputy for Target Archery (TA) Society Deputy for Thrown Weapons (TW)

The duties of the office include:

- Inform and support the Society Marshal in matters concerning TA and TW
- Oversee Kingdom TA/TW Deputies concerning the supervision of TA and TW activities at Society events
- Work to promote and improve the safety of the Society's TA and TW activities
- Work with the Minister of Arts and Sciences to encourage research in weapons and the practice of historical archery and thrown weapons

Day-to-day work of the position entails administering the TA and TW activities of the Society and coordinating the activities of the Kingdom TA and TW Deputies. Reports are required to be filed quarterly to the Society Marshal summarizing the TA and TA activities of the Society. These activities specifically include:

- Supporting the Kingdom TA and TW Deputies when they have questions, and advising them as necessary
- Review and oversite of Kingdom TA and TW rules to ensure they are consistent with Society TA and TW Handbooks and any affiliate legal limitations
- Helping resolve disputes among TA and TW marshals
- Encouraging the expansion of TA and TW activities in the Society through wise revision of the Society TA and TW handbooks, and review and approval of experiments with new materials and activities.

The successful candidate must be well-versed in administrative techniques, problem solving, and interpersonal communications. The successful candidate will possess:

 Knowledge of TA or TW marshallate policy, rules, and procedures

- Knowledge of the traditions of the Society
- Negotiation skills and experience in resolving differences
- The ability to set aside all preferences and biases for the betterment of all
- Patience in the face of emotion, advocacy and provocation
- Experience in the use of modern communications media, messaging, e-mail and telephone

Pie Shenanigans!

Each WW, I try to take on a dinner for Iglesmere House, and this year I was looking for a new idea. On the way to Kingdom A&S there was a pit-stop at Norske Nook for pie, and it dawned on me that given medieval food preservation methods, a medieval camp repast might consist of a large amount of foods preserved in a crust. In addition, my household brother and I are well known for shenanigans, and this played right into one of our inside jokes.

And so pie shenanigans commenced!

Medieval feast days would have been long, drawn-out affairs, with several courses and entertainments presented between the removals. I styled my courses after French traditions, which vary slightly from the medieval pattern, but I didn't have the bandwidth to study humoral theory in the midst of everything else. These pies also don't subscribe to any one time or place, but were chosen for availability of ingredients and my personal whims.

All the pies and sauces were made in the week before the event and then kept cold or frozen, for modern food safety precautions, and thawed the day of the feast. Due to time and energy involved, I used several premade pie crusts, but used period recipes for the meat crusts. The handpies were edible coffins made in oversized muffin tins. I used a cookie cutter to distinguish the pies from each other, and provide venting. In period any venting would have been sealed with fat while hot for preservation.

The plan was for a twelve-person board (give or take), and so everything was split between two tables, each table getting its own pie.

Course 1- appetizers

Breads, various cheeses, butter, honey butter, garlic butter, and tapenade.

Water, hydromel and white wine on the table.

Course 2 – savory pies
