From the Minister of Arts & Sciences

Greetings Caid!

May is bittersweet for me. This month at Altavia Anniversary I step down as your Kingdom Minister of Arts and Sciences and entrust this office into the capable hands of the Honorable Lady Avicia de Na Baiona. I have no doubt she will serve you well.

Although there is so much more I wish I could have done, I’m proud of what I accomplished. I produced the SCA’s first ever living history demo at the Getty Center. I dedicated hundreds of hours to improving Pentathlon by establishing evaluator feedback guidelines and training, as well as creating standardized rubrics and concrete documentation guidelines. I helped design PENNI, the Google App built by Philip de Will O’Aston, that manages registration, evaluation and scoring of the event. All of these implementations were directly tied to actionable feedback I received when I released Kingdom-wide Surveys on how to improve A&S in Caid. Also in conjunction with survey feedback, I created onboarding documents for territorial arts ministers, developed new A&S modules for territorial anniversary tourneys, and established standard operating procedures for the KMOAS office so that my successors no longer have to reinvent the wheel due to lack of guidance, established best practices, and record keeping. Having infrastructure in place means spending less time on administrative tasks and more time on actively helping the A&S community grow.

These past two years have been busy, but very rewarding. I am grateful for all of the moments I had connecting with the populace, listening to your needs, and striving to make positive change. Thank you all for the support you gave me, for trusting me with your input, and for helping make the A&S space a place where people feel welcome.

I agree with Ms. Brontë’s sentiments. This May, I expect to continue volunteering to help our Kingdom where I can, I wish Her Ladyship Avicia a wonderful tenure as KMOAS, and I hope to watch Caid’s artisans continue to flourish.
