I-5 SOUTH OR NORTH TO HWY 78 EAST- Take Hwy 78 east to city of Escondido. Freeway will end at Broadway. Continue straight on this road, Lincoln. Take a right at the light onto El Norte Parkway (Do not turn right on red here). Travel to Valley Parkway and turn left at the light onto Valley Parkway, continue about 6 miles - it will go up hill gradually. At a traffic light - Woods Valley Road, turn right. 
