- An attached copy of the SIGNED event form
- Consider including details such as directions to the site, merchant information, event activities, site restrictions, and ADA accessibility options.

Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar). The deadline does not change for Sundays or holidays. Late submissions may not make it into that month's issue.
- Articles may be reformatted for publication. Please use a single font; do not use tabs or create columns.
- Event Articles should be provided as an attached MS Word, .txt, or Open Office file.

From the Society Seneschal

Applications Open - Society Seneschal/Vice President for Operations

The Society for Creative Anachronism (SCA) is seeking candidates for the position of Society Seneschal/Vice President for Operations.

The Society Seneschal is considered both a Society and Corporate officer, and is responsible for coordinating the administration of the Society's historical re-creation. This involves directing the activities of the Kingdom Seneschals and of Society-level deputies. Where questions arise concerning the intent of Corpora, the Board specifically authorizes the Society Seneschal to make interpretations and clarifications. The Society Seneschal is also responsible for reviewing all sanction related activities.

This is a part-time stipend position requiring a minimum of 25 hours per week, often more.

Applicants must possess strong communication skills and be capable of interacting with unique SCA personalities without regard to rank or position in the organization. The ability to process and distill large amounts of information from multiple sources is required. Organizational and problem-solving skills are essential. Having held a Kingdom Seneschal position, while not required, is preferred. Applicants must be capable of maintaining a home office space, have access to internet, PC/tablet, printer, and possess word processing skills. Proficiency with Microsoft Office and Adobe Pro is a plus. Ready access to postal service for the mailing of trackable documents is required.

Required skills or background:

- Prior experience in positions of leadership within the SCA or in leading volunteer organizations
- Excellent working knowledge of current SCA corporate documents and handbooks
- Ability to research issues surrounding kingdom and Society rules and policies
- Understanding of how the SCA's sanction and investigative procedures work; direct experience with these procedures is preferred
- Ability to maintain confidentiality of investigations and other confidential material
- Ability to manage multiple projects and oversee volunteers on both Society and Kingdom levels
- Excellent communication skills, both written and oral
- The ability and willingness to communicate via email, phone, and videoconferencing on a regular basis
- Ability to explain policies, delegate projects, and build consensus

The Society Seneschal is responsible for the following duties:

- Oversee directly and indirectly the planning and implementation of all "game side" activities.
- Deal with large amounts of correspondence with many individuals, including but not limited to all kingdom seneschals, royalty, and
- corporate/Society level officers, especially the President, VP for Corporate Operations, and Executive Assistant to the Board of Directors.
- Meet via video conference and/or phone with kingdom seneschals, Directors, and other corporate and Society officers several times a month. Provide training and advice to kingdom seneschals on a regular basis.
- Present sanction packets to the Board and provide oversight of investigations related to possible sanctions.
- Interpret Corpora and other SCA policies as needed; revise policies and create new policies as needed to facilitate SCA activities.
- Evaluate and create documentation as needed to facilitate a positive experience for SCA participants.
- Quarterly review of all Kingdom Seneschal reports, respond to reports, and refer Kingdom Seneschal requests or questions to the appropriate Society or Corporate officer for assistance as needed.
- Submit detailed quarterly reports to the President and Board, and supplemental reports as needed.
- Attend all quarterly meetings of the Board of Directors, mid-quarter conference call meetings, and other meetings as required.
- Other duties and projects may be assigned by the Board or President.

The Society Seneschal must be available for the four quarterly Board meetings, typically held over a Friday and Saturday or a Saturday and Sunday. These meetings may be held via video conference or in person. In-person meetings require travel, typically on a Thursday and Sunday. In addition, the Society Seneschal must be available for conference call meetings of the Board four to twelve times a year, typically on weekday evenings, and meetings or calls with officers or directors on an as-needed basis. Additional travel besides the quarterly meetings may be required, typically around SCA events.

Applications are being accepted through January 15, 2024.

Deputy Society Marshals for Thrown Weapons & Target Archery Appointed Maestra Arabella da Siena, Marshal of the Society, is pleased and proud to advise the appointment of Deputy Society Marshals for

Thrown Weapons and Target Archery.

Adam Burnham (he/him/his) is a a Business Operations Analyst for a bank. He works on gathering and writing specifications, preparing data for testing, processing data and analyzing it for results. This includes gathering input, filtering that input down to the core items needed then writing specifications and instructional documentation. Adam also enjoy Legos (star wars in particular), kayaking, fishing, and woodworking so if he's not on the range he is probably doing one of these other interests.



Master Viði Hovdestad (pictured left), OP is a Norse, 13th century gentle, based on the family farmstead (that he hopes to visit in person one day) from the Kingdom of Northshield, Barony of Nordskogen. He started in the SCA almost 20 years ago by wandering out to the archery range at my first event and have been going back ever since. He shoots modern recurve, Asiatic recurve, Longbow and Crossbow within the SCA. Master Viði also participates in leagues and competitions in the state of MN and in USA Archery in the Barebow category and enjoys helping people get started in archery and finding ways for people to participate. Whether they need period gear, modern gear, or specialty gear there is a place on the range and he will help find ways to make that happen. He has served as Baronial Captain, Regional Deputy and Kingdom Archer General.

Jon Libby (he/him/his) is the Assistant Director of Student Services for a school district outside of Boston, MA. Among other responsibilities, he oversees Special Education and Section 504. He has deep professional knowledge of disability and applicable laws. Jon regularly advises school faculty to "go where the data take us" when making decisions about how to support students and families. He is passionate about inclusion and building success for all students, including students who are neurodiverse, gender diverse, multilingual, and of all racial and ethnic backgrounds. Jon served as a Trustee for his local synagogue board, the chair of the synagogue bylaws committee, and a member of the synagogue education committee.

Pandaulf (pictured right) is from England in the early thirteenth century. He is a gentle who works to serve the populace of the realm. In the SCA, Pandaulf hails from the East Kingdom. He became a Thrown Weapons Marshal at Pennsic XXVII and has worked for over 25 years to grow the Thrown Weapons program and make it inclusive to youth and throwers with physical challenges and neurodiversity. Along the way, he has collaborated with the thrown weapons community from many kingdoms. Pandaulf served as the East Kingdom's Northern and Central Regional Deputy as well as a Marshal at Large. He was the Deputy Marshal in Charge of Thrown Weapons at Pennsic XLVIII. During the pandemic shutdowns, Pandualf led a workgroup of throwers and thrown weapons marshals from five Kingdoms on how to make accommodations so that thrown weapons is an activity accessible to all.

- REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTENT POSITION BARON AND BARONESS OF TWIN MOONS -

The Baron and Baroness of Twin Moons are preparing to conclude their tenure and enjoy a much deserved retirement. It is time to request Letters of Intent. On Thursday, January 25th 2024 at the Quartermoon Tournament there will be a polling for the next pair to lead the barony who will step up at Border Wars, March 21st-24th.

Below are the Guidelines for Participation as a Baronial Candidate

- 1. Baronial candidates must be current paid members and must receive their Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Twin Moons.
- 2. Candidates must be at least 18 years old.
- 3. Candidates must have Letters of Intent in the hands of the Crown, the Kingdom Seneschal, & the Baron & Baroness no later than Sunday, December 10th 2023. Letters should be written with the understanding that (if accepted by the Crown), the letters will be published in the Baronial Newsletter for the populace to review prior to the polling.
- 4. Candidates must include the below information in their Letter of Intent:
- a. Full contact information, including SCA & modern names, addresses, phone numbers, email, & membership numbers & expiration date
 - b. Their reasons for seeking the position
 - c. Their history of participation in the SCA & amp; the Barony of Twin Moons
 - d. Their plans for the future of the group
 - e. Their understanding of the responsibilities of the position of Baron & Baroness.
 - f. Their statement that they are willing to be installed with a two or three year warrant in the position, & understand their Letter of Intent will be published in the Baronial Newsletter if their candidacy is accepted by the Crown.

In addition, please review the following information regarding your participation in the Barony of Twin Moons Polling

A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of Twin Moons will be conducted on Thursday January 25th 2024 to determine their support of candidates for Baron & Baroness. The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling may be held immediately following the closing & tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all pollings held that day, you must be a Sustaining, Associate, or Family member who is 18 years old or older, & amp; must receive a Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Twin Moons.

- 1. Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.
- 2. You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of Twin Moons, & this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.
- 3. NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of Twin Moons, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown & Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections & preferences. The Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.
- 4. You must be 18 years old or older & amp; present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

**** SPECIAL ZIP CODE EXCEPTION ****

If you DO NOT HAVE a membership address in a zip code assigned to the Barony of Twin Moons, but your membership is current in a zip code in metropolitan Phoenix, you will be asked to sign a Pledge Form before you can receive a ballot. The Pledge Form shows your agreement with this statement:

"I consider myself a member of the populace of the Barony of Barony of Twin Moons, and promise the Crown of Atenveldt that I will not cast a ballot in any Pollings held in the Barony of Sun Dragon or the Barony of Atenveldt for 3 years following the date of this polling"

A list of the members who sign this Pledge Form will be kept by the Kingdom Seneschal's office, and by the Seneschals of the three Baronies in the Phoenix metropolitan area. After signing the Pledge Form, you will be given a different color ballot to indicate your preference for Baron and Baroness.

War of the Phoenix - Basic Guide for Planning Ahead

Plan ahead for the best event:

- Get your tent out, and check it for any needed repairs and get them done.
- Do you have a bed/cot/sleeping arrangement that will keep you off the ground and comfortable for up to 4 nights?
- February in AZ can be cold, especially at night. We don't have any of that humidity thing to keep the heat in. We could be wet, we could be dry, might be warm, but will probably be cold. The war is in Phoenix and the:
 - Average High in February: 71° F/22° C
 - Average Low in February: 49° F/9° C
 - Average Monthly Rainfall: ~1 inch
 - Have a food plan.
 - There may be food vendors on site, but it is also a good idea to have food that is similar to your regular diet and a way to store and prepare it. Your body will thank you.
 - If you are camping with a group of people a group kitchen and food plan is always a good option and can save you some money.
 - Do you have enough garb to last you for the event, and is what you have in good repair?
 - Is your garb up to the challenge? Plan for layers that you can add or remove as needed.
 - We have a couple months of holiday cheer ahead of us, and "I have to sew" is a great excuse to get out of an awkward family conversation.
- Do you have any special medical needs that would be impacted by camping. Make a plan for how to store medications, and any other devices you will need and how to power them.
- Are you a combatant? We have just the thing for you, but first:
 - Are your combat authorizations current for all your preferred weapons styles? Will they be current during the war?
 - How's that armor holding up? Can you find all the pieces and is it repaired?
 - Check your weapons. They also need to be in good working order. We all want to have fun and not have to stop on day one because something broke.
- Do you like Arts & Sciences? We've got those too.
 - If you plan to teach or display in one of the showcases are you prepared?
 - Now is the time to start getting things together.

Great Helm is upon us!

It is time to choose the new champions for Tir Ysgithr's Baron and Baroness! Once again gather to watch our brave combatants take the field as they fight for the honor of becoming Captain of the Guard, Rapier Captain, Youth Champion and Hardsuit /Rapier Guardsmen. Details of the tournaments will follow closer to the event in consultation with Their Excellencies and Their current Captain, Sir Gregior.

This year, we will accomplish all within one full day of Tournaments at Catalina State Park. Opening court will be at the discretion of Their Excellencies, Æsa and Jörgen, with tournaments to begin immediately following.

A Magic the Gathering game will be held for youngsters, and 8 embroidery packets will be offered for those who would like to contribute a boar to the Barony's largess locker.

Stakes for popups and pavillions are permitted. Please do not drive on the grass during setup and tear down. There is shade and there is water on site, as well as flush toilets. The site is discreetly wet and smoking is allowed. Pets are also allowed at the site. Pets must be leashed at all times and you are required to pick up after them.

DIRECTIONS TO EVENT:

Note: tell the ranger at the gate that you are there for the SCA event and you get in free. They will give you a pass.

From the North: south on I10 to the Tangerine Road exit. Go east on Tangerine until you hit Oracle. Right (south) on Oracle. Park has a sign on the east (left) side of the road. Or come south on 80 until you see the sign for the park.

From the South:

From I 10, exit on Tangerine Road. Then follow direction above for if you were coming from the north.
