

- · Site Fee(s) including any applicable surcharges
- An attached copy of the SIGNED event form
- Consider including details such as directions to the site, merchant information, event activities, site restrictions, and ADA accessibility options.

Events which have not published all of the above information in the Kingdom newsletter are not eligible to have awards, law changes, or other Official Kingdom business conducted at them.

- All submissions must be received by midnight on the 1st of the PREVIOUS month (see the Calendar).





# From the Society Seneschal

# Patron Membership - Corpora Commentary Request

As part of the <u>upcoming addition of a Patron membership</u>, we invite you to provide commentary on the language changes in Corpora that this update will require. This commentary will assist the Board in forming further decisions relevant to its consideration of this matter.

What is the Patron Membership?

It is a membership tier that offers the option of a greater financial contribution to the organization. Many non-profit organizations offer tiers of membership.

What is the proposed cost of a patron membership?

The proposed cost of the patron membership is \$150 a year.

Is it linked to titles or in game recognition?

No. Some Kingdoms require paid annual memberships rather than an event membership (non member rate) for awards but this is not a Society wide requirement.

Is it mandatory? No.

Who asked for it? The Corporate Office has received feedback from members at times that this is an option people would like available. What are the benefits of a Patron membership?

The main benefit is knowing that you are contributing to the ongoing administrative functioning of the Society in a way that you prefer. The organization is providing a small range of options as a gesture of its appreciation for your generosity.

Commentary regarding this proposed Corpora change must be received by the Board no later than May 3, 2024. Add #6 to Corporate Policies below. In bold.

Corporate Policies, I.B, 1-4—Membership Types-Non-Statutory Members:

B. Non-Statutory Members

The Board of Directors has designated the following categories of advisory membership. Such advisory members are not members within the meaning of Section 5056 of the California Corporations Code. California law supports the SCA's use of the terms "member" and "membership" in the common English meaning, referring to persons who have paid to be associated with the organization.

- 1. Sustaining Membership conveys eligibility to hold office in the SCA, a subscription to a Kingdom newsletter, the option to subscribe to other Corporate publications, and any other privileges designated by the SCA or its subdivisions as accruing to members of the SCA. This type of membership is considered a subscribing membership.
- 2. International Membership conveys the privileges of Section I.B.1. This membership type is available only in locations outside the United States which are part of the SCA, Inc., and not subject to an affiliate corporation. This type of membership is considered a subscribing membership.
- 3. Associate Membership conveys eligibility to hold office in the SCA, except where other membership categories are required Governing Documents. Associate membership also entitles the holder to any privileges designated by the SCA or its subdivisions as accruing to members of the SCA, except where another membership type is specifically required by the organization defining the privilege. This type of membership is not considered a subscribing membership.
- 4. Family Membership extends the privileges of Section I.B.1 to one additional adult and any children aged 21 or younger who live at the same physical address as a member defined in paragraphs B.1-B.2 of this Article. This type of membership is not considered a subscribing membership.
- 5. Institutional Membership allows a library or school to subscribe to Tournaments Illuminated and The Compleat Anachronist without acquiring the regional newsletter, and without any of the other privileges of membership. The Board reserves the right to determine whether or not a given organization qualifies for this membership type
- 6. Patron Membership conveys all privileges of 1.B.1. along with additional privileges as designated by the SCA.

# Commentary Request - Newsletter References - Governing Documents

In 2022, the Board of Directors decided to remove kingdom newsletters from behind a paywall and make the newsletters freely accessible from the SCA.org website. This change caused all references in the Governing Documents of the SCA, Inc. to "subscribing memberships" and requirements for immediate access to a newsletter at one's home to become obsolete. The Board of Directors is seeking commentary on the changes to the Governing Documents necessary to bring them in line with the reality that the newsletters are no longer of limited access.



Below are the areas of Corpora, the Bylaws, and Corporate Policies where changes will be needed to bring these documents in line with current practice.

#### Governing Documents: References to Membership types for Officer Privileges

- Bylaws, V.C.2.b Members-General Conditions and Privileges of Membership-Privileges of Members-Eligibility for Office:
  - Officers at all levels of the SCA must be members and must have immediate access to the corporate newsletter for their area. This standard also applies to deputies designated as successors to officers subject to this provision or assigned independent administrative duties. Deputies who only assist with specific tasks are exempt from the newsletter access requirement.

#### Corporate Policies, I.B, 1-4—Membership Types-Non-Statutory Members:

- 1. Sustaining Membership conveys eligibility to hold office in the SCA, a subscription to a Kingdom newsletter, the option to subscribe to other Corporate publications, and any other privileges designated by the SCA or its subdivisions as accruing to members of the SCA. This type of membership is considered a subscribing membership.
- 2. International Membership conveys the privileges of Section I.B.1. This membership type is available only in locations outside the United States which are part of the SCA, Inc., and not subject to an affiliate corporation. This type of membership is considered a subscribing membership.
- 3. Associate Membership conveys eligibility to hold office in the SCA, except where other membership categories are required by the Governing Documents. Associate membership also entitles the holder to any privileges designated by the SCA or its subdivisions as accruing to members of the SCA, except where another membership type is specifically required by the organization defining the privilege. This type of membership is not considered a subscribing membership.
- 4. Family Membership extends the privileges of Section I.B.1 to one additional adult and any children aged 21 or younger who live at the same physical address as a member defined in paragraphs B.1-B.2 of this Article. This type of membership is not considered a subscribing membership.

#### Corporate Policies, II.C: General Conditions and Privileges of Membership-Eligibility for Office:

Officers at all levels of the SCA must be members as defined in I.B.1-4 above. and must have immediate access to the corporate newsletter for
their area provided by a subscribing membership at their residence. (Alternate access arrangements may be made on a case-by-case basis
for people with post office boxes and for International Members.) This standard also applies to deputies designated as successors to officers
subject to this provision or assigned independent administrative duties. Deputies who only assist with specific tasks are exempt from the
newsletter access requirement.

#### Corpora-Glossary:

• Subscribing member: A Sustaining or International member of the SCA, Inc. or its approved equivalent in an affiliated organization.

#### Corpora I.D.2 – General-Membership Requirements-Officers:

a. Officers at all levels of the Society must be Society members as defined in the By-Laws and Corporate Polices of the SCA, Inc. Glossary. and
must have immediate access to the corporate newsletter for their area received at their residence. (Alternate access arrangements may be
made for members of affiliated organizations or on a case-by-case basis for people with post office boxes and for International Members.)
 This standard also applies to deputies designated as successors to officers subject to this provision or assigned independent administrative
duties. Deputies who only assist with specific tasks are exempt from the newsletter access requirement.

#### Corpora III.A.2—Branches-General:

• While international memberships may be used in the calculation of membership totals for branch status, a branch based on international memberships must have least one subscription to the appropriate corporate publication for their geographic area. The exact number required is a matter for negotiation among the Seneschals of the branch, principality, and kingdom, and the Society Seneschal. The required subscription(s) may be purchased communally by the branch.



- Be responsible for the publication of the Kingdom newsletter, herein called Southwind
- Work with the Kingdom Calendar Officer to include in each Southwind an accurate calendar of all official Atenveldt events to be held in the six months following the date of that Southwind issue, and work with the Kingdom Seneschal to publish a monthly list of "Bids Needed for Kingdom Events Scheduled in Next 12 Months"
- Be responsible for the publication of any official documents, booklets, etc., which may become necessary from time to time. This includes publication of Event Financial Reports for all Kingdom and inter-kingdom events
- Coordinate with the Minister of Arts and Sciences as needed to produce any printed issues of the Arts and Sciences publication Atenveldtus Glorious
- Publish in Southwind a listing of all awards given by the Crown, and any missives from the Crown,
- Publish Kingdom financial information every quarter in the Southwind, and With other Greater and Lesser Officers, implement and adhere to the financial and reporting guidelines.

# <u>Kingdom Emergency Deputy Seneschal (Open until filled)</u> The Emergency Deputy Kingdom Seneschal is delegated to specific tasks instructed by the Kingdom Seneschal. The Kingdom Seneschal's

overall duties are:

- Maintain Kingdom Law and administer changes to Kingdom Law
- Advise the Crown on Kingdom Law and Corpora
- Call such meetings, require such reports, and oversee such events as are necessary for the proper functioning of the Kingdom, including but not limited to:
  - Ensuring all Greater and Lesser Kingdom Officers are warranted, reporting, and maintain current SCA memberships; and (though local Seneschals) ensuring all official SCA local groups in the Kingdom maintain the required number of Great Officers who are current SCA members, warranted, and reporting
  - Maintaining a master list of warrant expiration dates and membership expiration dates for all Greater and Lesser Kingdom Officers and delivering a copy of that list to the Crown Prince and Princess at Crown Tournament
  - Approving all additions, changes, and deletions to the list of Royalty, Landed Nobility, and Kingdom Officers ("The Regnum") published in the Kingdom Newsletter and on the Kingdom websites. A warrant date may be omitted for Officers listed with the notation "Acting"
- Be responsible for the administration of procedures involving recognition of new branches and status changes for existing branches and recommend to the Crown for recognition of those branches that are prepared for a change of status
- Monitor official branches within the Kingdom to determine if they are maintaining the standards required for an official group and notify the Crown and the Board of Directors when groups fail to uphold the standards.
- Work with the Kingdom Calendar Officer to establish the Kingdom Calendar for the current calendar year and the next calendar year as
  - Solicitation/Presentation of Event Bids: The Kingdom Seneschal shall consult with the Royalty, Territorial Barons and Baronesses, and Seneschals of the local groups to actively solicit bids for Kingdom and inter-kingdom events to be scheduled in the next calendar year
    - Qualified bids must be submitted no later than six months before the event date; must include a proposed budget, a proposed site, an Event Steward and Feast Steward (when a feast is required); and must comply with all guidelines in section VII EVENTS. Copies of the bid must be sent to kfc@atenveldt.org.
    - Bids received by the Kingdom Seneschal shall be presented to the Kingdom Financial Committee by the Kingdom Seneschal for approval. Bids shall be submitted on a first come, first submitted basis
  - Publication of Bids Needed: The Kingdom Seneschal shall publish a monthly report in Southwind showing "Bids Needed for Kingdom Events Scheduled in Next 12 Months'
    - When a bid has not been received for an event six months in the future, the Kingdom Seneschal shall proactively contact local groups to ensure required bid(s) are generated.
- Be ultimately responsible for all official Kingdom and inter-kingdom events (see Section XIV for Estrella War guidelines) held within Atenveldt, including ensuring completion of two post event reports for each Kingdom event as follows:
- An Event Summary Report must be completed by the Exchequer and sent to the Crown, Heirs, and Kingdom Financial Committee within 30 days of the event.
- An Event Financial Report must be completed by the Co-hosting Group Exchequer (or Responsible Exchequer) and submitted for publication in Southwind within 30 days of the event. Copies must be simultaneously sent to the Crown, Heirs, and Kingdom Financial
- Distribute a copy of Kingdom Law to Royal Heirs at the time of Crown Tourney
- Distribute updated copies of the membership list to the Crown on a monthly basis
- Be responsible for the dissemination of information via Southwind any changes to law made by, or considered for change by, the Board of Directors
- Be responsible for ensuring that Territorial Barons/Baronesses review immediate law changes proclaimed on any day other than the day of Coronation
- With other Greater and Lesser Officers, implement and adhere to the financial and reporting guidelines for any inter-kingdom war
