
# A Missive from Their Royal Majesties




# An Announcement from Their Royal Majesties

Letters of intent for the upcoming Fall Crown List will be accepted in the month of October. If you wish to participate, you have until midnight on Halloween to submit your letters.

Please note the requirements outlined in Meridian Kingdom Law and SCA Corpora. The Letter of Intent must include, at a bare minimum, the following:

- a. A statement that it is the intent of the competitor and consort to participate;
- b. A statement that each person has read Corpora and Kingdom Law and meets the respective requirements of each;
- c. Proof of membership for both the competitor and consort;
- d. A copy of the competitor's authorization card;
- e. The competitor and the consort must sign the letter.


