### AVACAL ADVOCACY COUNCIL

Avacal is seeking 2-6 people for the position of Advocate Council. The Avacal Advocacy Council will address situations when a member of the populace needs help understanding their options should they feel they are being mistreated. The role of the Advocacy Council is to support the populace member in addressing their concerns respectfully to support a healthy culture within Avacal. This support can help members to navigate kingdom laws and policies, listen to concerns, offer advice such as SCA policy and procedure options, and assist with conflict resolution.

One member of the Advocacy Council shall be the Avacal DEI officer.

Responsibilities of the Advocacy role:

• Be willing to be approached during events, meetings or outside SCA formal events to assist with managing interpersonal conflict between populace members in an advisory role. • Actively listen to the concern of the populace member and validate facts by asking clarifying questions.

• Offer feedback, where appropriate, and, if needed, support the design of scripting to address conflict by focusing on facts and the situation's impact.

They may be present with the populace member when they approach the other party in the efforts to resolve the conflict.

Considerations for this position:

• Be considered by others to be approachable, open and willing to engage in dialogue.

· Feels confident to partner with the DEI office, as required.

• Comfortable with conflict, the ability to be objective, listen for facts and assumptions, and offer coaching to address the issue at hand.

• Enhanced interpersonal skills and the ability to manage conflict without creating barriers

• Be non-judgemental and keep the confidence of the people involved

· Receive direction from the Kingdom Seneschal as per the grievance procedure/bullying and harassment policy requirement, etc.

• Dependable access to email and phone. • Strong ability to build and maintain relationships across all peerages.

· We are skilled at working collaboratively with all leadership across Avacal, including the Crown, Kingdom Seneschal, Baron and Baronesses, all group-level seneschals, etc.

• Attend training to become skilled in Advocacy Training which includes: active listening, effective feedback, and managing conflict.

## "Thank you,""You're doing a good job," and other priceless awards

**Featured** Article

The topic of longevity in the SCA is one that comes up regularly. Since very shortly after I joined, I've been told that the average SCAdian lasts around 3-5 years before quitting. I've heard a few reasons for this - internal politics, life circumstances, failure to integrate into one group or another, event burnout, etc. - but I think there may be another reason.

In your first few years in the Society, it's common to receive quite a lot of recognition fairly quickly for the things that you do. If you're active, you'll probably get an Award of Arms, maybe a baronial award for service, combat, and/or arts and sciences, and possibly even a kingdom-level award for the same. After that, there's quite a long gap. Everyone knows that you make beautiful clothes or run the best events around, and since you've been recognized for it, there's not much more to say - at least, unless you receive a peerage ten or more years down the road. You start to feel forgotten or underappreciated after a while, which makes other small annoyances seem larger.

Now, I'm not sure everyone is that bothered about how often they receive awards. However, if people leaving the SCA is at least partially caused by feeling underappreciated by the community, it may be possible to fix it. It's good practice in general to express appreciation for the people around you. The simple courtesy of just saying "thank you," "you did a wonderful job," or even "I love how you do this," in a meaningful, sincere way can be even more important than an award recommendation to someone whose energy is flagging.

Here are some of the ways I intend to show more gratitude and appreciation for others in the SCA in the future:

• After eating my meal, I will make a point of thanking at least one member of the feast team for taking dozens of hours out of their busy schedule to cook for the populace.

 $\cdot$  When I check in at gate, I will thank whoever is sitting in the cold, wet, or blazing heat (the three seasons of Avacal) for taking the time out to check people in.

• When I notice people moving and setting up tables, thrones, erics, or other heavy items, I will thank them. We don't get to see their bruises, sore muscles, and stubbed toes the next day - but we can all appreciate the ability to sit and watch court or take shelter under the pavilions they put up!

· I will clean up after myself, and if possible, stay late to help the tear-down team. If I am unable to stay to clean up, I will thank the people tearing down for sacrificing their time to do it for the rest of us.

· I will make a note to thank royalty and coronets for their incredibly important service at some point during their reign. It is incredibly emotionally, financially and physically taxing to do these jobs.

• I will thank officers as they step up and step down for their service. Their administrative work in the background makes it possible for us to organize ourselves and play this game. I promise to never say "poor you" or "what a sucker" when someone takes an office. I will not speak sarcastically about officer positions, complain about the fact that nobody has taken an office, or be critical about an officer in a non-constructive fashion.

· I will thank people who regularly host and organize activities, classes, championships, prize competitions, and tournaments. Without them, there is nothing to do.

· I will thank the event stewards every time I attend an event. If I need to communicate with an event steward during the event planning process, I will speak to them with the kindness, gratitude and patience that I would if someone was doing me a personal favor.

I will speak about the research, arts, martial activities, or service which other people enjoy with the greatest respect and enthusiasm. I will not fool myself into thinking that the activities that I like to do in the SCA are more important, essential, or interesting than anyone else's. I will not suggest that what I enjoy should take more precedence than what someone else enjoys.

· If I like what someone is doing, I will say so. If I appreciate what someone has done, I will say so. If someone has inspired me through their actions or words, I will tell them.

## DIY Salt Ice Cooler Tubes

I don't recall when I learned this, or from whom, but this is definitely worth sharing for our hot summer camping season for both mundane and sca camping events.

#### Materials:

1.5" - 3" diameter PVC pipe ( purchase a length of PVC piping to cut down into portions to fit into you cooler. ) PVC end fittings to fit the diameter of your pipe.

PVC glue (using quality glue extends the life of your cooler tube)

#### Notes:

A thinner diameter pipe will freeze faster, which also means it will melt quicker; choose what is appropriate for your needs, and cooler size.

The salt water cooler tubes will need at least 24 hours to freeze properly for every linear foot x1.5 inches.

Salt Water:

To ensure you have the correct ratio of salt and warm water fill a large pitcher (juice jug/ gallon size) or other container with a pouring spout 3/4 full. Start by adding a half cup of salt (please note where you get your water from may require more salt to be added), stir, gently place in fresh egg.

Does it float? Yes - you've got it! No - add salt by half cup measures until egg floats. Set aside.

#### Assemble:

Measure the interior of your cooler; is the wall on a slope or perfectly straight? Use the narrowest dimension for a sloped wall. Use those measurements less 1" when cutting your pipe to length. This is to make room for end caps and for easy in and out of your cooler.

The next measurement is linear along your tube (without ends attached), you will mark the maximum fill line at 85%. For example a tube without end caps 20" will have the maximum fill line marked off at 17". Salt water expands on average 9% at 1.5 inches diameter, so using and 85% overall ratio is good up to and including 3" diameter and air pressure.

Put 1 end cap on each tube opposite the maximum fill line, using PVC glue. Allow to dry completely before the next step.

When one end is completely dry, place tubes in bucket, and add salt water to fill line.

One at a time, carefully add second end cap with PVC glue and place back in bucket to final end cap to dry completely. Wait 24hrs to ensure your salt water cooler tubes are water tight.

You can now freeze them.

Happy camping with no melted pools of water in your cooler!




