

Beorn's Curio Corner:

What IS Twelfth Night?

(or, "I've had an Epiphany!")

Hail and well met fellow people of Caid! As you read this (if you read this [do you really? Or, do you just say you do so as not to hurt the ol' feller's feelings?]), it will be about as cold as it gets in a land that is, according to land mass, mostly desert. For that reason, it is a bit unusual that we get all into the festive winter activities when, and this is true, the average January temperature for Southern California and Las Vagas is 59°. Does it get colder at night? Sure, but that is hardly "winter weather" and more like, "Woot! Time for hoodies and board shorts! Now I get to wear my Christmas flip-flops!"

So, the time in and around the New Year doesn't seem all that different than any other. Add to that we, as a collective, no longer live our lives encumbered by the whim of the Church, and days like Twelfth Night seem purposeless. In fact, we used to have Twelfth Night celebrations in Caid every year, a different day from Coronation. But, our attempts to make the winter and summer reigns more equal required events, shuffling schedules. and traditions around and now we have Coronation and Twelfth Night on the same day. I hear tell they may switch it back at some point in the future, but that ain't the way of things at present.

The more astute of you may think Twelfth Night and "The Twelve Days of Christmas" have something to do with each other, and you would be right. The Council of Tours in 567C.E. (not the ones in 461, or 813, or 1054, or 1060, or 1163) decreed that the time between Christmas and Epiphany was just one long party called Christmastide (that Twelve Days of Christmas we were just talking about). Of course, they also said that married clergy were no longer allowed to sleep with their wives. I

What IS Twelfth Right?

(or, "I've had an Epiphany!")

suppose the Council giveth, and the Council taketh away.

After fasting for all of Advent (and I mean the religious form of fasting [don't eat meat, dairy, or consume alcohol and be mindful of your portions] not the "you have to get bloodwork done" modern form of fasting), a 12-day celebration between the birth of the baby Jesus and the arrival of the Magi with their gifts for said same was a welcome addition to the calendar. Since then, we have added all manner of superstitions, traditions, and activities from "now it is time to take your holiday decorations down," (also known as "now we leave the tree on the lawn to annoy the neighbors") to "let's bake a bean and a pea into a cake and serve it to our friends, and whoever breaks their tooth on said hardened legume shall be King and Queen of the evening!" So, that's it. This is just a celebration for funsies as declared by the people in charge of making sure you didn't have too much funsies.

As for the song itself. This very postperiod song (the earliest record we have is a broadsheet published in 1780) racks up an impressive amount of poultry and 'people just trying to get by in the gig economy' and if you tally it all up, you would be required to, over the course of 12 days, give to your true love 12 partridges, 12 pear trees, 22 turtle doves 30 French hens, 36 'calling birds' (which were "Colly Birds" in the original song¹), 40 gold rings, 42 geese (not ganders, since they are laying eggs), 42 swans, 42 milk maids, 36 dancing ladies, 30 leaping lords, 22 pipers, and 12 drummers. In 2023 money and assuming current market value for poultry and all the performers (and the dairy workers) were union, such an extravagant outpouring of affection would back set you \$300,000! That's a lot of love, especially in this economy!

¹- You thought you'd gotten away from my end notes, didn't ya? Ha! NEVER! <ahem> The "colly" of Colly Birds is a reference to coal (as in the color of coal, or black). And since we know that the English have a long tradition of taking blackbirds and doing all manner of things with them for sport (four-and-twenty baked in a pie? Savages!), just giving them seems quite tame.
