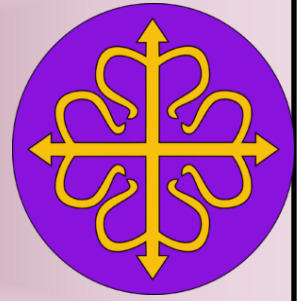

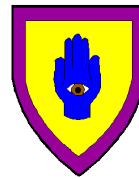

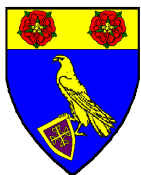

## Greetings all!

I'm in Grove City, PA typing this right now, which is my normal stopping point for the night before Pennsic. I always like to give myself an evening to rest after the drive before setting up the store.

Of course, by the time you read this, Pennsic will be over and all that's left are the cool stories and legends.

And who knows, one of those legends may be another tale like that of Phaedra's Gate, where the Calontir shield wall held a gate at Estrella again and again. It's a legend best told by Fernando, who was general at that war, or Drix, who was in the midst of it all. It's been over twenty years since that happened, so it's not as big of a thing as it once was, and that's a shame.

I'll follow up on that after I get the business out of the way. Right now, we have only one open position seeking applicants. This is the **Habicht Herald**, which is in charge of **heraldic education**, teaching members of the College of Heraldry, and coordinating with RUSH for heraldic classes.

I don't have much else business-wise, except to say that the heralds of Calontir have done an excellent job doing tasks that aren't always seen by everyone. You're really lucky, Calontir, to have such a good crew working for you.

So let's get back to the Calontir shield wall, and today I'm going to tie a bunch of what you see in heraldry to it. Because there's a connection. Oh, yes, there's a connection, and it's staring you in

the face.

Let's talk about displaying heraldry. Yes, you see it often enough on a banner, on clothing, or on a bunch of other things, but the basic way heraldry is displayed is on an "escutcheon." This is the general term for the shield part of a heraldic device.

Most often we shape it like a heater shield, but it can be a variety of other shield types, depending upon culture. Escutcheons actually started with kite shields, because those were more in use during the 12<sup>th</sup> century when heraldry first became heraldry (this is its own separate discussion, so just accept this statement for now). Anyway, there are all sorts of other display shapes in use in heraldry, including the lozenge, oval, and simple circle. There are also a variety of shield types that come more into use as the shield developed over the years.

However, not a single one of them really has any connection to the Calontir shield wall, right? The shields that make our shield wall so successful are scutums, and these were designed something like 1500 years before heraldry becomes a thing.

Ah, but we have ways of making this work, and as usual, I'll go into the etymology of escutcheon. The word comes to us from Old North French and its word "escuchon," which was a variant of Old French "escusson," which meant the half-crown coin as well as a coat of arms.

Shockingly enough, escusson derives from Vulgar Latin, as so many Old French words do. This came from "scutionem," and I think you see where we're going with this now. Scutionem does, in fact, derive from scutum, and there you go, the word "escutcheon," which is defined as the

“shield upon which coats of arms are depicted,” is a direct word descendent of scutum.

Side note, “scutum” derives from the Proto-Indo-European root “skoito,” which also gives us Old Irish “sciath,” Welsh “ysgwyd,” Breton “scoed,” Old Prussian “staytan,” and Russian “ščit.” Of note, this does not include Old English “scild,” Old Norse “skjöldr,” Old Saxon “skild,” Middle Dutch “scilt,” Dutch “schild,” German “Schild,” and Gothic “skildus,” which all come from the Proto-Indo-European root “skel” instead of “skoito,” though the similarity makes me wonder if the two roots came from a common source in the languages that would evolve into Proto-Indo-European.

But then, I’m a word geek, as I’m sure you all already know. Anyway, I think it’s time for me to stop typing and get going to Pennsic, where every one of those words might get used at one time or another.

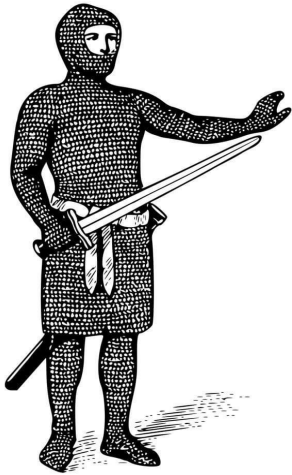

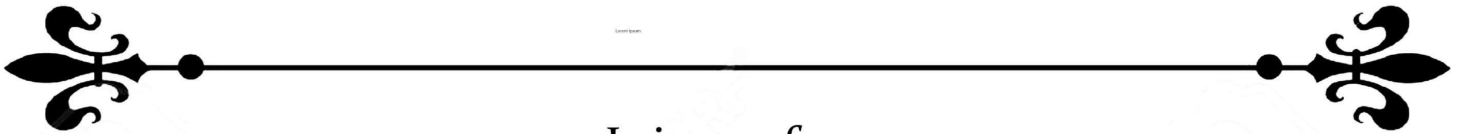




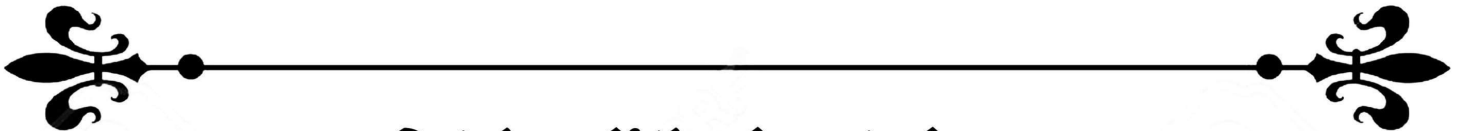

For Their Majesties to hold Court, & for official business to happen, a complete flyer must be published in *The Mews*. Failure to do so means that the Crown can not hold Court at that event. Prior to emailing a flyer confirm your event with the Reeve. *The Mews* **WILL NOT** publish an announcement if your event has not been approved or confirmed. ### **Flyers MUST contain these SIX ITEMS:**

- ♦ Day month and year of the event
- ♦ Site open & close times for populace
- ♦ Name of the sponsoring group or groups
- ♦ Location of the event. The name of the event site, and full address.
- ♦ Name, both SCA and Modern, of the Event

Steward, including contact phone and email. ( Needed if there an emergency / or issues arise)

- ♦ Details of Registration : Do NOT use “FEE” as a describer for registration cost.

**Adult Event Registration: \$25 / Adult Member Discount Registration: \$20 / Youth (6-17) \$5 / Children 5 & Under: FREE**

**Event Copies: An Editable version of your flyer MUST be sent. PDFs ARE NOT ACCEPTED AND RETURNED FOR EDIT.**

**Deadline:** The Chronicler must receive event copies no later than the **1<sup>st</sup> of the month TWO MONTHS PRIOR to your event.** ( e.g. if the event is in November, the flyer must be received by September 1st. ) If there is an issue with meeting the deadline, please contact the Chronicler ASAP. There is no grace period the deadline is final and non-negotiable. The earlier a flyer is received the better!
