A 500- to 1000-word article will usually fit in one issue; longer articles will be split into multiple parts to appear in successive issues. Submit the file in MS Word .doc format along with an SCA Creative Release form. Send the images used in the article as separate files using the format described below.

You must cite all references, quotations and sources in your article using the Chicago Manual of Style format. Sample citations are located here: www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools\_citationguide. html. Citing sources is very important to avoid accusations of plagiarism and legal action for copyright violation.

**IMAGES**, such as line art, calligraphy, illumination and photographs are also welcome. Scan any artwork at 300 dpi and save it at the highest quality JPG setting. Photos should also be 300 dpi, high quality JPGs. All images will appear in print as black and white, but the online version of *The Pale* is in color. Images can also be submitted as high quality TIF or PDF files. Any artwork or photography submitted to *The Pale* must have a signed SCA Creative Release or SCA Photographer Release form from the artist sent in with the work. Any person identifiable in an image must submit a signed SCA Model Release form with the art work. This is a requirement of SCA Inc. for print publication. All release forms are available at www.midrealm.org/chronicler.

**EVENT PREVIEWS:** A free event preview of 50 words is available to all events. The listing **MUST include the name of the event**, **sponsoring group**, **site address**, **date**, **times and event steward contact information**.

**EVENT NOTICES** (ads) must be published in *The Pale* for events at which any of the following occur: crown and coronet tournaments, coronations and investitures, appointment of kingdom or principality officers, presentation of awards and titles, proclamation of law, establishment or advancement of branches. These activities cannot take place unless a complete event notice appears in *The Pale*, the Middle Kingdom newsletter, at least once before the date of the event. The publication requirement may only be waived in extraordinary circumstances, such as a natural disaster.

Events must **already** be listed on the Middle Kingdom Calendar prior to advertising in *The Pale*, but an event listing on the Middle Kingdom Calendar does **NOT** constitute "official publication". Incipient groups must submit a scan of the sponsorship form to the Editor. Event submissions to the Kingdom Calendar should be submitted through the **online form** available on the calendar page. Any issues contact the Middle Kingdom Calendar Secretary at calendar@midrealm.org. Middle Kingdom events receive free event ads that run in the next issue unless otherwise specified. Out-of-kingdom events and merchants pay the listed rates.

Ad templates for the quarter and half page ads are available at **http://midrealm.org/chronicler/thepale/**. All ads must be submitted to *The Pale* via e-mail attachment in DOC, PDF, JPG, or TIF format.

WITHOUT EXCEPTION, EVENT NOTICES MUST INCLUDE event name, sponsoring group, dates, times, site address, site registration, NAME (SCA & modern), email address and phone number of the event steward. Website URLs and simple driving directions to the event site are useful but not required. All clip art images in event notices must have a source listed and be used in accordance with the terms of use. All artwork MUST include an SCA Creative Release form from the author(s) or artist(s). SCA Model Releases are required for identifiable persons in any image. Submissions are edited for grammar, spelling, space constraints, inflammatory or explicit language and compliance with Middle Kingdom Law. Editorial decisions are final. "Letters to the Editor" are not permitted per SCA Inc. regulations.

Greetings,

In light of the smoke issues from the Canadian wildfires, I've gotten some questions about when we should cancel outdoor activities due to air quality issues. I've talked to some folks with air quality experience. We are looking at fine particulate matter in the air (PM2.5) which is measured in the Air Quality Index (AQI). Current measurements can be found at: https://fire. airnow.gov/

- At 100 AQI ( PM 2.5 ) asthmatics and sensitive persons will begin having issues by higher degree.
- At 150 AQI ( PM 2.5) non- sensitive people will begin having issues.
- At 200 AQI ( PM 2.5) pretty much everyone will be in a dangerous situation.

When the local AQI (PM 2.5) is over 200 outdoor, martial activities are to be cancelled. At lower levels, participants should act with caution and in the interest of their health. As always, local marshals may cancel official activities based on their reading of the environment. Additional information can be found at: https://www.airnow. gov/aqi/aqi-basics/. We should expect a very similar policy to be in effect at Pennsic.

Speaking of Pennsic: The Pennsic rules this year allow for authorizations and re-authorizations to happen at Pennsic if the participant's kingdom is good with it. For the Midrealm, we will allow armored and rapier authorizations and reauthorizations to happen with a few caveats. For armored authorizations/re-authorizations, one of the marshals running the authorization must be either me or Sir Draenge (my deputy for armored combat). For fencing authorizations/ re-authorization must be either me or Maestra Mirabai (my deputy for fencing). We will not be doing any Combat Archery or Siege authorizations at Pennsic. Folks may also authorize at official practices all the way up to the start of Pennsic.

Be safe out there.

#### Greetings!

Last month was the Known World Heraldic and Scribal Symposium held in the Barony of Caer Anterth Maer in Northshield. It was a well-attended event with a good selection of classes. I had the opportunity to meet the Laurel Sovereign of Arms and her deputies, along with several other current and past Principal Heralds.

This month, I have a letter from the Rouge Scarpe Herald, External Submissions deputy. Rouge Scarpe, Kallinikos Gavras, gives a good review of his office to help explain this portion of the name and/or armory submission.

Please take a moment to read about this second step in the submission process.

### Rouge Scarpe Herald

What Does The External Submissions Herald Do?

The External Submissions Herald, also known as the Rouge Scarpe Herald, is the second stop on your submission's journey. After your submission (either name or armory) is sent to the Internal Submissions Herald (aka Escutcheon Herald), they put it on a list of submissions, called the "Kingdom Letter of Intent", or KLoI. This letter is hosted on the website oscar.sca.org, where heralds from throughout the Middle Kingdom can look at your submission. These heralds ensure that your submission is compatible with SENA (Standard for Evaluation of Names and Armory), the ruleset that the SCA uses to make sure all submissions match our current understanding of what names or armory might have looked like in Period. This document is regularly updated as our understanding of Period practices grows.

The Kingdom Letter of Intent is open for commentary for one month. During this period, the External Submissions Herald will read any feedback, and will reach out to the submitter with any questions, follow-ups, or suggestions for changes if the heralds find an issue. After about one month, the External Submissions Herald will hold a decision meeting to discuss all of the month's submissions. These meetings are currently held on Slack at mkheralds.slack. com, and are open to members of the populace. At this meeting the External Submissions Herald, along with the Dragon Herald and with advice from the rest of the Middle Kingdom heralds, will individually review all submissions and make one of three decisions.

- 1. Approved Approved submissions will be passed on to the wider Society for further commentary and approval.
- Returned Returned submissions will be closed. The submitter will be informed of what rules the submission violated and what changes can be made to the submission for it to be accepted after it has been resubmitted. Resubmissions do not carry extra cost.
- Pended Pended submissions will be held back until some issue has been resolved or until further feedback can be gotten from the submitter. After this, the pended submission will usually be passed forward with said changes or feedback.

After the commentary meeting, the External Submissions Herald will prepare a new Letter of Intent, which will be posted on oscar.sca.org for heralds from throughout the Known World to review. This letter is usually published about a week after the decision meeting. They will also pass on their decisions to the Notifications Herald (aka Opinicus Herald), who will inform submitters of the status of their submission. The Society-wide Letter of Intent will be open for

two or three months for submitters to comment. In that time, the External Submissions Herald will monitor commentary and will pass on any further questions to the submitter as needed. After this period, the submission passes on to the Heraldic Sovereigns, the ultimate decisionmakers for heraldry in the SCA, who will make the final decision if the submission is approved or returned. Normally they need an additional two months to review commentary, write and proofread their decisions, and publish them to the wider SCA.




